Age and Gender

You can freely determine both your age and your gender for the purpose of this jump.

Origins

While there are several firefighting branches, firefighters are assigned wherever they are needed in emergency situations, regardless of their branch.

Firefighting Team

You are a newly graduated firefighter, having just completed your training at the fire academy. Armed with the essential skills and knowledge of firefighting techniques, you're ready to face the challenges of active duty. Whether it's combating structural fires, rescuing civilians, or managing hazardous situations, you are eager to prove your worth in the field. Though you may lack extensive experience, your training has prepared you to respond quickly and effectively under pressure, ready to learn from every emergency you face.

Rescue Team

You belong to a specialised branch dedicated to handling high-risk and complex rescue operations. Whether it's urban search and rescue, swift water rescues, or intricate technical extrications, your team is trained to respond to the most challenging and dangerous situations. Your skills are honed for navigating hazardous environments to save lives, often involving delicate procedures and equipment to extract victims safely.

Wildland Team

You are part of an elite team dedicated to the suppression and management of wildfires. Wildland firefighting demands endurance and adaptability as you face harsh, ever-changing conditions—ranging from intense heat to rugged, steep terrain. Working closely with local forestry agencies, your team's primary mission is to control and contain fires in forested and remote areas, often requiring specialised techniques and tools to prevent the spread of wildfires while ensuring the safety of both your team and nearby communities.

Hazmat Team

You are a crucial member of a specialised team focused on handling hazardous materials and chemical spills. Unlike traditional firefighting, your role involves containment, decontamination, and evacuation in environments tainted by toxic substances. Your team works to secure dangerous sites, neutralise threats from chemicals or biohazards, and ensure the safety of both civilians and responders. Precision, careful planning, and expert knowledge of hazardous substances are vital to your operations, as you mitigate risks and work to restore safety in hazardous environments.

Perks

Perks cost half for their origin. Discounted 100 CP perks are free.

General / Undiscounted

Firefighting Valedictorian [Free | 200 CP]

You didn't just graduate from the firefighter academy—you graduated as the top of your class. You possess all the expertise and practical knowledge of a highly skilled firefighter, from rescue techniques to fire suppression strategies. Your physical condition is exceptional: you can carry heavy equipment with ease, manoeuvre through dangerous environments effortlessly, and sustain peak performance for several hours of relentless rescue operations before feeling fatigue. Whether saving lives or tackling blazing infernos, you're the very definition of a firefighting professional.

For an additional 200 CP, this perk becomes part of your body mod.

Looking Hot Over There [100 CP]

While it is a cliche that all firefighters look amazing, you are that very cliche. You possess a great face, body and proportion that would easily make any of the people you rescue fawn over you. In fact, you would make for a permanent presence in the firefighter calendars during your time as a firefighter should you be willing.

Specialist Training [100 CP | Special]

Firefighting is a broad field, with different branches requiring specific skills and training to be effective—whether it's industrial firefighting, wildland firefighting, hazardous material handling, or search and rescue. Each specialty typically demands extensive training and experience to operate efficiently in the field. With this perk, you bypass the long training process and gain the foundational knowledge and skills necessary to perform competently in the specialisation of your choice.

This perk can be purchased multiple times, allowing you to gain expertise in different branches of firefighting.

Timely Arrival [200 CP]

Firefighting is a race against time, and responding to an emergency dispatch quickly is critical. While delays are inevitable in any profession, you seem to be blessed with an uncanny ability to make it to your destination right on time—or even earlier. Whether it's perfect traffic flow, optimal weather, or ideal transport conditions, everything seems to align in your favour when you need to respond to an emergency, ensuring that you can always be there when you're needed most.

Right of Way [200 CP]

Emergency vehicles have the right of way on the road when their siren and lights are activated — meaning, the vehicles on the road should split like the Red Sea with Moses. Unfortunately, many selfish drivers tend to ignore that rule. For you however, drivers on the road will always make an extra effort to allow you through unobstructed, no matter whether your sirens and lights are activated or not.

Quick Dress [200 CP]

Firefighters need to gear up fast when the alarm sounds, but traditional bunker gear takes time to don. Luckily, this isn't an issue for you. You can slip into or out of any clothing or equipment in the blink of an eye, no matter how bulky or complex it is. Whether it's firefighting gear, protective suits, or even casual outfits, you're always ready to go at a moment's notice, giving you extra time to focus on saving lives.

Occupational Protection [400 CP]

The demands of firefighting—irregular hours, extreme heat, and prolonged exposure to hazardous substances like smoke—often lead to long-term health risks, including cancers and disrupted circadian rhythms. Fortunately, you are immune to these occupational hazards and any related mundane diseases. No matter how gruelling or prolonged your exposure, your body remains unaffected, allowing you to dedicate yourself fully to the job without fear of physical deterioration.

Firefighting Team

Firefighter's Eyes [100 CP]

Navigating through a blazing inferno is a challenge few can handle, especially when thick smoke turns everything pitch black. Unlike the exaggerated clarity shown in movies, real-life visibility in such situations is near zero. Luckily, you possess an extraordinary ability: you can perceive the outlines of objects and structures in dark or smoke-filled environments as if they were highlighted in glowing white. Even more impressively, you can see the silhouettes of survivors through walls and debris, allowing you to locate and reach them with unparalleled speed and precision.

Heat Acclimatization [200cp]

Being exposed to intense heat over a long period of time can easily kill anybody. Fortunately, your body is much more resistant to heat, burns and dehydration, allowing you to somewhat shrug off the effects of fire and last much longer in such conditions to complete your objectives and make your way to a safer area.

Danger Sense (Environment) [400cp]

Responding to accidents and disasters can be dangerous as the conditions are volatile and can worsen at any given time. Collapsing grounds, live cables touching liquid surfaces, exploding fuel sources to say a few. Fortunately, you possess an innate sense that allows you to receive premonitions of such environmental dangers, and the general direction and location, seconds before they happen.

Universal Extinguisher [600 CP]

Not all fires are created equal—grease fires, electrical blazes, chemical infernos, and more—each demanding specialised approaches and tools to control. Luckily, you bypass these complexities entirely. Your methods and equipment are universally effective against any type of fire, allowing you to extinguish blazes all the same, regardless of their nature or origin.

Rescue Team

Rescue Engineering [100 CP]

Rescuing victims often means extracting them from precarious situations, be it being crushed under debris or trapped in a crushed vehicle. A wrong move could further worsen the situation and collapse everything on the survivor. Fortunately for you, you possess a deep insight for structural mechanics and physics, allowing you to identify the safest and most efficient rescue routes. You can efficiently break down structures to faster reach people, or stabilise precarious environments and predict collapses to keep everyone safe during an extraction.

Rescue Diver [200 CP]

Not all emergencies happen on solid ground—sometimes, lives are at stake underwater. Rescue diving presents unique challenges, from the dangers of underwater debris to the unpredictability of panicked victims. Thankfully, you are a master of diving and aquatic rescue, with the skills and expertise to handle even the most perilous water-based scenarios. Moreover, you emit a calming presence that soothes those in distress, reducing panic and ensuring smoother, safer rescues for everyone involved.

Crisis Communication [400 CP]

Disasters often breed chaos and panic, but your voice cuts through the turmoil like a lifeline. You possess an exceptional talent for delivering clear, calm instructions that instil confidence and focus in those around you. Whether guiding frightened victims to safety or coordinating a complex rescue operation, your words inspire trust and rally people to action, even in the most chaotic environments. People naturally defer to your leadership in emergencies, and your presence becomes a stabilising force amidst the disorder.

Paramedic Expertise [600cp]

As a firefighter, you're not just trained to fight flames but also to save lives in medical emergencies. While most are trained as Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs), you've gone above and beyond, achieving the expertise of a fully qualified paramedic. This grants you advanced knowledge and skills in emergency medical care, from trauma management to administering lifesaving interventions. Additionally, you may choose to have conditions you treat to be fixed at that state, unable to deteriorate further until they reach professional medical care, ensuring their best chance at survival.

Wildland Team

Ember Tracker [100 CP]

Spotting the origins of wildfires or hidden embers in a forested area can be like finding a needle in a haystack. Not for you. You possess an almost preternatural ability to track fire movement and detect lingering, or smouldering, embers, no matter how hidden. This skill ensures you can prevent a fire outbreak at its root, stop a fire from reigniting and allows you to anticipate the direction and intensity of its spread with incredible accuracy.

Nature's Ally [200 CP]

Wildland fires present unique challenges, with abundant fuel and unpredictable winds capable of transforming a small blaze into a raging inferno in moments. Thankfully, you possess an innate ability to read the natural environment. You can easily predict wind shifts, weather changes, and fire behaviour in outdoor settings, giving you a critical advantage in managing and controlling wildfires before they spiral out of control.

Rapid Deployment [400 CP]

In wildland fires, every second is critical, but the challenging terrain—mountains, dense forests, or rugged cliffs—can slow even the most seasoned firefighter. Not for you. You excel at navigating such environments with remarkable ease, conserving stamina even on the toughest routes. You also have an uncanny ability to identify the safest and quickest paths, ensuring you and your team reach your destination efficiently, no matter how hazardous the surroundings.

Controlled Burn [600cp]

Sometimes you have to fight fire with another fire. By burning a designated area beforehand, one is able to ecologically thin out the resources required for the fire to spread further. Similarly, you can perform this feat with other phenomena to similar effect. For example, should you flood a designated area beforehand, a tsunami will find it difficult, but not impossible, to breach past the once-flooded area.

Hazmat Team

Chemical Analysis [100 CP]

Hazardous substances and chemicals often pose a challenge due to their deceptive appearances, lack of odour, or overlapping effects. Fortunately, you possess an exceptional ability to detect and identify any chemical or hazardous material, regardless of its form. Whether it's a scentless gas, an invisible flame like methanol fire, or a complex compound, you can recognize it instantly and accurately.

Rapid Decontamination [200 CP]

Dealing with hazardous materials often requires extensive decontamination procedures, but you can perform this process quickly and effectively. Whether it's a person, equipment, or an environment, you can remove all traces of contamination in a fraction of the usual time without the need for specialised tools. Your decontamination process is thorough, ensuring there are no lingering hazards and making recovery efforts safer and more efficient.

Hazardous Resistance [400 CP]

Handling hazardous materials often means risking exposure, even with the best protective gear. Luckily, your body is exceptionally resistant to the effects of chemicals and toxins, requiring significantly prolonged contact or accumulation before any harm manifests. Furthermore, your body naturally detoxifies and purges itself of these substances, be it physical such as mercury or ionising radiation, slowly over time—unless you choose to retain them for some reason.

Chemically Inert [600 CP]

The volatile nature of hazardous materials—whether through toxic reactions, explosions, or rapid vaporisation—makes them particularly dangerous. With this perk, all such materials temporarily become completely inert while in your vicinity. They will not react, spread, or change state, allowing you to neutralise their threat and focus on cleanup or evacuation without fear of escalation.

Items

You receive three floating discounts. Discounted 100 CP items are free.

Fire Helmet [Free]

A sturdy, high-impact helmet worn by firefighters around the world. It offers protection from the impact of falling debris, ensuring your head remains safe during hazardous situations. The helmet comes in a variety of colours and styles depending on your rank or unit.

Bunker Gear [Free]

This upgraded version of standard firefighter attire includes a turnout coat, turnout trousers, boots, and gloves, designed for exceptional durability and protection. It offers significantly greater resistance to fire, heat, and smoke than typical gear, enabling you to remain in extreme conditions for extended periods without compromising safety or performance.

Firefighter's Axe [50cp]

A premium-quality, high-grade steel axe built for heavy-duty use in rescue and firefighting operations. It is virtually indestructible and specially designed to effortlessly breach structures, break through barriers, and clear debris. Whether used to pry open doors or chop through walls, this axe is a reliable tool for tackling the toughest obstacles in emergency situations.

Multi-Gas Detector [100 CP]

This compact device combines the capabilities of multiple gas detection systems into one, ensuring you can safely monitor your environment for harmful gases such as carbon monoxide, smoke, and other toxic substances. Upon detecting significant levels of any hazardous gas, it emits a loud and unmistakable alarm, ensuring that everyone nearby is alerted to the danger. Additionally, the device can easily be integrated into any hardware or system of your choice, providing seamless connectivity and functionality.

A fresh supply of these detectors is provided to you monthly, so you will always have access to the latest batch for your safety needs.

Firefighter Calendar Collection [100cp]

Each year, you'll receive a limited edition calendar filled with stunning or playful photos of firefighters in various professional or more daring poses. You can choose to be one of the featured firefighters in the calendar, and for your participation, you'll receive a payment of \$10,000. If you prefer, you can simply enjoy the calendar in its entirety, showcasing firefighters of your preferred gender.

Backpack Pump [100cp]

This 20-litre backpack features a built-in hose that lets you control the flow of water, whether you prefer a steady stream or a wide spray. It dispenses water at a rate of 10 litres per minute, but the best part? The backpack contains an infinite supply of water, so you never need to worry about running out. Additionally, the water is always maintained at the perfect pressure, so there's no need to manually pump it.

Safety Air Cushion [200cp]

This advanced inflatable mat is always fully inflated and ready for use, eliminating the need for setup or deployment time. Upon impact, it instantly neutralises the force of any fall, completely negating any fall damage for anyone or anything that lands on it. You can summon it at will, and it will automatically disappear once its purpose has been fulfilled, making it an efficient and reliable tool in emergency situations or when traversing dangerous heights.

Pancake Breakfast and Chili Feed [200cp]

Each month, you can host a community event featuring delicious meals like pancakes and chilli, all prepared to perfection. This event brings in a steady income of \$5,000, thanks to a nominal charge for guests attending. Alternatively, you can choose to hold a private gathering, serving the same mouth-watering pancakes and chilli to your party. While it won't generate any income in this case, the food is so good, it might just become the highlight of your month.

Fireman's Pole [200cp]

This is a magical pole that allows you to quickly slide down to any level, just like the ones used in fire stations. However, unlike standard poles, you can summon and unsummon it at will, no matter where you are. Upon summoning, the ground beneath you opens up, and the pole extends downward to the desired level. Once unsummoned, the opening closes seamlessly, and the ground returns to its original state. Perfect for swift descents or quick escapes!

Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus [300cp]

This advanced breathing apparatus functions as an all-in-one air supply system. Unlike traditional gas masks that rely on external tanks or filters, this device is fully self-contained, providing a continuous supply of breathable air from an internal reserve. You can now breathe indefinitely, regardless of the surrounding environment, and be immune to harmful gases, smoke, or any toxic atmosphere, allowing you to operate in hazardous conditions without concern for air quality or limitations.

Fire Shelter [300cp]

This advanced fire shelter is a lifesaver for wildland firefighters when caught in extreme conditions. When you take cover under this heat-resistant sheet, it creates an impenetrable barrier against intense flames, preventing them from reaching you. Inside, the temperature remains cool, the air stays fresh, and the humidity is balanced for comfort, ensuring you can breathe easily. You will remain safe and isolated from the fire until you no longer need the shelter, providing you with the time you need to wait out the danger.

Cloud Seeds [400cp]

This satchel contains a collection of dark grey seeds with a unique property: when ignited, they release a special vapour that rapidly condenses in the sky, forming thick rain clouds. These clouds will quickly gather and produce a heavy downpour in the surrounding area, offering a reliable means of water control or dousing fires. The satchel is replenished each day, ensuring you always have a fresh supply of seeds at your disposal.

Fire Engine [400 cp]

This cutting-edge fire engine combines the features of every type of specialised fire truck. Whether it's powerful rotary fans for ventilating fumes, advanced hazmat storage and equipment, or heavy-duty tools for rescue operations, this vehicle has it all. It also boasts an endless water supply, allowing you to combat fires tirelessly without needing a hydrant connection. Fully self-cleaning and self-maintaining, the engine automatically restores itself to peak condition after every deployment, ensuring it's always ready for the next emergency.

Fire Service Academy [500 CP]

This prestigious academy offers comprehensive training for aspiring firefighters, equipping them with all the necessary skills for firefighting, emergency evacuations, rescue operations, and more. The academy features state-of-the-art practical training facilities, such as towering buildings for rappelling exercises, simulated accident scenes for vehicle extrication drills, and other specialised environments to hone real-world skills. Graduates of this academy are trained with the expertise of a seasoned firefighter, having gained years of hands-on experience. The academy is fully autonomous, running smoothly without any oversight or assistance from you.

You can choose to have it appear at any location of your choice in future Jumps, appear as a warehouse attachment, or both.

Companions

Canon Firefighter [Free]

You may recruit any person that you meet during this Jump, provided that you have convinced them to join you in your adventures across the Jumpchain.

Import Characters [50 CP | 200 CP]

You can import companions as any of the stated origins, or create new companions, for 50 CP each or 200 CP to import up to eight companions. Imported or created companions gain 600 CP to spend. Companions cannot import other companions.

Scenarios

The following scenarios are optional, and you are able to select as many as you wish.

Scenario #1: Historical Worst Disaster

During your Jump, a catastrophic event will unfold in your assigned dispatch area. This disaster will involve a combination of extreme phenomena, such as earthquakes, tsunamis, and hurricanes, occurring either simultaneously or in quick succession. The disaster will strike a major capital city, leading to a devastating death toll that exceeds four digits over the course of a couple weeks.

Your primary objective in this scenario is to save at least half of the individuals who would otherwise perish. While you are not required to handle every rescue personally, the efforts of others in aiding the victims will count towards your total, as long as you have some influence in their rescue.

Restriction

- You will have no prior knowledge of the event, including its occurrence, location, or specific details. The moment the disaster begins, you will suddenly gain the clarity of your mission and your objective.
- You will not be able to use any perks, abilities, or items acquired or purchased from previous Jumps for the duration of this scenario.

Reward

Disaster Foiler [Perk]

You have become an antithesis to disaster. In your presence, natural and man-made catastrophes are significantly diminished. Floods are reduced to mere puddles, typhoons become light gusts, and earthquakes shake only the faintest tremor. Disasters that would normally devastate entire areas are toned down to manageable levels, ensuring that while danger still looms, the severity is dramatically lessened, protecting both life and property from the worst of the chaos.

Scenario #2: Pride In Our Past. Trained For Tomorrow.

Firefighting is a noble and essential profession, but its physical demands and inherent dangers can deter many from pursuing it. To inspire the next generation, junior firefighting and cadet programs are established worldwide, targeting youths as young as 10. These programs range from short summer camps lasting 18 weeks to comprehensive, multi-year cadet initiatives with probationary periods. While participants gain valuable skills and knowledge, all training is conducted in safe environments with zero exposure to real emergencies until they reach the legal age.

In this scenario, you will enrol in and graduate from multiple junior firefighter programs, immersing yourself in its teachings and traditions. Your goal is twofold: first, to complete multiple programs and experience the foundational training firsthand; and second, to leave a lasting positive impact on the programs, improving its structure or influence for future generations.

Upon reaching the legal age, you are required to join the firefighting force, as outlined in the Jump's Introduction.

Restriction

- You will begin this Jump as a 15-year-old, participating in various junior firefighter programs, including summer camps and multi-year cadet training, until you have reached the legal age to join the firefighting force.
- Any out-of-context perks, abilities and items will be disabled for the duration of the program.

Rewards

1. Firefighting Valedictorian [Perk]

For having amassed a plethora of firefighting experience and knowledge and graduating from multiple junior firefighter and cadet programs, you will receive the 200 CP version of the perk [Firefighting Valedictorian].

2. Rookie Star [Perk]

Joining a new organisation often comes with awkward initiations or hazing rituals that can sometimes go too far. Thankfully, this is never a concern for you. Any initiation you experience will be lighthearted and enjoyable, leaving everyone involved in high spirits. Beyond that, you'll seamlessly integrate into the team, quickly earning their respect and camaraderie. Your dedication and enthusiasm for your role shine through, ensuring no one harbours any negative feelings toward you. You'll always be seen as a valued and passionate member of the crew from the very start.

Drawbacks

You may pick as many drawbacks as you like; there is no limit.

Extended Stay [100 CP, up to 500 CP]

You gain 100 CP for every additional 10 years you stay in this Jump. You can only gain a maximum of 500 CP via this way.

Power Lock [100 CP]

For the duration of this Jump, all abilities and perks that are not purchased from this document or acquired from this Jump is disabled.

Item Lock [100 CP]

For the duration of this Jump, all items that are not purchased from this document or acquired from this Jump is disabled

Warehouse Lock [100 CP]

You are unable to access your warehouse and any of its variants for the duration of this Jump.

Companion Lock [200 CP]

During the duration of this Jump, your companions may not join you in this Jump. They can still be imported and purchase perks and items, but they are unable to step into this world. You have to experience this Jump by yourself.

Wait, You Guys Are Getting Paid? [100 CP]

Your dedication to the noble ideals of firefighting is unparalleled—so much so that you take it to an extreme. You steadfastly refuse to accept any form of payment for your work as a firefighter, insisting that all funds be redirected to the department or your colleagues' welfare.

Urban Hell [200 CP]

Fire engines are large and require ample space to manoeuvre, but in this world, drivers seem to lack any sense of courtesy. Illegally parked cars and obstructive vehicles will frequently block your path, making it nearly impossible to drive your fire engine to the scene. As a result, you'll often be forced to abandon your vehicle, hauling heavy equipment on foot through crowded streets, wasting valuable time and energy due to the disregard of others.

Beefing with Cops [200 CP]

It seems that the infamous rivalry between cops and firefighters has become a permanent presence around you. Expect the cops to scrutinise the letter of the law to its very word when it comes to you — they will take every opportunity they can to harrass you such as clamping your vehicle wheels and more.

It Hasn't Rained Since The 80s [200cp]

You have an uncanny ability to keep the skies clear and sunny wherever you go. While this might sound like a blessing, it means that rainfall is a rare occurrence in your vicinity. No matter how much you might wish for it, you'll find that rain will not fall in your area, even in the most desperate moments. This makes firefighting even harder, as you'll have to rely solely on other methods to put out the flames, without the natural aid of water from the sky.

Sir, This is a Fire Station [300cp]

You're about to become the go-to person for all the wrong reasons. The number of nuisance or irrelevant calls your fire station receives has skyrocketed, and you'll be answering three times as many as usual. From people calling in about their cat stuck in a tree to complaints about noisy neighbours, you'll find yourself spending far too much time dealing with issues that have nothing to do with actual fires or emergencies. Your patience will be tested as you navigate these distractions while trying to stay focused on your real work.

Not That Kind of Fire Fighting [400cp]

It seems that some of your comrades have a rather unfortunate misunderstanding of the term "firefighting." Across every crew you encounter, there will always be at least one member with arsonist tendencies. These individuals are driven to ignite fires or worsen already dangerous situations, seemingly locked in a global competition to create the most catastrophic inferno.

Catching them in the act is nearly impossible—they are experts at hiding their actions. Even if you manage to expose one and have them removed, another with similar tendencies is likely to join the ranks, ensuring the cycle of sabotage continues. Prepare to navigate constant chaos and mistrust within your teams as you struggle to combat both the fires and those secretly setting them.

Ego & Pride [400 CP]

It seems that every fire department you join or encounter holds their traditions and pride above all else. They are fiercely resistant to change, clinging to outdated methods, equipment, and techniques despite advancements in firefighting. This stubborn adherence to the old ways means that your colleagues may struggle with efficiency and modern challenges, leaving you to take on the bulk of the work and find creative solutions to save the day.

Detective Conan Firefighter Jumper [600cp]

You have an uncanny ability to be at the epicentre of major disasters. Whether it's a catastrophic fire, an explosion, or an unexpected calamity, something significant tends to happen at least once a week, often in the most chaotic and unexpected ways.
