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Introduction

In a world similar to modern-day Earth, a virtual reality known as Tsukuyomi exists. Within this digital world, everyone is encouraged to become a creator, producing content for others to enjoy. Tsukuyomi offers countless idols, streamers, and forms of entertainment, but it also allows people to compete for pleasure or settle disputes through a game called KASSEN.

This virtual world is widely used, with its most prominent figure being Yachiyo Runami, a virtual idol who also serves as the administrator of Tsukuyomi. Despite the existence of such advanced technology, the overall level of development differs little from that of Earth in 2026. However, a deeper secret lies hidden within the moon, one that humanity has yet to uncover. The story begins when an ordinary high school student, Iroha Sakayori, discovers a baby inside a telephone pole while walking home from her part-time job.

You will begin your adventure in this world one week before the comet carrying Kaguya arrives in the modern era, and you will remain here for a decade. As there are a few locations of major relevance to the story, you may choose anywhere on Earth as your starting point.

Take these +1000 Choice Points to begin your journey in this virtual, star-crossed world.

Origins

Any origin can be taken as Drop-In.

Regular Student

You're an ordinary student attending the same high school as Iroha in Tokyo, Japan. Depending on your choice, you may have caring parents or strict ones with high expectations, or you may be an orphan doing your best to get by. Regardless of the circumstances, you have moved out of your original home and now live alone in an apartment near your school.

Cosmic Royalty

In this universe, humanity is not alone, and now you are living proof of that. You are a special lifeform originating from the moon or another planet within the solar system. Though you are alien in nature, you possess a human appearance, along with abilities far beyond what humans are capable of. Your reason for coming to Earth remains your own. Perhaps you seek amusement, or perhaps you are pursuing a certain runaway princess. The choice is entirely yours.

Virtual Resident

Work has never felt easier when you are doing something you truly love. You are one of the many creators within the virtual world, Tsukuyomi, earning money by producing items, developing games, streaming, singing, or pursuing other creative ventures. You may even have a modest but loyal fanbase supporting your work. Despite your online presence, your real-world identity remains completely unknown. Perhaps you are merely a student, a businessman, or even a world-hopping adventurer. Who you truly are is entirely up to you to decide.

You can choose your age and gender freely for all origins, as long as it's within reason.

Perks

Perks are discounted 50% for their respective Origin, with the 100 CP Perks being free.

Regular Student

Model Student (- 100 CP)

You possess extraordinary academic talent, capable of learning at ten times your normal rate within an educational institution such as a school. You absorb your teacher's lessons effortlessly, becoming a model student regardless of the subject. In addition, you can wear the mask of a perfect student, concealing your pain, fatigue, and sadness so that no one notices. Even when you are on the verge of collapsing from exhaustion, you can maintain this facade and answer a teacher's question flawlessly.

JumperP (-200 CP)

Every idol needs a composer if they cannot write their own songs, and fortunately, you are more than capable of filling that role. You are an exceptional composer, able to craft beautiful melodies on the spot, and any song you release quickly rises to prominence. You are especially skilled with the piano and possess remarkable talent in using Vocaloid to produce music. Beyond composition, you have an instinct for choosing the perfect words to match the emotions of your symphonies, allowing you to write powerful and fitting lyrics. When people hear your songs, they clearly understand the emotions and message you intend to convey, if you wish.

A Love Across the Stars (-400 CP)

This setting revolves around an extraterrestrial girl who falls in love at first sight with a human girl. Now, you are blessed with a similar fortune. Individuals of the same sex as you will fall under your charm, developing both romantic and sexual attraction just as readily as those of the opposite sex. This effect is especially potent on beings who are not native to your home planet, causing those from other worlds to fall in love with you almost instantly. You can build a deep emotional bond within a matter of days and form a romantic relationship within a week. If you choose to return their feelings, you can create a love that endures the test of time.

Gimme a Happy Ending! (-600 CP)

Many stories don't end happily, but with this perk, yours doesn't have to end the same. When you strive to change the conclusion of what happened, you gain the ability to achieve what would normally be impossible. If you wish to reach a lover on another planet, your song can somehow carry across the stars. If you seek to give a digital being a physical form, you can develop an advanced android body within a few years, even if such a feat has never been accomplished in that world before. So long as you refuse to give up on pursuing your happy ending, miracles will occur. No matter how dire the situation or how long it takes, the impossible can become possible when you decide to change a tragedy to bring about a better outcome.

Cosmic Royalty

Alien Chef (-100 CP)

You possess culinary skills that are truly out of this world. Even with ordinary ingredients, the meals you prepare rival five-star restaurant quality. You instinctively understand how to handle a wide variety of ingredients, how to prepare them properly, and how to recreate dishes typically found in professional kitchens. Whenever you enter a new jump, you may choose to gain knowledge of the common ingredients in that setting, including how to handle and prepare them, along with the recipes for popular dishes commonly served in its restaurants.

Moon's Beauty (-200 CP)

You now possess the same ethereal beauty possessed by Kaguya-hime from *The Tale of the Bamboo Cutter*. Your beauty is otherworldly, radiant like moonlight itself, captivating both men and women alike. Yours is a peerless beauty that, in ancient times, could have driven entire nations to war. In the modern era, your face alone is enough to propel you to the top ranks of the idol industry if you choose to pursue that path. With genuine effort, becoming the world's number one idol is well within your reach.

8000 Years Dedication (-400 CP)

Waiting eight thousand years for someone demands extraordinary dedication and willpower, and that is precisely what you now have. Your patience is unmatched, allowing you to pursue a goal for millennia without faltering, supported by equally immense willpower. Even when confronted with the horrors of human history over thousands of years, you will not succumb to despair. Your resolve and motivation strengthen whenever you set a target, never giving up or swayed by temptation, no matter the obstacles in your path.

Cosmic Kaguya (-600 CP)

It seems Kaguya isn't the only space royalty around. You are a digital being given flesh, able to slightly alter your appearance, including your eyes, eyebrows, hair, and skin tone. Your aptitude for technology is extraordinary: for example, you could code a 2D pixel game in just a few hours after learning to code. With enough time, you could even create a virtual world so realistic that it is nearly indistinguishable from real life.

You also gain a 1-up. When you die or receive a fatal, unrecoverable wound, a comet will appear in the sky carrying your soul, striking a pole-like object such as a bamboo or telephone pole, and allowing you to be reborn inside it. You will return as an infant and grow to your prime within a week. This 1-up refreshes only once every ten years or at the start of a new jump.

Virtual Resident

Professional Streamer (-100 CP)

In the modern era, streaming can become a full-fledged career, and you excel at it. You have a keen understanding of popular trends and content, allowing you to attract viewers easily. You are skilled at crafting jokes and humor that make most people laugh, and you know how to secure brand deals and create merchandise for your personal brand. With these abilities, reaching the top ranks as a streamer is well within your grasp.

Reality's Your Stage (-200 CP)

Performing as an idol can be difficult without a proper stage, but with this perk, the world itself becomes your stage. You gain the ability to manipulate reality in ways that enhance your performance. You can create platforms to stand on, make lights appear, manifest creatures you control, instantly change clothing, recreate scenery, and make structures glow.

Essentially, this ability brings any visual effect you imagine to life. However, nothing you create can cause real harm. For example, replacing air with water will still allow people to breathe, and any weapons you create will pass harmlessly through others. Its range is initially limited to an area the size of a stadium, though with training, you can expand it further.

Virtual Warrior (-400 CP)

Who says playing video games can't improve real-world skills? With this perk, they absolutely can. Your proficiency in video games now directly enhances combat-related abilities. Excelling at an FPS dramatically improves your shooting skills and aim, allowing you to snipe targets from great distances. Mastery of fighting games boosts your abilities in a martial art of your choice, such as kung fu, muay thai, etc. Skill in sword-based games enhances your proficiency with a sword. If your gaming skills reach the level of professional e-sports players, your combat abilities allow you to take on large groups with ease.

World's No.1 Virtual Idol (-600 CP)

Rising to the top as a virtual idol is no easy feat, but with this perk, you have nothing to worry about. You gain divine-level skill in dancing, moving perfectly to any tune with every step exuding grace and elegance, and possessing the stamina to dance all day without tiring.

Your singing is equally extraordinary, capable of moving hearts and even calming babies with your melodies, easily earning you dedicated fans. Like Yachiyo, you can create controllable copies of yourself that function as a hivemind, sharing sensations if desired. There is no limit to the number of clones you can create, though each consumes stamina to maintain, so creating too many at once will tire you. You may instead produce smaller clones that require less stamina.

All clones inherit your abilities, perks, and copies of your clothing and items on your person. Additionally, as a virtual idol, you can instantly mimic any voice you hear, replace your own voice, and even combine multiple voices to create entirely new ones.

Items

You get one discount for each price tier of items.

Items are discounted 50% for their respective Origin, with the 100 CP Items being freebies.

Similar items can be imported without extra cost.

Cosmic Keytar (Free)

A white keytar with glowing accents, equipped with an internal synthesizer engine. It can function as a MIDI controller, connecting to other devices to configure its sounds, but it does not require any connection to produce music. The keytar's sound is crystal clear, indistinguishable from real instruments rather than digital reproductions. It requires no power, is nearly indestructible, and never needs maintenance.

Virtual Clothing (Free)

A closet filled with clothing worn by characters from Cosmic Princess Kaguya, whether from promotional material, music videos, or the movie itself. The closet can also connect to any device to materialize digital outfits from games, videos, or other media on your device to wear them in real life. These clothes lose any special effects they had digitally and function as ordinary clothing. All outfits in the closet are automatically cleaned and repaired.

Each piece is made perfectly comfortable for any environment, adapting to temperature and conditions, and is adjusted to fit you flawlessly. The closet itself requires no maintenance and is nearly indestructible.

Rent-Free Apartment (-100 CP)

You are now the proud owner of a fully furnished, luxurious two-story Japanese apartment. You may freely choose the interior design and furniture style. All utilities are fully covered, and you never have to pay rent. The apartment includes a soundproof room perfect for streaming, which you can import into any building you own in future jumps.

Plain Hard Cash (-100 CP)

Iroha struggles to balance her part-time job, rent, tuition, and maintaining high grades, making life extremely stressful. With this item, that won't be an issue. You receive 100 million dollars in the country you're in, with no questions asked and no suspicion over your possession of it. You will receive another 100 million every ten years or at the start of a new jump.

Octopus Inventory (-200 CP)

A pink flapjack octopus roughly the size of a human abdomen. This creature can act as a pseudo-inventory, storing any items that fit in its mouth, though it cannot store living beings. It can hold up to 64 items at once. If you have an inventory perk or item, the octopus can connect to it, sharing the inventory space. It can also be attached to clothing, becoming part of an outfit without causing any discomfort. This octopus requires no food or care, does not age or get sick, and is extremely difficult to kill. If it does die, it will respawn within a few hours.

Digital Pet (-200 CP)

A digital pet capable of existing in both the real and digital worlds at will. You may choose its appearance, but it must resemble a small animal, such as a dog or sea slug, with a cute, plush-like design rather than a realistic one. You can directly control its body if you wish, using it like a vessel. The pet can speak, is fiercely loyal, and would never betray you. It can also interact with technology, for example, serving as a projector for a holographic display.

Virtual Weapons (-400 CP)

Weapons in Tsukuyomi are unique, combining multiple functions into a single tool. You may choose a weapon from *Cosmic Princess Kaguya!* or design your own, though custom designs cannot exceed the power of the original weapons from the setting. Examples include a bamboo hammer with rocket propellers that can launch electric eels, a bladed boomerang that separates into twin blades capable of firing energy slashes, a blue hardlight oil-paper umbrella that blocks bullets and functions like a chainsaw, and a Kanabou with a removable club end that reveals a katana blade, which the club end can transform into a gun. Whatever weapon you select, it requires no maintenance, is nearly indestructible, and has infinite ammunition.

Smart Contacts (-400 CP)

A small black case containing a special pair of contact lenses. The case functions like a miniature computer, while the contacts allow you to interact with the internet through augmented reality. Their primary purpose, however, is to connect you to the virtual world of Tsukuyomi. In future jumps, these contacts can be used to enter any virtual or digital world in the setting, regardless of distance. The equipment requires no maintenance and never runs out of power. You also receive a set of controllers necessary to operate the lenses and move freely in virtual reality.

Tsukuyomi World (-600 CP)

Here it is, the central stage of most events: the virtual world of Tsukuyomi. Shaped like a pancake, this world is hyper-realistic, almost indistinguishable from real life. It currently lacks taste and smell; however, these functions could be added with further development and equipment. You receive a copy of Tsukuyomi, allowing you to either keep its original aesthetic, a mix of ancient Japanese style and cyberpunk, or design your own. As the admin and owner, you are nearly omnipotent and omniscient within Tsukuyomi, able to do anything you desire as long as the hardware can handle it and you can code it into the world. The virtual world's server can be housed in any structure you own. It is nearly indestructible, never runs out of power, and automatically performs maintenance and fixes minor bugs on its own.

A Real Body (-600 CP)

A humanoid android body that perfectly mimics human functions. Its appearance is customizable or can match the being inhabiting it. Despite being made of metal, the skin feels soft to the touch, though the body remains relatively heavy. The android can eat, drink, simulate sleep, experience the five human senses, and connect to the internet independently. It also includes adult functions depending on the chosen gender.

The android has no AI or consciousness of its own; it is designed as a vessel for any digital or incorporeal being, capable of transferring them from any device, no matter how advanced or exotic, into this body. It features self-maintenance and a large battery that allows it to operate for a week without charging. The body can recharge itself by consuming biomass to convert into energy or by directly absorbing energy.

Companions

Import Companion (-50 CP)

You can spend 50 CP to import an existing companion or create a brand-new original companion. The companion can choose any origin, get all the discounts related to that origin, and the freebies that origin provides. The companion gets +600 CP to spend on perks and items.

This option can be purchased multiple times.

Canon Companion (-50 CP)

By paying 50 CP, if you can convince a character in this jump to join your journey before this jump ends, you may recruit them as a companion. This option will make it so that you'll have several chances to meet the character you chose in a favorable condition.

A Certain Cosmic Princess for You (-50CP)

It seems you are not the only one to encounter an extraterrestrial princess. You discover an infant from outer space inside a telephone pole, an infant who will grow into a young adult within days. At first, she remembers very little and doesn't even know her own name, yet she has fallen in love with you at first sight and refuses to take no for an answer. She is clingy, craving your attention and easily jealous when it is given to someone else, though her jealousy manifests in a way so cute it is hard to be angry at her.

She is extroverted, hyper, emotional, kind, and a little eccentric. Despite her flaws, she deeply cares for you and prioritizes your well-being. As an alien, she possesses extraordinary technological talent, absorbing knowledge effortlessly and even creating programs she has never learned in record time. With enough time, she could even develop a fully realized virtual world on her own. She is skilled at cooking and has a beautiful singing voice, with the potential to become a great singer if she devotes herself to it.

Being an energy-based lifeform with a physical body, she does not age beyond a certain point. In the future, she will return to her home and time-travel to meet you immediately afterward. However, something went wrong, and she arrived 8,000 years before you entered this jump. Over that long span, she has mellowed, becoming calmer and losing some of her earlier cheerfulness. Over this long period, she has laid out various plans and mastered new abilities in preparation for your reunion. It's possible that, for a time, her past self and her current self were with you simultaneously. Once her past self departs to preserve the time paradox, she will reveal herself, hoping your feelings for her remain unchanged.

Normally, she must wait 8,000 years to reunite with you, but perhaps you can change that. This companion can be Kaguya herself if you wish. Although doing so will significantly alter the story based on your interactions with her, replacing Iroha's role and requiring you to provide a body for Kaguya once she returns to Earth, if you let the story run its course.

Drawbacks

Rival Sibling (+100 CP)

There's a saying: when there's an outside enemy, your sibling is your greatest ally, but when there's no danger, your sibling can become your biggest enemy. This drawback embodies that perfectly. You gain a sibling of your preferred gender who is highly competitive and persistently annoying. They excel at all your hobbies, often outperforming you effortlessly, and they show up at events you participate in just to one-up you.

You'll frequently encounter them in the areas of entertainment you enjoy most, even appearing in collaborations with your favorite streamers. While they will step in to help if you are in real danger or despair, in everyday moments, they are your toughest competitor.

Iroha's Special (+100 CP)

It's unfortunate, but now everything you cook will taste like Iroha's water-and-flour pancakes. Every meal you prepare or assist with will turn into a completely bland, flavorless mush that even starving people wouldn't want to eat. You'll need to rely on a personal chef or order takeout, because you won't be cooking anything yourself during this jump ever again.

Back to School (+200 CP)

It's school season, and now it's time for you to return to class. This drawback requires you to complete a full high school education in Japan. You cannot skip grades, must maintain a decent score, and keep high attendance. You must graduate legally, and you may choose any high school in Japan. Failing to graduate before the jump ends will result in failing the jump entirely.

Life of Poverty (+200 CP)

This drawback gives you terrible spending habits and poor money management, keeping you in near-constant poverty. If you're not careful, any savings you accumulate will disappear almost instantly. Any items or perks that provide money are sealed for the duration of this jump.

Virtual Ghost (+400 CP)

Say goodbye to the physical world, because you're now confined to the digital one, just like Yachiyo. While you can still see the outside world, you cannot interact with it physically and can only affect electronics if you can do so. Fortunately, there's a virtual world to explore and enjoy, unless you accidentally "butterfly" that world away.

Power? What Power? (+400 CP)

It's unfair that you're coming into this world with all these out-of-context powers while the locals have nothing to stop you. This drawback makes all perks gained from previous jumps inaccessible for the duration of this jump. However, your body mods are not affected. This drawback may be taken even if this is your first jump.

Moon Invasion (+600 CP)

The Moon people are an advanced and peaceful race, having long transcended the need for physical bodies and far surpassing humans in nearly every way. With this drawback, they will come to Earth with a single purpose: to capture you and force you to complete the work Kaguya abandoned. Though they lack physical forms, they can invade any virtual world, control technology less advanced than their own, and even travel through time.

If captured, you won't fail the jump, but you cannot leave until Kaguya's work is finished, potentially keeping you on the Moon far longer than intended. Your best option is to go into hiding where there's no electronics or technology if you want to avoid being found.

8000 Years with You (+600 CP)

It seems you've triggered a time anomaly upon entering the jump. Shortly after arriving, you will be sent 8,000 years into the past at a random location on Earth, remaining there until the point you would have normally left. On the bright side, you get to witness 8,000 years of human history firsthand and perhaps even influence it to make the world a better place. Who knows, you might even have company from an lunar princess if you haven't altered the setting too much.

You'll be moving on from this place to the next world that awaits you.

Another Tomorrow

You decided to permanently stay behind in this world; this will be your home from now on.
