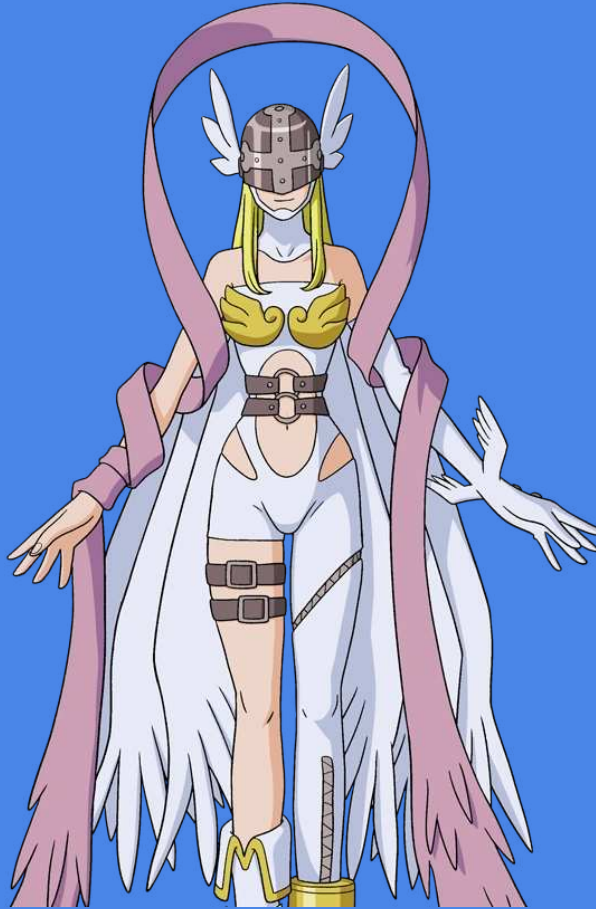


Angelic Department of Justice
