### Elder God (300 CP)

You exist beyond space and time, and your true nature dwarfs the naive concept of infinity known to mortals. The expanse of your Self unfolds throughout whichever reality you find yourself in, bonding to and becoming one with the fabric of reality and assimilating any souls foolish enough to get too close to your presence. If you wish, you could craft entire realities wholesale from nothing but your eldritch will alone, fashioning a history for that world and living people to inhabit it. You're also able to teach mortals to surpass the limits of their perceived reality, guiding them to see beyond the illusory veil and comprehend the limitless possibilities beyond.

You have a natural talent for working in the chaotic environment of a busy fast food store. You never mix up people's orders, and you always get their food out in a timely fashion. Any manager would be overjoyed to have you working at their restaurant.

#### Getting the Gang Together (200 CP, discounted for Good Burger Manager)

People like you, and you like them. You've always said you're a people-person, and it shows when the faces of your employees light up when you enter the room. You know how to bring them together, easing in anyone shy or aggressive and smoothing out any wrinkles in their professional relationships. Before long you'll be running one tight ship, everyone playing their part with a smile on their face.

#### Cover Up the Taste (200 CP, discount for Mondo Burger Employee)

You can't hope to slip those additives past the health inspectors if they can taste it in the meat, can you? You know how to mask the taste of many illicit ingredients with spices and salts, passing it off as simply a value brand taste. ### Fry Cook (400 CP, discounted for Good Burger Employee)

They say home is where the heart is. If that's true, you'd never been home until you first stepped foot into a kitchen. You can work ovens and deep fryers like an artist, and some would say you were born with a spatula in your hand. Anyone who tastes your food is all but guaranteed to go home satisfied.

If your customer base suddenly drops out, you have a much greater chance of running into someone who'll have just the right idea to bring them all back.

Genesis (600 CP, discounted for Elder God)

Mondo Burger Uniform (100 CP, free for Mondo Burger Employee)

### Millenium Jacket (100 CP, free for Elder God)

Guided by the will of Ed, it will unerringly strike those who have wronged you, or are otherwise your foes. It will never harm them directly, but you can rely on this falling patty to severely inconvenience them in some way.

### Amulet of Halted Time (400 CP, discounted for Elder God)

Anyone who wears this amulet around their neck will never feel the strains of time wearing them down. They will never age, living eternally as young as the day they put it on. They will never tire, running and fighting as if they just began after a soothing rest. They will never run low on magical energy or other internal stores of power, always remaining at full vitality. They will never require sustenance, breath, or rest, as steadfast as the relentless march of entropy.

### Special Sauce (600 CP, discounted for Good Burger Employees)

A specialty sauce invented by Ed, which tastes incredible on just about any type of fast food. You get a jar to taste test, and the recipe to create more. Putting this in your hamburgers is sure to bring in customers even to a ghost town of a restaurant.

### Good Burger (600 CP, discounted for Good Burger Manager)

The Threshold, the Key, and the Gate. The Good Burger restaurant itself. You can carry the joys of greasy sandwiches and quality customer service with you to future worlds, and each time the restaurant will be staffed by friendly people ready to get down to business.

#### Mondo Burger (600 CP, discounted for Mondo Burger Employee)

The rival to Good Burger, you now own the property yourself. It will also follow you to future jumps, and will be staffed by devious, sinister malcontents like yourself. They'll be eager to get down to work scamming anyone who comes through your doors, but if you stiff them they'll probably trash the place before disappearing.

### Pocket Universe (600 CP, discounted for Elder God)

A puppet world of your own creation. It exists outside of time and space, and beyond the reaches of other universes or dimensions. It's unreachable and unassailable by all others save those of your own kind, the other primordials. Within the bounds of this realm you are god. You have full and total control over the flow and structure of reality, cannot be killed as you will simply reform instantaneously, and can alter the physical, spiritual, and metaphysical structure of the dimension at will.

#### Companions

### Companion Import (50 CP)

Import up to eight companions for 50 CP each, and each received 600 CP to spend on anything besides more companions.

# Canon Companion (100 CP)

You can companion any character you meet here and take them with you, as long as you can convince them to come with you that is.

### Hamburger (200 CP)

"Even now, the evil seed of what you've done *germinates* within you." A strange hamburger with two eyes and the ability to speak that mysteriously appeared in the last bag of fast food you purchased. It has a small number of other abilities as well, such as multiplying itself, causing people to float in midair, and banishing souls to the howling vortex of the Abyss for all of eternity.

### Things on Strings (100 CP)

Random objects just happen to have strings tied to them, and will be yanked out of your hands should you ever make the mistake of picking them up. Try not to do that, as this is a ploy by Ed to slowly drive you mad over the course of your ten years for his own amusement. Should you ever succumb to his madness, your soul will be his for all eternity.

### Haruhi Suzumiya Syndrome (100 CP)

The cycles of the Good Burger are illusory, as fleeting as the people who inhabit them. They dance on strings pulled by Ed, as he plays games and charades with the creatures and objects he has created. Oftentimes, the lines between the two will blur, with objects being given life and intelligence and the toys he's grown bored with having their souls stripped from them and scoured across the endless wastes. Ed giveth, and Ed taketh away. Now, you will play his games. Whether or not you would be forced to anyways is another matter, but now he will be able to counteract any attempts at resistance as easily as he counteracted the futile attempts by Mondo Burger to usurp his throne. You must entertain Ed for ten years, and if he ever decides

you aren't worth watching, he will reduce you to nothing more than hamburger meat to be sold to his customers in the next cycle.

### Exiled (100 CP)

You have wronged your betters, and for this you have been punished. You have been sentenced to an eternity of isolation, trapped within a prison universe by the Elder God Shaquille O'Neal. Once every 1000 years he will return, to test you. If you have perfected the Good Burger, you will be allowed to escape from your bonds. If not, you will have another millenium to meditate upon your failure and experiment with further attempts. If you have still failed in your task by the death of the universe, or refuse to submit, your prison universe will be collapsed and destroyed in an unstoppable maelstrom of Shaq-Fu, taking you along with it.
