The Story Thus Far

Throughout the long history of this land there have many heroes, many villains, and throughout them all the heroes have triumphed over evil... with a little help. Most often that help takes the form of a nature spirit, and occasionally the princess of the nation. A princess that, due to tradition, is almost always named Zelda. Unbeknown to most, it's almost always the same hero and the same princess. Link, a hero of a bygone era, who earned the love of the goddess Hylia... and the goddess Hylia, reincarnated into the form of a mortal to be with the man she loved.

But what if there was an era that did not need the hero? Where the princess was an utterly ordinary girl? What if there was an era that was not destined for greatness and tragedy, and the ones who would normally fill the roles were ordinary people instead? To that end, allow me to introduce you to a Knight of Hyrule that the current princess has taken a liking to, and to that princess. Their names? Link and Zoe. Admittedly, Zoe may also be Zelda, as per Hyrulean royal naming tradition, but I assure you, this bitch is NOT the bearer of the Triforce of Wisdom. Or wise. Or even smart. And Link is not particularly courageous.

Have fun dealing with Zoe's constant swearing and Link's constant perversion.

Origins Choose One

Knight

You are a knight of Hyrule. Probably. You may even be the princesses bodyguard, or some equally prestigious position. Normally this would mean that I assume you to be something of a badass and a great hero, but there isn't much call for that in this lackluster day and age. Still, you're strong of body and presumably of heart, so if you wanted to do such a thing, you'd be in a good position to do it. You can insert into Link if you want.

Princess

You are a princess of Hyrule. Probably. High nobility would also be an option, and quite possibly a more dignified one than being a princess given what the other one is currently like. Hopefully you are more wise than her. Which you could accomplish by being moderately intelligent and or not getting your brain rotted by tiktok. You can insert into Zoe if you want. Actually please do, I have no doubt you'd do the job better than her.

The Pope

You are an evil wizard! ...Or a holy man. Can't quite tell, it could go either way really. You know some magic spells, and your day job seems to be removing magic artifacts from the hands of those who would misuse them. Honestly, using them for personal profit is actually fine, it's when the user is too stupid that you need to take it out of the hands of the public. They might hurt someone. They might hurt a lot of someones.

Age and Gender Your age may be chosen freely, and your gender is the same as the last jump, or may be swapped for 100 cp.

Discounts

100 cp perks and items are free to their respective origins.

All others half off as appropriate.

Perks

Knight

100 cp - 100% Gamer

Beating a game of the Legend of Zelda isn't terribly difficult, but beating it completely, one hundred percent, can be fairly annoying depending on the game. There are quite a few minigames in some of those, and not all of them are based on skill. Luckily for you, you're an excellent gamer. In fact, as it turns out, you are amazing at translating your skill in real life into gaming prowess. For example, you're now a competent swordsman and can ride horses. In games, you'll find sword things and horse riding to be significantly easier. If you can do something in real life, you can do it in a game.

200 cp - Total Stud

Given how Link keeps wishing for perverted things and inflicting himself upon Zoe when he isn't totally ignoring her in favor of games, you gotta wonder why she puts up with him. Heck, they seem to live together. Is this just a traditional thing for them to be thrown together? Maybe, but I have another explanation in mind. Link? Fucks. Like a god. You may or may not be the manliest man around, in fact if you wanted you could make for a very pretty girl if you're wearing the Gerudo outfit, but once you're in the bedroom, you have got The Moves ™, if you know what I mean. You're so good in bed that a woman - ie Zoe - who hated everything about your personality, habits, and sexual preferences would still put up with you for the sake of getting that dick.

400 cp - Timeskip

But hey, let's talk about the time Link didn't have a dick. Sesbian lex, right? For some reason Zoe was even more into him than normal. But anyways, how did Link get turned back into a guy? Up until now, all wishes that weren't transient were permanent - ie, while wishing for Zoe to be suddenly naked can be 'undone' by her putting clothes on, her bust size stayed enhanced. With that in mind, I have good news for you. You're actually very skilled and stupidly lucky at finding ways to undo things. Whether it's seeking out fairies to undo curses or just stealing the statue back to make wishes to undo the wishes that were made on you, you'll find that after about a week or so of suffering under whatever kind of magical transformation that the universe will start handing out potential ways to undo it. You just need to go find them.

600 cp - Hero Who Doesn't Do Anything

So, remember how I said the current hero wasn't THE hero? That he was just some dude? Well, congratulations. Because despite not being destined for greatness, there still seems to be a certain level of narrative expectation floating around. When you're nearby, things go better for others. Not that you're the one solving their problems, more like... You're so pathetic that they can't help but feel good about themselves in comparison, and that extra burst of positivity lets them accomplish more than they normally would. Well, saying it that way makes you sound completely useless, which probably isn't true. It's just that you aren't the Hero. You might make a decent ordinary hero, depending. In the meantime, everyone else around is already operating on that level thanks to you boosting them. Just imagine, an entire nation of half assed Links.

Princess

100 cp - Hail Zoe

Zoe is many things. Beautiful, witty, a competent horse rider, an amazing fuck, and many other things. She's also very much the exact opposite of what you'd normally associate with the princess of a nation, let alone one renowned for wisdom. In fact, Zoe debatably makes quite a few unwise choices, up to and including stealing the Moai Statue in the first place. However, she is also hot. Very hot. And not afraid to use that hotness to her advantage. I guess it's vaguely appropriate to refer to her as a fairly competent social manipulator? To that end, you now have a wealth of skill appropriate for a prostitute, a streamer, or a politician in that you seem to have a sixth sense for exactly how far you can push your bitchy attitude before people start to take umbrage with you. As well as skills actually appropriate for those roles, which I expect you will largely use to bail your ass out of trouble once you accidently do the nazi salute on live television.

200 cp - Sex Appeal

It wouldn't be a Legend of Zelda game without someone commenting on Zelda's ass. The Zeldass, if you prefer. Mind you, Zoe is an exceptionally poor example of a Zelda, but she still got it going on. And now, so do you. You're hot. You're beautiful. You've got a bouncy ass and fat tits that men are easily distracted by. Don't ask me what you're like if you're a guy, I don't care enough to figure that out. What matters is that you're hot enough people are liable to obsess over you. Hell, you could fairly easily make a living wage by selling pictures of your feet online. God knows some people are perverse enough to be willing to pay for that kind of thing, and you've got some damn fine feet. And, if you like, you can have absolutely no sense of shame when it comes to your beauty. Your mouth got you into this mess and with enough blowjobs, your mouth can get you out of it as well.

400 cp - I'd Spelunk Your Caverns

This particular era doesn't have much in the way of a plot. The most dangerous thing floating around right now is a magical wish granting statue, but Link and Zoe are too low IQ to wish for anything that would seriously affect things. That does beg the question of how they got it in the first place, however. ...Zoe stole it. She heard a rumor one day about a cool thing, hunted it down, was given a vision of all the things that could potentially go wrong, and then stole it anyways. Poor decisions aside, you have a set of skills I'd expect more from Link than from the princess - you've an acceptable level of talent with the blade, you can ride a horse, you can fend for yourself in the wilderness - in short, you can go on an adventure and have a great time. Or a terrible one.

600 cp - By The Power Of Onlyfans

So fun fact, Zoe wished for world peace and accidentally destroyed the monarchy in the process. Given that she's a princess, this was fairly bad for her and resulted in some fairly severe money troubles as she went from a life of luxury to having to scrape by to make rent. Fortunately she managed to get herself elected back into office thanks to the power of way too many people simping over pictures of her feet, and then became a princess again not too much later. While it's a bit unlikely for you to go through a similar set of circumstances, you'll find that it's oddly easy for you to rise through the ranks, potentially even to positions of power that you shouldn't have qualified for, or that didn't exist until they gave it to you. If you lived in a nation where you were only allowed to rule for four years at a time, only twice, and didn't even have total power while you did you - with the proper application of nudes you could fairly easily crown yourself as the gueen of that nation.

The Pope

100 cp - Holy Man

You are an evil wizard. Probably. This doesn't actually mean all that much these days, given how lackluster the entirety of Hyrule is, but it's worth mentioning. As a result, you've learned two fairly useful magic spells. The first is a fairly weak form of telekinesis, enough to lift and grab objects from nearby and pull them to you. The second is technically summoning magic, but mostly takes the form of communicating with the thing you would have summoned rather than actually summoning it. Think of it like a magic cellphone and you'd have a decent starting point. You can use it to call up demons, twil, and other weirdos, though actually getting them to do anything for you will be a bit of a gamble.

200 cp - Trustworthy

You need the statue. You NEED it. How else can you begin to undo the damage that these fools have so carelessly wrought upon the world? ... Which is to say, they turned it into something that wasn't your magical realm, so now you have to make a bunch of wishes to fix things, to punish them, and then to relax after a long day of wishing. Normally you'd think that being some big imposing guy dressed all in black and sitting on a throne would make people hesitate, but nope. For some reason people seem to think of you as reliable and trustworthy. Given even the slightest inclination that you'd be better at handling a problem than them, they might just dump it all on you.

400 cp - Merasmerizing

You are the pope. Probably. Which, amongst other things, means that you are clearly not an evil wizard who was sent to prison because of nine chucklefucks and learned to cast fist in the meantime. To that end, you now have a modicum of ability to invoke the gods. In essence, you are a cleric. By praying to Hylia, you can cast spells of healing or light. By praying to Din, you can cast spells of fire. In addition to this, you have a surprising level of talent at devising methods of containment for artifacts of power. The Moai Statue, for example, or Majora's Mask. Lastly, you may force visions of the future upon people based on less than ideal outcomes of them abusing the power of the artifacts you have in containment.

600 cp - Do You Even Fuck

Oh no! Due to an extreme misuse of the power of the Moai Statue, you've been infected by the Curse of Demise! Luckily for you, the curse is just as lackluster as Link and 'Zelda' in this era, so mostly you just have a bunch of darkness and hatred themed magical powers. Oh, and also you're now princess bait. They see where this is going and they like it! Try not to cuck Link too badly, that can't possibly go well even if the local version isn't actually the reincarnation of the ancient hero who looked a demon god in the eye and told that god that it was gonna flinch first. You also have an extreme level of physical prowess, which in turn means that once you've got her panties off, you can fuck for hours. Enjoy.

Wishes

Normally I would take the opportunity to let you grab some of the gear and equipment that Link uses on his adventure, but by now you should have realized that there is neither an adventure nor any gear in this era. Only the Moai Statue. To that end, I've decided to let you purchase individual wishes on that statue. You may discount one 100 cp wish, one 200 cp or lower wish, and one 400 cp or lower wish.

100 cp - Boob Up

Based upon Link's first wish, this wish will cause the sexual characteristics of the target to increase in size. Or, in other words, it makes their tits and ass bigger. Or penis, if you're aiming it at a guy. Even if they already have big assets, if you aim this at them then they'll continue to get even bigger. This wish may be invoked up to three times per month per purchase.

100 cp - Clothes B Gone

Based upon Midna's first wish, this wish will cause the target to be stripped naked. Fairly tame all things considered, and Zoe even considered it to be quite boring when she realized what had happened, but it's still fun in its own right. Try not to use it in public. Or do, that could also be hilarious. This wish may be invoked up to three times per month per purchase.

100 cp - Slave Leia

Based upon Link's Christmas wish, this wish will forcibly change the outfit of the target into anything you desire. The same outfit, but sluttier? Slave Leia cosplay? Anything you want. Them staying in the outfit is not guaranteed, so please be sure to enjoy the view thoroughly before they start taking it off. This wish may be invoked up to three times per month per purchase.

100 cp - Fuck Already

Based on Link's second wish, this wish muddles events for a brief moment to lead to the desired outcome. Which is to say, the wish lets you fuck the target in question. They'll be aware that something is wrong, but still willing to go along with it in most cases. This wish may be invoked up to three times per month per purchase.

100 cp - Nice Hat

Based on what is supposedly Link's most common wish, this wish... gives you a nice hat. That's it. That's all it does. According to Zoe, Link made this wish multiple times for some reason. Not entirely sure why. Maybe he kept losing them, or they weren't cool enough? This wish may be invoked up to three times per month per purchase.

200 cp - Catgirl

Based on Link's third wish, this wish will turn a person of your choice into an animal hybrid, such as the beloved anime catgirl. Side effects include coughing up hairballs and a propensity for puns. Optionally, this wish may automatically wear off after about a week, as being an animal person in some worlds isn't great. This wish may be invoked up to three times per year per purchase.

200 cp - Happy Wife

Based on Link's fourth wish, this wish drastically accelerates your relationship with the target and makes them significantly more submissive to you. So yeah, it's basically brainwashing them into becoming your sex slave. Morally dubious, but I like it. Optionally, this wish can wear off after about a week if you get bored of having a slave. This wish may be invoked up to three times per year per purchase.

200 cp - Genderswap

Based on the Pope's wish, this wish will turn the target into the opposite gender. For example, turning Link into Linkle, Ganon into a normal Gerudo, or Zoe into... I dunno, some kinda beach bum? The end result is largely up to you, but is guaranteed to be pretty damn sexy. Optionally, this can wear off after about a week if you want them back to normal. This wish may be invoked up to three times per year per purchase.

200 cp - Ganondorf

Based upon the Fake Zoe's wish, this wish transforms that target into a much more appealing form. Unlike a simple asset expansion, this one reworks the body from the ground up. A skinny nerd could become a hulking barbarian. Turning people into Ganondorf is entirely a valid choice, but is otherwise optional. This wish may be invoked up to three times per year per purchase.

400 cp - World Peace

Based upon Zoe's second wish, this wish destroys the local government and replaces it with a democracy that actually functions. Don't ask me how or why that qualifies as part of world peace, but seemingly it does. Or maybe that was just commentary on how the world would be more peaceful if Zoe wasn't a princess anymore? This wish may be invoked up to three times per Jump per purchase.

400 cp - One Million Rupees

Based upon Zoe's first wish, this wish gives you a ton of money. It's very simple, very short and to the point. Zoe should have actually wished for this instead of changing her mind to wish for something else, but alas. As Rupees are not always valuable, you may instead receive one million dollars in various gemstones if you wish. This wish may be invoked up to three times per Jump per purchase.

400 cp - Princess Zelda

Based on Link's accidental wish, this wish creates a copy of the target. Basically just instantly gives them their own twin sibling. Looks and acts nearly the same, but with a few subtle differences, such as a different hair color or slight personality alterations. This wish may be invoked up to three times per Jump per purchase.

Items

Knight

100 cp - Nintendo Switch

Yeah I know this is a bit meta, but you are now the proud owner of a Nintendo Switch with every Zelda game that was made for or ported to the Switch on it. At the time of writing, that is 18 games. Optionally, this may be one of the limited edition models themed after the Legend of Zelda if you so desire it. Because nothing says you have devotion to a princess like ignoring her to play the games about her ancestors, right? At the very least, if you have this then you probably won't be bored while you wait for all of the adventures you won't be going on to show up.

200 cp - Link's House

Even before accidentally wishing away the monarchy in Hyrule, Zoe was shacked up with Link. It makes sense for after, she didn't have a castle anymore, but why before? ...Eh, who cares. She probably got kicked out for being the exact opposite of Wise. Anyways, congrats, you now own a house! No it does not specifically need to be Link's house, though you can have a similar one if you like. Personally I always found the weapon mounts to be a bit tacky, I never kept anything for long enough to display them. If you so desire, you may base this around one of the other Link's homes and have it include a small smithy or perhaps an apple orchard.

400 cp - Knightly Things

Alright, alright, fine. I'll give you some actually useful stuff. First off, you have the Master Sword! However, as this version of Link is not actually 'the' Link, this version of the Master Sword is basically just a very shiny hunk of iron that stubbornly refuses to manifest any form of magical power. It's not bad, it's just lackluster. It might surprise you to know that Zoe uses it more than Link does. You can easily buy a better version elsewhere. Beyond that, you also have a regular sword, an ocarina, a horse, and your choice between the Goron Tunic and the Red Mail. That's not exactly a premium kit, but it should be enough to satisfy you.

600 cp - Majora's Mask

Uh. Why is this here? And why did Link think that it was a suitable christmas present to give to Zoe? Not that anything here makes much sense, but damn, that does not make sense. Wearing this mask gives you some fairly impressive telekinetic powers, it once pulled the moon out of orbit after all... or it would, if the mask was up to it. While normally the mask would give you those powers, then start to possess you, and then maybe hijack your body, currently it's... a bit Linkphobic. Or depressed from being offscreened by Link during Link Between Worlds. Suffice to say that its the closest thing to tame it's ever been, and is mostly interested in drinking a cold beer and maybe watching some porn right about now.

Princess

100 cp - Glasses

Man. We must really be going downhill if the heroes of this era are being held back by something as simplistic as bad vision. ...Oh wait, your eyes are fine? You just wear these because you think they make you look cute? Well, they certainly do that. Congratulations, you now have a pair of glasses. They're semi-stylish, go oddly well with everything, and also make you appear smarter than you actually are. Hopefully you actually are smart, unlike Zoe, otherwise that particular illusion will be ruined the moment you open your mouth.

200 cp - Cosplay

Rich girls own lots of clothes, right? And since you're probably a princess, or at least faking being one, that means you also need to have lots of clothes. Well you're in luck, because you now have an entire closet full of outfits. Specifically sexy ones. Swimsuits and lingerie, yes, but also cosplay. Tifa, Samus, Elizabeth, Dva, all this and more. Actually it's mostly cosplay. There are outfits that you might recognize as the signature look from literally every Zelda in here as well, if you ever feel like getting fucked while dressed up as your great great grandma or something like that. I suppose it's worth mentioning that these are all very high quality outfits - you could take them to just about any convention and get lots of guys drooling over you with them.

400 cp - Social Sites

Uh. Behold, the internet? To be honest I'm not really sure what's up with this version of Hyrule, but from here on out 99.9% of worlds you visit will have at least something that vaguely resembles the internet circa 2020 or so. Plus or minus five years. The local culture will probably warp it pretty heavily, you might see a bunch of new search engines - Hyrules search engine is probably named Nayru or some derivative thereof - but you can be sure that sites such as twitter, tiktok, and onlyfans will exist. Also you have accounts on all three, and a fairly large following if you so desire. If you're as hot as I think you are, it would be pretty easy for you to make a living just off those three sites. I mean, mostly onlyfans, but the other two shouldn't be discounted entirely.

600 cp - United States of Hyrule

Welcome to the Blue House, Miss President. What's that? White House? No silly, that's the United States of America. This is the United States of Hyrule, the nation that was accidentally created by Zoe when she wished for world peace. The 'united' part comes from the Gerudo, Goron, Rito, and Zora also being part of the nation. And maybe the Koroks/Kokiri as well. Either way, running a nation is a lot of responsibility, so I hope that you're prepared for long hours of work, for people blaming you for everything bad that happens, and for nobody to thank you when things go right. The good news, however, is that this places laws are one step short of literally divinely crafted and are fucking beautiful as a result. You're also only in charge for four years, eight if they re-elect you. Because Democracy, yeah? ...Don't fuck them up too badly in the proccess of crowing yourself queen if you decide you want to stay in charge, you hear me?

The Pope

100 cp - Secret Place

What is a wizard without his tower? What is the Pope without the Vatican? Poor, presumably. Which is what you are, since you have neither of those to your name. What you do have however is a small cave system that has been converted into an acceptable lair. There's a small library for you to store magic books in one branch, a nice throne room in another, living quarters over there, and of course a number of 'vaults' for you to store important magical artifacts. Do beware, however, as random caves full of magical things are practically catnip for adventurers. And this place doesn't have great security.

200 cp - Mirror of Mild Darkness

Ages ago, when the Twil were banished from this world, it was through the use of the Mirror of Twilight, which was used to trap them in the endless darkness of the Twilight Realm. This... is not that mirror. Sorry. This is, however, a fairly convincing replica of that mirror. It merely allows for short range teleportation, 'banishing' you from the immediate vicinity to another location. One that you have at least some control over. Which is to say, it can still be used to enter the Twilight Realm. Excellent for if you need to hire a Twil assassin or some such to hunt someone who has stolen from you down, no?

400 cp - Team Fortress's Number

So it turns out, before you were the Pope, you were an evil wizard. And during that time, you were roommates with a guy who was part of a mercenary team. Bad news, he was a horrible roommate and you probably hated his guts. Good news, you kept his number, he's poor, and you can pay to sic him and his team on people. Mind you, they're not the most competent people, even within their own company. That would be Team Ajax. Regardless, they're fucking crazy in a way that makes them dangerous, because they start with plans no one sane would think to defend against and only get worse from there.

600 cp - Wishing Moai

The source of, and solution to, all of life's problems. Behold! An artifact to surpass the Triforce, the ancient wish granting Moai Statue. This thing gets stolen more times than Ganon usurps other villains, you have no idea. However, for the sake of balance, let me tell you the mechanics. The Moai can grant three kinds of wishes. Three simple wishes per week, three medium wishes per month, and three large wishes per jump. Small ones affect one person, medium ones affect a group of people or an area up to a decently sized town, and large ones affect lots of people or an area up to a decently sized nation. Additionally, once per jump you may make an extremely large wish, one that potentially affects the entire planet. No screwing with the laws of physics. If you want to do that, you'll need to go find the triforce. If it matters, this is per person, so even if you use up all your wishes and someone steals it, well, they have their own wishes to ask for.

General

100 cp - Slutbucks

Think Starbucks, then make it hornier. This is Slutbucks. At first glance it's just a normal coffee shop that you can order your favorite drinks from, but the vast majority of the employees are cute girls and there's a secret menu that includes things like them putting their breast milk in your coffee. You get to choose if you're just a customer, a manager, or the owner who sits back and makes money. Also comes with a small supply of drugs that can induce lactation in women who aren't pregnant, in order to actually fill that iced latte with breast milk order. Unless you want to put the staff on the menu and get them pregnant enough to do so the old fashioned way.

300 cp - Monkeys Paw

Based upon a somewhat alternative take to the current situation, this is not a specific wish in and of itself, but rather another wishing device entirely. Up to five times per jump, you may make any wish you want, within the limits of what is seen in this world. However, every time you do, an equal and opposite effect will occur somewhere else. If you wish for your girlfriend to have larger breasts, perhaps several women you know will have theirs suddenly shrink. If she were to wish for world peace, perhaps another country would become a tyranny. Wish wisely, and mind the fallout. It's never far away.

Companions

100 cp / 300 cp - Companion Import

If you want to bring some of your companions into the jump with you, you can. You may import two of them for 100 cp, or eight of them for 300 cp. Regardless of how many you import, each companion gains 600 cp to play with and all the same choices you get, with the exclusion of them taking companions of their own or any drawbacks.

100 cp - Companion Export

If you're more interested in making new friends, I can also arrange that. With each purchase of this I'll arrange for you to have a meeting that leaves a good first impression with a character of your choice. Not many of them have any real level of detail to their lives, but if one of them appeals to you then by all means.

100 cp - Big Tiddy Milf Goth Hylian GF

That got your attention didn't it? Still, things have been a bit rough since Hyrule became a democracy, economic uncertainty is a shitty thing, but everyone has to make due during rough transition periods, like this fine woman right here. Mother of the former monarch, and now proud owner of a small record shop, this young looking entrepreneuress became an overnight sensation due to a simple fact: she looks like a slightly older goth version of the former monarch Zoe. With no one really catching on that she is in fact the mother. The thing was, she wasn't even trying to become an E-thot, though considering her daughter, maybe it was inevitable - that and everyone was just that thirsty. She also appreciates the money from the OF page pays enough that she can enjoy her time at the store doing what she likes. Rocking out, playing games, and cosplaying in honestly waaay too risky costumes for your enjoyment, as the only being to give a crap about her beyond boobs. Maybe you met while she was taking her daughter to school, or you really struck gold while playing some MMO. Whatever the case may be, you have an awesome GF, who is quite open about the whole new age idea of a polycule with other hot chicks. That and having a nice young boy to call daddy, much to Zoe's cringe, and growing interest.

100 cp - 100% Bio Farm Milk

In the E-thot war, if there is one certainty, beyond the willingness to sink to new lows in the name of exploiting simps dying of dehydration, is that every chick on the net is hot. That is in fact an issue for the common E-Thot, who needs something to make her different from all the others, and get the most cash. As such, niches are king. What we have here however is a girl waaay too busy for all that social media thing, she does have a life, you know. This girl next door is the dream of many, perfect face, killer figure, some cute freckles here and there, and a rack that is only manageable due to the muscles built by managing an entire damned dairy farm by herself, due to reasons she does not want to disclose. But like every girl, she needs some loving, and someone else to help on this damned place, and have a conversation with. Not just empty headed idiots that buy her produce more as an excuse to gawk at her. Or maybe you could suck up to a rich guy and try to get a sugar daddy?

As for why she's invading? ...She's completely obsessed with money and desires more men to simp over her and spend ever more on her. So she's going to steal all of the men (and lesbians) of Hyrule so that she can add their credit cards to her collection. She also has, if not the Lorulean Moai Statue, then something very similar that gives her entirely too much magical power.

+300 cp - Ice Cream So Good

Yeehaw yes. Thank you Destiny. Thank you Smoke. Oh, special. Gang gang, gang gan. Oh oh, oh oh. Meow. Meow. Girl power, girl power. Thank you Jonathan. ...A certain form of brainrot has infect Hyrule in this era. A specific, and quite possibly deliberate, lack of wisdom. Websites such as Twitter, Onlyfans, Facebook, Tiktok, and many others are not just social sites for people to post cute pictures and chat with each other, but an active detriment to the world as a whole. Why? Because they are intentionally draining the intelligence out of those who use them. And once that drain reaches a certain point, you'll find that the users are no longer capable of real speech, but instead merely endlessly parrot

buzzwords and catchprhases.
