Origins

Choose any gender, and an age from 15-18.

Student Council ('A')

A member of your school's student council, and underling of the hypercompetent, yet inexplicably single student council president, Dokuo. Lets hope you have the time for your SC duties, on top of the president's excessive hijinks.

Delinquent/Cyborg ($^{\wedge} \cdot \omega \cdot ^{\wedge}$)

Once a mere delinquent scumbag, after your humiliating defeat, you've been rebuilt as an oddly derivative cyborg. You aren't that much stronger than before, and you don't have any hidden weapons, but at least you look cool.

Perks

Love Survivor

You may be a bit of an oddball, but even you deserve a chance. Other people tend to be exceptionally patient with you. Never annoyed when you can't fit in, or need a little extra help, but still willing to let you fight your own battles.

This Book is Hard to Read

With hard work, you can push past any handicaps that would prevent you from learning, and catching up with your peers. Whether that handicap be bad habits, not speaking the right language, or even mental disability.

Good Old Friends Gathered

You're strange, but no less worthy of friends. No matter how strange you are, you have no trouble making and keeping friends. Only irredeemable scum will take advantage of your ignorance, but friends will always arrive to help you at these times.

I Don't Like a Jumper... who Goes Away

You're able to quickly forget all kinds of mental hazards, whether it be trauma, habits, hypnosis, etc. You know when you've forgotten something, and you may remember anything once you need it, and are emotionally prepared.

Protect Her to the End

($^{\omega}$) 100CP, Free Bar Examinee

For whatever reason, you're a wonderful caretaker for those who are unable to care for themselves. You're patience is seemingly endless, but not to the extent of coddling. You push others to want to improve themselves, and become more independent.

Based on a True Story

($^{\omega}$) 200CP, 100CP Bar Examinee

You have the makings of a bestselling author. You have the talent to make even the most dull stories sell. When you put your heart into publishing a book, you'll always get at least enough income to support yourself and those you love for some time.

I Guess it's Pretty Rare

($^{\omega}$) 400CP, 200CP Bar Examinee

I suppose there's no such thing as age for a prodigy. Your age will never bar you from achieving any given job or position, if you have the skills needed. Accomplishing such things at an abnormally young age will often be accompanied by short-lived fame.

He's Flying

($^{\omega}$) 600CP, 300CP Bar Examinee

You have a talent for stealing the spotlight in tense situations, and gaining a disproportionate amount of praise for your contributions. When it's to save those you care dearly for, you physical abilities are pushed to their limits, and a little past that, all for their sakes.

That's our Pres'

('A') 100CP, Free Student Council

You're a natural leader. With the presence that lets you quickly seize command when needed, and the organizational skills to keep everyone working together like a fine-tuned machine. You're also seen as quite approachable, and down-to-Earth.

Which Part do you Want me to Break?

('A') 200CP, 100CP Student Council

You're an inexplicably capable martial artist. With the agility, speed, and stamina to fight off entire crowds of people. Strangely, this can't be used for any forms of exertion that aren't related to combat, nor does it make you appear any more fit.

Whose Arm is That!?

('A') 400CP, 200CP Student Council

It's truly horrifying what one can do in the name of "self defense". For you especially, as long as nobody dies, there are no moral or legal repercussions for mutilating someone in self defense. Even if that mutilation goes as far as turning people into cyborgs.

We'll let Him off for Today

('A') 600CP, 300CP Student Council

People tend to brush aside clearly impossible occurrences when you're responsible. Even it's a giant rampaging cyborg, or a show of actual magic. They'll acknowledge it as pretty cool, but as long as nobody was hurt, they won't question it any further than that.

Let me Explain That!

(^ • ω • ^) 100CP, Free Delinquent/Cyborg

You have the makings of an excellent commentator. With a voice that keeps people's attention, and a delivery that keeps them invested. As such, when you try to make a name or a harmless trend catch on, it almost always sticks.

Still Don't get the Situation You're In?

(^ · ω · ^) 200CP, 100CP Delinquent/Cyborg

Any time, from any sizable and currently unobserved location, you can summon a few dozen mundane delinquents on a moment's notice. They're always game for any scumbag activities. Potential victims aren't considered in whether an area is unobserved.

Fully Autonomous

(^ - ω - ^) 400CP, 200CP Delinquent/Cyborg

You're more than a machine, you're a punk! You won't stand for being controlled like an RC car. Your rage alone allows you to break through brainwashing, or even your own programming, if your hatred (justified or otherwise) is intense enough.

There Should be a Limit

(^ • ω • ^) 600CP, 300CP Delinquent/Cyborg

You have the ability to grow immensely in size and strength by eating inorganic material. This boost is disproportionately great when eating other cyborgs. Potentially making you kaij-sized. Everything eaten will be harmlessly ejected upon your defeat.

Import (x2)

100CP

For each purchase of this, you may import two companions from past worlds into this one. Each imported companion receives an Origin, and 600CP to spend however they might want. They may gain up to 300 additional CP from Drawbacks.

Canon(x2)

100CP

With each purchase, you may take two characters not mentioned below with you as a companion. This accounts for a very small number of people. This option can also be used to make entirely original companions. You can't prove they don't exist in-canon.

Tsunbaka and Boon

100CP

The main characters of this story: Tsunbaka, a sweet young girl with spiraling pigtails and a peculiar mental illness, and Horizon Naito (Boon), a kind and brilliant aspiring lawyer with no hair, nose and an emoticon for a face. These two could not bear to be separated across time and space, so your only option is to buy them both with this option. If they have a child before your time in this world is up, they will also be included in this offer.

Dokuo

200CP

Your school's beloved school president. For unusual level of competence, taking Dokuo as your companion will cost quadruple that of the above options. There is very little Dokuo is incapable of, from his natural leadership abilities, singing, combat skills, superhuman strength, bioengineering, programming, and the list goes on. Despite that, he both boasts and laments his status as a lonar. His inexplicably skinny physique and lack of hair or human facial features might be partly responsible, but his eccentricities and half-baked personality are likely the chief culprits.

Big Pulp

300CP

One of Dokuo's most impressive creations. Once a cat-faced delinquent with above average fighting ability, now a insanely strong cyborg, with the ability to grow to colossal size from consuming inorganic matter. Their rage is too great to be contained by mind control or even their own programming, but you've seemed to have reigned them in, so they will obey your orders without a second thought.

Shang-High Noon Musume

300CP

I guess Dokuo gave up on his dreams of forming an all-cyborg idol group, and has re-gifted his cyborg army to you. Several dozen cyborgs with flawless coordination and loyalty to you. You won't get Big Pulp, but you'll still have many capable, and oddly familiar cyborgs under your command, all in one companion slot.

<u>Items</u> (/•▽•)/

2channel

100CP, one 100CP Item Free

From any internet-connected device, you always have a link to a texteboard with countless users and resources at your disposal.

Keeping in Touch

100CP, one 100CP Item Free

A simple flip-phone. Mundane, with the exception of zero delay between one side speaking and the other side hearing.

Preemptive Self Defense

100CP, one 100CP Item Free

When the need arises, you may pull a powerful taser from your pocket, even if none was there before.

Mystery Box

200CP, one 200CP Item 100CP

A hollow box, able to conceal impossibly large objects. People are prone to assuming nothing dangerous is hidden inside.

Autobiography

200CP, one 200CP Item 100CP

A book detailing your own adventures, or just the mundane ones, if you'd prefer. This book is always oddly popular when published.

The Neet

200CP, one 200CP Item 100CP

A pulp magazine that always seems to have news on people you personally know, and what they've been up to.

My Nichijou

400CP, one 400CP Item 200CP

Your very own highschool. No matter how insane or impossible, any insane events that occurs on-campus will be treated as normal, even to outsiders looking in.

Tonfas


400CP, one 400CP Item 200CP

A pair of tonfas. Wielding these lets you perform various superhuman attacks, few of which actually involve the tonfas. If that fails, you can just use them as explosives.

Jumper's Family is Wealthy, After All

400CP, one 400CP Item 200CP

One of the upper crust. You come from a stupidly rich family. While this does give you plenty of pocket money to throw around, you find that this also lets you handwave away any impossibly hi-tech, or absurdly expensive, hi-tech, or morally grey projects. As wealthy as you are, people often accept these matter-of-factly.

Receive Nothing

If you'd prefer, to have a more active role in the story, you may choose to replace the character your origin is based on. Those being Tsunbaka, Boon, Dokuo, or Big Pulp for Tsunbaka, Bar Examinee, Student Council, and Delinquent/Cyborg respectively. You take up their history and responsibilities, but you won't get any of their abilities that you didn't already have or purchase.

Failure is Not an Option

Receive 100CP

It's nothing new that Japanese society tends to pin everything on academic performance. For one reason or another, the future success of you and those you care about depend solely on an immensely difficult test. None of your OOC powers will help you.

The Source of it All

Receive 100CP

You come from a broken and abusive household. You're often left to fend for yourself, and when your family members are around, they're usually mentally, and physically abusive. This won't get much worse, but it will take its toll on your emotional well being.

The Real Forever Alone Guy

Receive 200CP

No matter what you're capable of, you'll find yourself drowning in loneliness for your time here. You aren't hated, or even disliked, but nobody is interested in a romantic relationship with you. Even those you love platonically will end up inevitably drifting away.

Stranger in Danger

Receive 200CP

You're a complete scumbag. That's how people will see you regardless. What's more, people tend to overreact when they think you're assaulting them or those they care about. You also lose all ability to beat people fighting in "self defense" and even afterwards, no one will be remotely concerned for your well being, no matter how severe the "self defense".

More "Baka" Than "Tsun"

Receive 300CP

You seem to suffer from the same dissociative amnesia as Tsunbaka. You frequently forget pieces of basic common sense or logic. You'll often forget things immediately after learning them, even your own thoughts. It will take time and emotional support to push past this. For now, caring for yourself is all but impossible.

I'mma Beat Ya

Receive 300CP

You're filled to bursting with an insufferable rage that compels you to destroy everything in sight. You can reign this in with willpower, but even them, you can only communicate through threats.
