Humans

Humans (人族) come in many different appearances and offer balanced stats, making them an adaptable choice for any playstyle.

Beasts

Beasts are a unique race in *The World R:2*, featuring the body of a human combined with the head and tail of an animal. They are deeply rooted in tradition, valuing the technology and culture of ancient times while resisting modernization. This adherence to the old ways has prevented steam technology from spreading widely within their cities. Despite their differences, Beasts are united by strong tribal bonds that help them overcome their inherent vulnerabilities. As a Beast character, you will belong to one of three tribes, each with its own unique traits and abilities. Choose one tribe carefully, as it will greatly impact your playstyle.

Ya Tribe

"Beasts of the Ya Tribe have fairly large bodies. Although they have bodies of steel that are capable of resisting physical damage, they have limited understanding of magic and are very vulnerable against magic attacks."

Ya Tribe Beasts are physically imposing, boasting exceptional strength and defense. Their resilience against physical damage makes them ideal for tanking roles and melee combat. However, they struggle with magical attacks due to their low magic defense and attack stats.

Lei Tribe

"Beasts of the Lei Tribe possess bodies that are similar in proportion to humans and have the quickest reflexes and speed. They have average physical and magical abilities similar to humans but are slightly less resilient."

Lei Tribe Beasts are agile and quick, excelling in speed and reflexes. They tend to resemble canines or felines and are well-suited for roles requiring mobility and precision. While they possess average stats overall, their slightly lower resilience compared to Humans means they must rely on their agility to avoid damage.

Tu Tribe

"Beasts of the Tu Tribe are smaller than the others. They are highly sensitive and possess great magical abilities and wisdom, but their bodies are much more fragile and they pose almost no resistance to physical attack."

Tu Tribe Beasts (ウ族) are diminutive and delicate, often appearing as small animals. They excel in magic, boasting exceptional magical attack and defense stats, making them ideal for spellcasters and support roles. However, their frailty leaves them vulnerable to physical damage, requiring strategic positioning to maximize their potential while avoiding harm.



Level Progression

Here, you'll decide your starting level and how much of the game you've already experienced, reflecting the amount of time you've invested in The World R:2. Each option determines your familiarity with the game and your mastery over your class which is determined by job levels. The higher job levels the more arts, spells and damage you do with your spells or arts.

Starting Out [+200 CP]

At this stage, you've achieved complete mastery of your class and build, allowing you to tackle challenging dungeons, PvP, and raids with ease. Classes:

Your class determines your playstyle, abilities, and role within The World R:2. Choose carefully, as this decision will define how you interact with the game world, approach combat, and contribute to teams.

Select one class for your character:

Blade Brandier

Blade Brandiers are versatile warriors who wield a sword similar to a katana. This class is considered the foundation for all warrior-type classes, with many of its techniques influencing other combat styles. While their abilities are average overall, they can adapt to a variety of situations, making them reliable in different combat scenarios.

Their damage and hit rate are balanced, ensuring consistent performance in both offense and defense. However, in terms of speed, Blade Brandiers are not as fast as other more agile classes, which places them in the middle tier for overall effectiveness. Blade Brandiers are ideal for players who enjoy a well-rounded class capable of handling diverse challenges with adaptability and steady performance.



Edge Punisher

Edge Punishers are formidable warriors who wield massive swords, capable of delivering devastating blows. A single strike from one of these colossal weapons can cleave most enemies in half. This class excels in raw physical offense, particularly against armored foes, where their strength and power truly shine. However, Edge Punishers are much slower than more agile classes, such as the Blade Brandier, which can make them vulnerable to fast-moving opponents.

While their physical defense is high due to the heavy armor they can wear, their magical defense suffers as a trade-off, making them more susceptible to magic-based attacks. Their weapons' long reach makes it easier to land hits on highly mobile enemies, and once they unlock the ability to move while charging attacks, they become even more deadly in these encounters. Edge Punishers are perfect for players who prefer heavy hitters with excellent offensive potential but are willing to sacrifice speed and magical defense for pure physical power.



Flick Reaper

Flick Reapers are a class focused on controlling the battlefield by keeping multiple enemies at bay. They specialize in medium-range, area-of-effect attacks, using their scythe-like weapons to "flick" enemies away before they can get close enough for melee combat. This makes them excellent at handling groups of enemies, ensuring that foes can't swarm them in close quarters.

However, Flick Reapers are highly vulnerable to long-range attacks, making them ineffective at a distance. Skilled long-range players can easily overpower them by attacking from afar, taking advantage of the Flick Reaper's lack of ranged capabilities. On the flip side, Flick Reapers excel at dealing with airborne enemies, using their wide-reaching attacks to hit targets above them with ease. This class is ideal for players who enjoy controlling the flow of battle in close-to-medium-range fights but need to be cautious of opponents who can strike from a distance.



Harvest Cleric

Harvest Clerics are specialists in healing magic, dedicated to supporting their allies with powerful restorative abilities. Aligned with the light spirits, they wield a staff in battle, honoring Eir, the Goddess of Tranquility. While their primary role is to heal and support, Harvest Clerics can also learn some attack magic as they progress, though they remain focused on restorative spells.

Their favored weapons, staves, enhance their magical and elemental stats, providing a decent balance of offense and defense. While they are physically stronger than those wielding grimoires, they are still weaker than other classes when it comes to melee combat. Harvest Clerics also have an incredibly fast learning rate for spells, gaining nearly one new spell per job level, but they do not learn arts like other combat-focused classes. This class is perfect for players who enjoy a supportive role, healing their team while gradually gaining some offensive capabilities over time.



Lord Partizan

Lord Partizans are powerful warriors who wield a giant lance, unmatched in their ability to pierce through enemies with devastating force. This class excels in medium-range combat, with high defensive capabilities that make them resilient against physical attacks. However, their weakness lies in their vulnerability to magic, where they are less resilient compared to other classes.


Lord Partizans specialize in armor-piercing and anti-air skills, making them especially effective against large monsters and airborne enemies. Their physical attack stats are among the highest, allowing them to deal massive damage in direct confrontations. However, they lack sweeping abilities like the Flick Reaper, focusing more on precise, powerful strikes rather than wide-reaching attacks. One of their weaknesses is their slow skill progression in the early levels, making them harder to master in the beginning. Overall, the Lord Partizan is an excellent choice for players who enjoy a high-defense, high-damage class focused on taking down tough monsters and enemies with piercing power.



Macabre Dancer

Macabre Dancers are masters of status and ability magic, drawing power from both light and dark spirits. They are proficient in a balanced mix of healing and attack magic, making them incredibly versatile in supporting allies and damaging foes. In battle, they wield large fans in both hands, using graceful, dance-like movements that are said to mesmerize those who witness them.

As the expert class for status effects and parameter changes, Macabre Dancers can manipulate the flow of battle by weakening enemies or enhancing their allies. They are well-rounded casters who can learn a wide variety of spells, gaining new ones at an impressive rate—almost one per job level—similar to Harvest Clerics and Shadow Warlocks. However, like these other classes, they do not learn arts, focusing purely on spellcasting. This class is ideal for players who enjoy controlling battles through magical influence, using a combination of healing, attacking, and status effects to sway the outcome of encounters.



Shadow Warlock

Shadow Warlocks are formidable spellcasters, deeply connected to dark spirits and experts in attack magic. They wield Grimoires, ancient books of spells, which greatly enhance their magic power and elemental stats. While Shadow Warlocks can use some healing magic, their abilities in this area are limited and far less effective than those of other classes focused on healing.

Grimoires, their preferred weapon, provide substantial bonuses to their magical and elemental stats, but offer very little in terms of physical attack, making Shadow Warlocks weak in melee combat. Like Macabre Dancers and Harvest Clerics, Shadow Warlocks learn spells at an extraordinary rate, gaining almost one new spell per job level. However, they do not learn arts, which limits their versatility in combat.



Steam Gunner

Steam Gunners are masters of long-range combat, excelling at delivering powerful, precise shots from a distance. Their unique guns allow them to deal physical damage through skills that function similarly to spells, making them the physical counterparts to Shadow Warlocks. These skills give Steam Gunners the longest range of any physical attack in *The World R:2* and enable them to pick off enemies before they can close the distance.

Steam Gunners' physical attack stat grows faster than any other class, giving them significant offensive power as they level up. However, they are weak in close-quarters combat. This class is ideal for players who enjoy long-range precision and high physical damage but are willing to manage the risks of close-range vulnerabilities.



Tribal Grappler

Tribal Grapplers are fierce combatants who rely on their own fists as weapons, combining high agility with tremendous stamina to excel in close-range battles. Similar to Twin Blades, their agility allows for rapid movement and quick strikes, giving them the ability to unleash normal Rengeki techniques at an impressive speed. Their high HP provides them with the durability needed to stay in the fight, even when outnumbered or under heavy pressure.

However, Tribal Grapplers' low defense makes them vulnerable to sustained damage, requiring players to remain vigilant and skillful in avoiding enemy attacks. Additionally, their repertoire of arts is limited compared to other classes, which can make their combat style feel more straightforward. This class is perfect for players who enjoy fast-paced, high-energy combat, and are confident in their ability to outmaneuver opponents while delivering a flurry of powerful melee attacks.



Twin Blade

Twin Blades are nimble and versatile fighters, wielding two short swords to deliver rapid, relentless attacks. With unmatched agility, they can chain together quick strikes that leave opponents with little opportunity to counter. This class has access to the widest variety of weapon types and subtypes in The World R:2, making them adaptable to numerous combat situations.

While their individual attacks are relatively weak, their speed and ability to combo make them highly effective at dealing sustained damage, especially to unarmored, ground-level enemies. Their rapid attacks also make it easier to trigger Rengeki techniques, enhancing their damage output significantly. However, their short attack range can be a disadvantage when dealing with highly mobile or airborne enemies, as their charged and regular attacks struggle to connect. Twin Blades are an excellent choice for players who favor fast-paced, close-range combat and are skilled at exploiting openings in their opponents' defenses.



Adept Rogue

Adept Rogues are the ultimate jack-of-all-trades, capable of equipping multiple weapons and using various magic. Unlike other classes that focus on a single weapon or combat style, Adept Rogues unlock their potential through *Job Extensions*, which grant them access to new weapon types as they progress. This adaptability allows them to excel in a wide variety of situations, provided they take the time to master each form.

- Starting Out (Beginner): At this level, you begin with access to one weapon class.
- Intermediate Level: By this point, you've completed your first *Job Extension* and now wield two weapon classes, providing greater versatility in combat.
- Expert Level: With a second *Job Extension*, you gain a third weapon class, solidifying your status as a dynamic and highly adaptable combatant.
- +200 CP Additional Job Extension: You can unlock a fourth weapon class, expanding your potential even further. This additional weapon type must be unlocked through future *Job Extensions* and is not available immediately.

For those who choose not to unlock all job extensions in *The World R:2*, the potential to master additional weapon classes carries forward into future worlds, where Adept Rogues can acquire and refine these skills in a hyper-advanced state. This class is ideal for players who enjoy versatility and are willing to invest time and effort to master multiple combat styles. Choose three starting classes to define your Adept Rogue's unique path!

UI Perks:

These perks enhance your experience while playing The World R:2, offering improved interfaces and utilities for navigating and enjoying the game. They are free for use in The World, but if you wish to carry them into future worlds, you'll need to pay the listed CP cost.

Enhanced HUD [Free/50 CP]

Upgrade your Heads-Up Display (HUD) with a sleek, customizable layout that offers improved clarity and real-time information on enemy stats, ally status, and more. This feature makes navigating and battling in The World R:2 more intuitive. It's free to use in The World, but you'll need to pay 50 CP to bring it into future worlds as a display onl;y seen by your head.

Quick Chat [Free/50 CP]

Simplify communication with a fast-access chat wheel and pre-set phrases suited for various in-game scenarios. This perk ensures smooth interactions during quests, battles, or socializing. Available for free in The World R:2, it costs 50 CP to retain in future worlds as you can no auto talk certain lines.

Minimap Mastery [Free/50 CP]

Upgrade your minimap with enhanced details like terrain features, quest indicators, and custom markers, making exploration and navigation effortless. This perk is free while playing The World R:2 but requires 50 CP to take into other worlds while you see maps that are only visible to you.

Inventory Auto-Sort [Free/50 CP]

Keep your inventory tidy with an auto-sorting system that organizes items by type and rarity. Save time and reduce clutter effortlessly. Free in The World R:2, it can be brought to future worlds for 50 CP.

Walk/Run [Free/100 CP]

Your character possesses infinite stamina while walking or running, allowing you to explore fields, dungeons, and towns without ever tiring. This perk ensures seamless and uninterrupted movement, perfect for those who love to traverse large areas or immerse themselves in exploration. While it's free for use in The World R:2, you'll need to spend 100 CP if you wish to carry this feature into future worlds.

Examining/Selecting [Free/100 CP]

This perk allows you to effortlessly examine and interact with objects in The World R:2 by simply pressing the designated "Examine" button. Whether you're interacting with NPCs, looting items, or inspecting objects in the environment, the process becomes seamless and quick. The feature also makes it easier to engage with quest triggers or points of interest without needing to navigate complex menus. This perk simplifies your interactions, saving you time and reducing the risk of missing important elements. In The World R:2, it's free to use, but should you wish to retain it in future worlds, it will cost 100 CP.

Trapped Chests [Free/200 CP]

This perk allows you to effortlessly disarm traps on chests through an intuitive mini-game, ensuring safe and smooth looting. When you approach a trapped chest, the mini-game pops up, giving you the opportunity to disable the trap before opening the chest. This prevents damage to your character and allows you to collect items without any setbacks. The perk enhances your exploration and loot-gathering experience, especially in dungeons or areas filled with traps. In *The World R:2*, it's free to use, but if you wish to keep this feature in future worlds, you'll need to spend 200 CP. This adds a layer of convenience and safety, ensuring you're always prepared for what you find.

Party Selector [Free/200 CP]

This perk allows you to easily send party invitations to other players, enabling them to teleport directly to your location with magic or another teleportation method if they accept the invite. This feature streamlines group play by removing the need for time-consuming travel and ensuring that you and your teammates can quickly reunite or gather for quests and battles. Whether you're exploring dungeons, participating in raids, or simply socializing, the Party Selector enhances your multiplayer experience by enabling efficient party management. It's free to use in The World R:2, but if you want to keep this feature in future worlds, you'll need to pay 200 CP.

Skill Triggers [Free/200 CP]

Skill Triggers simplify activating your most powerful moves, both in The World R:2 and in real life. In-game, it allows you to effortlessly trigger skills by pressing L1 along with your preferred button (Circle, Triangle, Cross, or Square), making it easy to chain combos and execute attacks with precision and flair. In real life, this perk goes even further by allowing your body to automatically trigger skills based on muscle memory, whether they're learned in-game or from physical training. This means you don't have to consciously think about your actions—your body reacts naturally, letting you focus fully on the task at hand. While it's free in The World R:2, keeping it in future worlds will cost you 200 CP, adding convenience and efficiency to your gameplay and real-life actions alike.

Rengeki [Free/200 CP/Requires Skill Triggers]

Rengeki is a powerful combat mechanic that allows you to unleash devastating attacks when you've built up hit combos. When you land enough hits, colorful rings will appear around a target for a short time. To trigger a Rengeki, you must quickly use a Skill Trigger on the enemy while the rings are still visible, resulting in a high-damage move that also contributes to the Morale Gauge. This perk is free to use in The World R:2, but in future worlds, it will require 200 CP to keep. Rengeki adds a layer of strategy and excitement to battles, rewarding you for efficiently chaining attacks and executing powerful finishing moves.

Morale Gauge [Free/400 CP/Requires Rengeki]

This gauge itself is located in the top right corner, and fills out when you use Rengeki or use actions that your party members like. and once it's full, it will ring and flash, signaling that you can use the Square button to activate it. The gauge remains full until you leave an area or use an Awakening.

Awakening – When the Morale Gauge is full, you can trigger an Awakening by pressing the Square button. During an Awakening, you deal significantly more damage either physical or magical, making it a powerful tool in battle. It's recommended to start the Awakening with a Skill Trigger and then attack rapidly, setting up for another Skill Trigger. However, you cannot use Rengeki during an Awakening. Once it ends, there's a chance to chain a Rengeki if you've accumulated enough hits. In Arena Battles or colosseum battle, the Morale Gauge depletes twice as fast, so be strategic in using your Awakenings. In future worlds, this perk will cost 400 CP to retain.

MMO Storage [Free/400 CP]

With this perk, you can carry up to 99 of the same consumable item at once without worrying about weight restrictions. Additionally, you can store up to 100 pieces of any other equipment, allowing you to manage your inventory more efficiently. This feature makes it easier to maintain a large stock of items without being encumbered, and you'll never have to worry about running out of space in your inventory. For 400 CP, you can retain this perk in future worlds, where it will continue to provide similar benefits.

Normal Player

Item Identification [100CP]

Any items you come across in The World R:2 are automatically identified without requiring any additional action on your part. Whether it's a rare item, weapon, or armor, its full market value and details are revealed instantly as you pick it up. This perk streamlines your looting and trading process, making it far more efficient and hassle-free.
