Take this money and buy yourself something nice.

Origins

Wanderer

You are a stranger in a strange land. A strange, stupid land. How you wound up here doesn't really matter, all that matters is that you're here now and you'll have to deal with the nonsense of this place.

Rando

You're just a guy who's around here. Or girl, I suppose. I don't know if you live here or what. Probably. I bet you're just here to gawk at the big titted sunflower. Weirdo. Whatever, you can be part of those weird cavemen or the weasel Mafia or some other group if you feel like.

Villain

You're evil for sure. One of the menaces that plagues this land like vampires, mad scientists, evil kings and giant sentient poos. Given that you're a right wanker you'll likely be involved with other such individuals of a nefarious nature in this kingdom.

Race

Free - Conscious Talking Thing

Most creatures in this land are roughly equal, all things considered. Not too many advantages or disadvantages of note (at least not enough for me to put in the effort to make new options) despite their vast diversity. You've got animal folks, vaguely human cavemen, full on animals that can talk and are sentient and pretty much any object you can imagine but with eyes slapped on and able to hop around. You can be anything you want except a cat or squirrel. As mentioned before you're basically on an even playing field with everyone else around here.

\$300 - Cat

You're some form of cat, be that a humanoid cat, cat person or catfish. The only notable thing about you is that you get 9 lives that refresh each jump, which equates to 8 extras.

\$300 - Squirrel

Squirrels are very special. You can spin your big tail around to hover in the air for a few seconds. More importantly, you can get as many extra lives as you think you can get away with. See, there's these tails lying around the world and each one you collect gives you another life. You start with 3 which refresh each jump and can find more even in future worlds, though they'll be far rarer and harder to find in future worlds than in this one.

Perks

Perks and items are 50% off for matching origin. \$100 perks and items are instead free for the matching origin. Typical stuff, really.

Wanderer

\$100 - Cheeky

You're a real stinker. You've got a natural wit and a talent for sarcastic remarks and insults. Not only are you good at mocking people, but you're good at tricking them - at least if they're stupid. You could convince them that you're not, in fact, a squirrel but an elephant and the moron would actually buy it.

\$200 - Have a Go

Just because you're cute doesn't mean you're not ready to throw down. You've got the combat skills of a highly trained soldier, able to operate virtually any weapon and fight with the best of them. You even seem to take being squished or lit on fire or punched by a giant rock monster in relative stride, as if you were some kind of cartoony video game character. You've got some pinpoint aim too. You're a tough little bugger.

\$400 - Conkerer

You may not look it, but the blood of kings runs in your veins! You're a natural born ruler, in the sense that people automatically assume you'd be a good fit for one. If you defeated someone who was a ruler, or at least defeated the guy that defeated the ruler, people would immediately try to slot you in as the ruler's replacement. How about that?

\$600 - Blackmail

Uh oh, looks like someone slipped up. Y'see, you caught the developers lacking - game froze right up as you were doing something real important. Shameful work, really. As a result, you can call on them one time to stop everything and meet all your demands for the next, say, two minutes. The developers are pretty powerful, having created the world and everything in it and all. They could move you and your enemies somewhere else, give you some weapons, maybe some cash, heal you.... oh, and bring the dead back to life too. Can't forget about that one. Don't expect them to just beat your enemies for you, though. The point of a game is to have some challenge! You can call in one of these "favors" once a jump.

Rando

\$100 - Skills

Not everyone can be an adventurer. Some of us have to work for a living and to work you need skills and know how. You've got all the requirements for some kind of basic job - goon, bouncer, cult leader, maybe even world champion hoverboarder. Whatever it is, you're pretty damn good at it.

\$200 - What a Pair

Hoo-wee, what a nice... personality you have. Indeed, you've got a "personality" most fellas would kill for. You're hot is what I'm saying. Big tits. Big butt. Curvy body. Or the guy version of being hot, y'know, abs and chiseled jawline and all that. Big penis.

\$400 - Fiver

You got a problem you can't solve? What's a video game NPC to do? Why, wait for some strapping young hero to come by and fix it for them, obviously. It seems that, for the most part, when there's a problem you can't solve, someone comes along who can fix it for you, albeit for a price. The price will go up in accordance with the difficulty of the task, but most things can probably be handled with a hundred dollars.

\$600 - Big Boner

Hey, why are you suddenly so large and menacing? Did you do something different with your hair? Ah, I see. You're one of them boss-type guys. Wouldn't that fit more in the villain section. Oh well. You're fitted with the strength of a full blown boss. You could be anything from a giant caveman with a big bone, to an advanced robot teddy bear with weapons systems out the wazoo, to a super-sized sentient singing shit. Regardless, you're pretty darn tough and dangerous. It'd take some kind of bright eyed, bushy tailed protagonist to take you out. Now where would one of those be?

Villain

\$100 - Sweet Pipes

Truly marvelous. Awe inspiring, even. Your voice is like that of a god's, so deep and bellowing as to surpass the greatest of opera singers. Not only are you naturally talented at singing, but your voice is so powerful it can shatter glass. Really thick and strong glass. Truly a voice to be reckoned with.

\$200 - Scary Boss

It's better to be feared than loved. Some gay Italian guy said that once, and it's true. You can force others to submit to you due to your terrifying presence and menacing threats of duct tape. You're so scary that your minions would scarcely think of acting out of line, at least not if they thought you'd find out. If you do find out? Duct tape time.

\$400 - Bloodsucker

Velcome to the night. You are a vampire, the immortal rulers of the night. Indeed, you no longer age or have the needs of mortals, though you must now consume blood to survive. If someone wanted to kill you they would have to rely on the typical vampire weaknesses like sunlight, stakes/crossbow bolts through the heart and fire, though a massive meat grinder would ultimately work just as well. You can turn into a massive bat, allowing you to fly around, use echolocation, crap on your foes to incapacitate them and effortlessly lift them into the air to carry them off to your lair. You can turn others into more of your kind, though you are the progenitor class of vampire so if you were to die it would turn those you turned mortal once more.

\$600 - Efil Zcience

I zee you are having ze higher education. Zis is good, yes? Indeed, you are not only highly educated but massively intelligent, at least in terms of making scientific inventions. Anti-gravity chocolate, hovering chairs, highly equipped and capable robot teddy bear soldiers, experimental alien lifeforms, even a whole bank vault that can fly into space. Truly you are only limited by the resources at your disposal. Soon, you shall show your boss who uses ze duct tape!

Items

Free/\$50+ - \$1000

You didn't read that wrong. I'm giving you \$1000 for free, no need to thank me. Now don't get this twisted, this isn't the same legal tender you're using to buy these here jump options. Entirely different currency. That being said, you can pay me \$50 to double the amount you get here, and do that again and again and again. As I'm sure you can imagine this could lead to some ridiculous wealth. You'll get however much money you get here deposited into your account at the start of each jump or every decade, whichever comes first.

Free/\$300 (exclusive to Squirrels) - Tails

These are those tail things I was telling you about. For each one you've got, you get an extra life. Now you start with 3 and can find more lying around if you want, but if you'd like I can up your base stock, that is to say the amount you start each jump with, by one for each \$50 you spend here. As a special discount, you can spend a lump sum of \$300 to start each jump with 12 tails instead of 3. Heh, get it?

Free - Big Ball o' Poo

'ere ya go. It's a big ball o' poo yez can roll around an' do whatever ya like with. The fack do ye mean ya don't want it? It's a great big ball o' poo! Get the feck outta here before I make yez take it!

\$200 - Pub

Your own little bar in a vague location by the side of the road. It's a very successful and steady business, with the bonus of being able to get tanked whenever you please. Sometimes when people get drunk here they wander out and wind up in very odd places. Can't tell if that's a feature or the natural consequences of walking home alone drunk. Probably both.

Wanderer

\$100 - Frying Pan

The trusty weapon of an animated squirrel. Don't underestimate this just because it's a frying pan. Conk someone over the head with it and odds are they'll be knocked right out for a minute unless they're particularly tough. Not the most lethal weapon, admittedly.

\$200/\$400 - Heavy Weapons

Yeah, now we're talking. Forget about a stupid frying pan, this is the good stuff. Crossbow, shotgun, twin submachine guns and even a rocket launcher. All perfect for sending some horrible bastards straight to hell. For \$400, this will instead let you pause time and enter a white void where rows upon rows of every weapon you could imagine are inside. Chainsaws, katanas, all types of guns and explosives, quite literally every weapon ever invented that one guy could use and maybe even some futuristic stuff like a plasma gun if you're lucky. Once you've made your selections you can unpause and re-enter the fight with your new weapons in hand.

\$400 - Combat Vehicles

What you've got here are three very special items. The first is a tank. Pretty self-explanatory, really. Shoots unlimited rockets and it's highly resistant to damage. The second is a mini-mech suit which has a rocket pack to hover into the air and has enough strength to punch out an alien (like, from Alien) and throw them straight into space. The third is a dinosaur you can ride around on and have it eat your enemies. It'll be very sad if you abandon it.

\$600 - Context Sensitive

Scattered around the world you may notice these fancy button type things on the ground with a "B" on them. These are context sensitive buttons and they give you whatever you need in the particular moment. Need to slam something down? Hit the button and you'll turn into an anvil to smash it. Need to piss on someone? Pull some beer out of nowhere and get tanked. There's almost nothing this can't potentially do, though it's less something that solves your problems and usually more a tool to greatly help you in solving them yourself. You'll find one nearby wherever you might have trouble, though they'll only actually be there if you're looking for them. Wouldn't wanna ugly up the multiverse.

Rando

\$100 - Hoverboard

Hey, lookie here! Time for some "radical tricks" or whatever the kids are saying these days. This is a hoverboard and, as you can imagine, it hovers over the ground. The real neat part is that it also hovers over lava. It goes pretty damn fast but it's also prone to exploding horribly if crashing into things at high speed. If that happens, you'll get a new one right away. Assuming you're still alive, anyways.

\$200 - Anti-Gravity Chocolate

Your eyes aren't fooling you. This massive chocolate was scientifically enhanced to float above the ground. It has the miraculous properties to heal almost any wounds, including burns, cuts, bullet holes and more. It's nice to have around and very delicious. Don't eat the ones you find in the poo area.

\$400 - Home Base

It's your very own living quarters. Far from just a house, this place could be anything from a massive gothic mansion to an extensive cave civilization with an arena. Whatever the case it's quite defensible and filled with hordes of your loyal and thematically appropriate minions

\$600 - Experimental Suit

The military's latest and greatest in experimental technology has been given to you. This suit is a special titanium laminate, meaning it's effectively indestructible. It's a bit like a big turtle shell and combined with the helmet means if you turtle up inside it you're virtually immune to harm, at least from anything you'd find here. Even fall damage doesn't affect you.

Villain

\$100 - Cripple Chair

No legs? No problem! Well, actually it's a huge problem, but hey you've got this chair! It's a flying chair that can hover off the ground pretty quick to let you get where you need to go even without legs. You never got the turbo installed, but surely that won't come up.

\$200 - Club

Welcome to Party Central. Well, I guess you own Party Central. Whatever, the point is this is a nightclub which attracts all kinds of hot babes and young dudes (or rock people) and they spend a sizable amount of money here. Money going straight into your pockets. Hopefully some asshole squirrel doesn't come and mess it up.

\$400 - Army of Tediz

You'd been mocked. Humiliated. Not to mention the duct tape... but now you'll show them all! This is a massive army of robot teddy bear soldiers, equipped with the latest military hardware to slaughter whoever you like. They are mindlessly obedient with no moral code or compunction (at least, when in character) and if all goes well with them they could even conquer the kingdom for you. Hopefully some asshole squirrel doesn't come and mess it up.

\$600 - Kingdom

You are king. King of aaallll the land. Who'd have thought that? All the power and all the wealth in this land is yours to command, including the surprisingly modern army. Your massive, mighty castle also holds the bank, which has about a million dollars in it. Kind of a poor kingdom, but hey, you're still King and everyone will obey your whims. Hopefully some asshole squirrel doesn't come and mess it up.

Companions

\$50/\$100 - The Boys

Want to bring people with you to this world (for some bloody reason)? All you have to do is spend \$50 to import/create a companion, granting them an origin and \$600 to spend on whatever they like. Alternatively you can spend \$100 to import/create a companion who gains the same benefits but \$1000 to spend.

Free - Come With Me

Why you would want to bring anyone from this awful world with you is beyond me, but if you really want them I won't stop you. Just invite them along with you and if they accept they'll become a companion at the end of the jump.

Free - Big Titty Sunflower

She's a sunflower with big tits. Really big tits. Doesn't require much more explanation than that.

\$50 - Hot Girlfriend

Some people might consider buying a girlfriend a bad thing and a poor reflection of character, but if we're being honest you were buying her anyway. I'm just cutting out the extra work. This is a really hot chick like Jugga the giant cave woman (or Berri if you're into that kind of thing). Suffice to say she's really hot and really into you. You want a guy instead? Fine, sure, just move on already.

Drawbacks

+\$0 - Emphasis on Day

Pretty much everything of note here happens on the same day, so if you wanna just finish up the first day and then move on to the next jump immediately you can go right ahead.

+\$100 - Hammered

You seem to have a serious drinking problem. You're always getting tanked and going out to bars even when you know it's a bad idea. You just can't help yourself, it seems. A tragic but all too common tale.

+\$100 - Excessive censorship

Well this is f^{***} ng annoying. Every d^*n swear word you say gets censored out by some ***** who thinks he's king s^{**} t of F^{**} k mountain. Not really a big deal except now you swear all the time and every time it happens it really p^{**} ses you off. Plus the beeping might be slowly giving you tinnitus. C^{**} t.

+\$100 - Tiny Boner

How humiliating! Your thingy is absolutely miniscule and it terrifies you to imagine anyone finding out your embarrassing secret (if you're a girl it's your boobs and you pad your chest). You're constantly overcompensating for it, bragging about how massive it is but you know if anyone finds out you'll never recover from the embarrassment.

+\$200 - Mercenary

You're the living embodiment of the phrase "I'm not gay but \$100 is \$100." Well, sort of. You're not a gay prostitute, I don't think, but you'll do basically anything for relatively meager sums of money. Your own greed prevents you from turning down ridiculous requests like diving into wasp hives or swimming through deadly underwater mazes just for the hopes of a hundred bucks at the end of the rainbow. Could at least ask for more?

+\$200 - Un-bloody-dead

The hordes of the dead have taken over the land. Sorta. I mean, they mostly just wander around aimlessly but they seem to have a right hankering for your flesh. You'll find them basically anywhere that isn't heavily guarded and reinforced, even popping out of the ground at times. Un-bloody-dead, what's even the point, then?!

+\$200 - Conscripted

You're at war, soldier! You'll have to battle the forces of the Tediz as a soldier in the fairy Panther King's army, fighting an actual full length war rather than the one operation Conker was part of. This is incompatible with "Emphasis on Day" for obvious reasons. Good luck out there, soldier.

+\$200 - Dumbass

You're really stupid. Just generally an absolute moron. The type of complete dipshit who could be convinced that a squirrel is actually an elephant. How you've even lived this long is anyone's guess, you mentally retarded fuckhead.

+\$200 - Depressed

You're struggling with a deep depression. It just makes every day seem meaningless and devoid of hope. You can get the help you need but if you don't then you'll ultimately end up taking your own life. Assuming you don't botch the attempt, at least.

+\$300 - Cripplesac

Well, then. How unfortunate for you. You seem to be missing legs of any description. No walking for you, I'm afraid, or any other means of locomotion provided by your own body or abilities besides crawling. If you want to get around you'll need some kind of vehicle like a hover chair. If you don't have one you're probably gonna have to crawl everywhere.

+\$300 - Roundabout

I don't even know what to call this, but you have some disorder where you always decide to solve your problems in the most roundabout way possible. If you needed to fix a table you'd come to the conclusion you need to kidnap a red squirrel and use the squirrel at the 4th table leg. This makes getting anything accomplished a massive pain in the ass at best.

+\$300/+\$600 - Bad Fur Day

It looks like you're coincidentally going to have your own day just as eventful, absurdly dangerous and awful as Conker's. You can even replace Conker if you want (totally not so you can steal his girlfriend). Your day will be filled with tons of deadly boss battles, hazardous platforming challenges, undead killing, giant singing turds and even all out war. It's going to be a day to remember. Try not to lose anything too important along the way. For +\$600 instead, you're gonna have a day like this every day for a decade.
