
Harry Potter Smokes Weed

+1000 Blunt Points

Starting Locations

You, as does everyone else, start off in Pogwarts.

Age & Gender

You can choose whatever age or sex that you want, so long as it reasonably fits within the setting.

Origins

Pogwarts OG [Free]

You are on the side of good(?), and are either one of the Pogwarts staff or students.

Death Weeder [Free]

You work with Voldesnort and the Death Weeders. Among your jobs are lacing weed with fent, and moving kilos of coke.

Perks

Origins receive their 100 BP Perks free, with the others having a 50% discount.

Undiscounted Perks

Xanification [Free]

You *may* have noticed that the names are a *bit* different. Just a smidge of course. If you find this amusing, you can have this effect any world you go to.

The Bitch That Lived [100 BP]

You are remarkably talented at insulting other people, be it playing up their insecurities, mocking their best accomplishments, or just making insulting nicknames that stick.

Worry Not, I Accept EBT [200 BP]

Money is overrated, when you can have something else of value. You are to accept pay in the form of things that a customer would consider to be valuable. These can be actual valuable possessions, something of sentimental value, or some sort of favor. Whatever you are paid with, it will always have some form of value.

Posted Like Totem Poles [200 BP]

It's always good to know what the opps are up to. You possess a sixth sense that instinctively alerts you to how well your enemies and general opposition are doing. This includes them rising up, experiencing a fallout, or getting ready to plot something.

Don't Die Doobie, Please! [400 BP]

Ok. Once per Jump, you are able to ignore the fact that you died, functionally having a 1-Up.

Actual Wizard [400 BP]

While absolutely not the main focus, several characters *actually* have magic, and do use spells. For the sake of use, you will have the same level of talent as heavy hitters like Voldemort and Dumbeldore

Rising Trapstar [600 BP]

You're the only trapstar here! So long as you are out and enjoying yourself, you'll find that your powers, perks, skills, and even things like popularity experience a slow but steady rate of growth.

Pogwarts OG Perks

We Had to Fight Some Gay Trolls [100 BP]

Sorry we were late, but you have to understand. You are able to make up any nonsensical excuse that you want, and people will believe you. This will not work if there is evidence contrary to your claim.

Voldesnort Has Been Lacing Our Loud [100 BP]

You have to believe me! So long as you are telling the truth, people will inherently trust you, even if you don't actually have enough evidence to prove it.

Wock Resistance [200 BP]

Harry Pothead could sip lean without tweaking, and now so can you. No drugs, alcohol, or poisons will affect you anymore than what would be considered pleasing. Even outright magical drugs are no-selled.

Pipe Down [200 BP]

This isn't the opp block, so don't go snitching. You nor anyone in any organization that you run will ever snitch on each other if they can help it

Being the Chosen One Brings Lots of Anxiety and Depression [400 BP]

I *will* chief this whole blunt if I feel like it. If you come across something that is supposed to be shared, you will be able to have all of it without anyone kicking up a fuss.

Hermione Says Your a Bad Influence [400 BP]

She's a total buzzkill, but she's probably true. You are able to leverage your control or authority over others to make them give up negative influences and bad hobbies.

I Just Gave Him Six Dollars [600 BP]

The ultimate technique. By paying anyone the equivalent of \$6, it will be registered as you having paid the full price for anything. This includes drug deals, groceries, video games, buying a house, and more.

Dumbbelldore [600 BP]

You are hilariously jacked, having whatever physical build that you want. What's more, your strength is now equal to the output of your magic, and vice versa. As you train in one field, the other grows in tandem with it. Also, if you use things like steroids, it has no negative impact on your body or mental state.

Death Weeder Perks

Slythillionaire Grindset [100 BP]

Never let them know your next move. It is impossible for your opposition to ever get a read on you, be it through mind reading, clairvoyance, empirical observations, or advanced predictions.

All You Youngbloods Listen to is Mumble Crap [200 BP]

That's why I laced your weed with fentanyl! Nothing you enjoy will ever go out of style, be it music, art, systems of government, or even things like phone models. This isn't the most helpful thing in the world, but it is nice to have.

So is Half of Hogwarts Staff [200 BP]

Why would I care that you're a registered sex offender? So long as you are not actively committing a crime, nobody seems to care about any criminal activities you have done in the past. They won't even have any subconscious revulsion from it.

This Will Get Me Immunity Right? [400 BP]

Snitching is always the way to go! When you are part of a crime, revealing the identities of your co-conspirators will get you off the hook completely. You won't be punished by the law, nor will you get a bad reputation or threat of death from snitching.

Stripped of Copper [400 BP]

I see you want a way to stack paper. When you enter a location, you are able to instantly strip it of anything remotely valuable. This includes TVs, furniture, antiques, copper wiring, and much more. It is all stored in a pocket dimension, which can be released shortly afterwards.

A Girlboss is Speaking [600 BP]

Shut up, Sirius Pack! When performing an action, nobody will ever try to stop you. You could yap for 90 pages, and end it off with a twenty minute transformation, yet your enemies would stand there and listen. This ceases working when you actually begin to attack them.

He's Actually Gonna Do It! [600 BP]

Just kill Dumbassdore, and you can get all the wings that you want. You have a degree of charisma, and can get people to do ridiculously dangerous things for rewards that are almost certainly not worth it.

Cut it With Baking Soda [600 BP]

You may cut corners, but it doesn't matter! When producing something, you can swap out any components with some cheap substitute, and it will work as intended. Cut your cocaine with baking soda, and you'll still have extremely high-quality coke.

Items

Origins receive their 50 BP Item free, with the others having a 50% discount.

Undiscounted Items

Lean [50 BP]

A powerful concoction of the muggles. You now have a double styrofoam cup that contains an infinite amount of lean. This will never spill out when you don't want it to.

Popeyes Two-Piece with Sweet Tea [100 BP]

Do you remember their names now? You have access to an infinite supply of any specific type of food that, when offered to someone you are interrogating, will compel them to tell the truth. They will be honest in their answers, and will not leave out information that they would deem as pertinent. This does not compel them to answer questions unrelated to your investigation.

Quality Herb [200 BP]

It can cure lung cancer! You have an endless supply of extremely high-quality weed, which can manifest in a blunt or in a magical bong. It is non-addictive, purges any stress from you, and quite literally cures any and all sicknesses and diseases.

Pogwarts OG Items

Wizard Welfare [50 BP]

It works for Hermione, so it can work for you! Once at the start of each month, you receive the equivalent of £1000 to spend on whatever you want. Naturally, this has already been taxed, and is perfectly legal

Dispensary Card [100 BP]

A reward greater than most others. This is Dumbledore's weed dispensary card, which allows you to get any weed that you require. More importantly, it also functions as the ultimate ID, which lets you bypass any form of security.

Delsym Potion [200 BP]

I'm pretty sure this isn't a potion, but alright. You have a bottle of cough syrup that refills daily. By drinking a cap-full before sleeping, you will receive relevant psychic dreams, informing you of an event in the near-future, or something significant from the past.

The Elder Blunt [400 BP]

The loudest blunt that has ever been rolled. Anyone who smokes on this that isn't approved by you will immediately die. Curiously, it is extremely easy for you to convince people to use it.

Death Weeder Items

Dementor Plugs [50 BP]

Allegedly operating out of Snapchat, you have access to a large group of Dementors loyal to you. They have all the standard strengths and weaknesses that Dementors have, with a little extra. If need be, they will sell fent-laced weed to your enemies, which they will not be able to detect, and will feel compelled to smoke. This is ineffective if the Dementors are known to lace their weed.

More Keys Than Argus Filch [100 BP]

You run a veritable drug empire, matching even the Dark Loud's own. By default, this will be extremely high quality cocaine, although you can incorporate however many drugs you have. Every day, you will sell your drugs by kilos, earning a massive profit. Furthermore, unless that is the endgame, the drugs you sell will have no negative effects on those who use them, including yourself.

Go-Go Gadget Glock [200 BP]

The very same used by Snape to off Dumbledore. You have a glock with seemingly infinite ammo and zero recoil. Uniquely, the bullets fired from this gun are able to bypass magical barriers, and can harm non-physical entities and magical creatures.

The Hoecrux [400 BP]

Better known as the Horcrux: this magical item is bound to a piece of your soul, extending your life and making you technically immortal. You are given knowledge of how to create one horcrux per Jump, attaching it to pretty much any object larger than a pebble.

Companions

Import/Create Companion [50/200 BP]

For every 50 BP, you may either create or bring along any companion you want, with them getting +600 BP.

For **200 BP**, you may import as many companions as you want, or create up to eight companions. Each companion receives **+600 BP** to spend.

Recruitment Drive [100 BP]

If you can convince them, you are able to recruit any canon characters that you want.

Drawbacks

Supplement Mode [+0 BP]

Is this Jump too short for you? You may use this document to supplement any other Harry Potter Jump.

Prolonged Stay [+100 BP]

This Jump lasts only for the events of one book, but surely you can stay a while longer? For an extra +100 BP, you stay in this Jump for an extra ten years. You may take this as many times as you want.

That was a Flintstone Gummy [+100 BP]

Your tolerance for drugs and/or alcohol is abysmal, with even a sip threatening to put you under the influence.

Dumbledore Voice Syndrome [+100 BP]

Once every week, your voice will noticeably change from how it originally sounded. You will always sound somewhat similar to your original voice, but it will always be distinct.

I Think I'll Hit the Nae-Nae to Celebrate! [+100 BP]

You are oldheaded, being effectively ten years behind on any current trend. You will also actively refuse to learn any new sort of slang.

-420 Points to Gryffindor [+200 BP]

Everyone around you is a hater, and will insult you at any given opportunity, even if they aren't part of the conversation

No Witches? [+200 BP]

You have absolutely zero game, and anytime you talk with a female will be incredibly awkward.

THC-Fried Brain [+200 BP]

Looks like all that cannabis had lasting effects after all! You are incredibly scatterbrained, sound perpetually high, and have a goofy laugh.

Ugly Bitch [+200 BP]

You aren't visibly uglier or anything, but people seem to insist that you look hideous, or at least will claim that you're ugly.

You Are Broke! [+200 BP]

No matter what you do, you always seem to be on the poverty line. I hope that you don't ever ask for wings without paying for it yourself.

The Munchies [+200 BP]

Even if you don't smoke weed, you always seem to want something to eat, even if you are full. This is never an unbearable sensation, but it will be annoying.

Inconvenient Rival [+600 BP]

You appear to have a scaling enemy, except they're...not exactly an enemy? They'll constantly try to fight you, but rather than actively trying to kill you, they just seem interested in mildly inconvenienced you. Because they aren't trying to kill you, you obviously can't kill them.

Weed is Prohibited [+600 BP]

Well isn't this annoying? Weed and any other non-medicinal drugs are banned and penalized, and if you are caught with it, you fail the jump (although not your chain), and forfeit everything gained here. You will, of course, be required to smoke a full blunt once per week, or you fail the jump. Be careful!

Final Choice

Your journey in this Jump is over, and now it's time to decide your next move.

Go Home: Do you feel nostalgic for home? You return to your home world with everything you've brought with you so far.

Stay Here: Were your adventures here that impactful? You now stay in this Jump, with everything that you've gained.

Move On: There's always something new to experience. You move to your next Jump.
