Hello Jumper, welcome to a rather normal world compared to many of your usual adventures, with the exception of one thing. This world plays to the tropes of BL manga, or boys love manga. The protagonist of the story is a university student, who refers to himself as a "Mob Character" and is a straight man trapped in a world filled with BL (or Boys Love) tropes, such as a handsome ghost falling in love with an equally handsome exorcist who couldn't banish him to the afterlife. To combat the various tropes, he researches the genre as to combat the tropes to protect his anal chastity, usually resulting in other men falling in love via the tropes he avoided instead of himself.

You will start the jump when the manga begins, sometime during Mob's (referring to the MC) tenure at his local university and remain for 10 years.

Location:

You start in one of the following locations within Mob's city, located somewhere in this world's version of Japan.

- The Local University
 In Front of Mob's House
 Outside a Karaoke Bar
 On a Park Bench
 In a Subway Car
 In a Random Alleyway
- 7. Free Pick (if you choose to roll)

Origins:

You can choose to be between 18 and 65, with your sex being up to you. Your experiences in this world will likely be much different depending on your sex, as the focus is obviously on the men of the world.

Mob Character (Drop-In Option) - Free

For a lack of better words, you are a mob character in this world. You have minimal history in this world, barely interacting with those around you. As of right now you are a background character through and through, though you can change that with the right actions, should you want to of course.

Main Character - Free

You are a person worthy of 'main character' status in a manga, be it BL or a more mainstream romance manga, such as a slice of life manga. You have made many friends throughout your life and because of it both men and women adore you to varying degrees, from platonic to romantic love. This of course comes with the positives and negatives of such popularity, such as people being willing to help you out from time to time, or the more crazy individuals having an unhinged obsession over you.

Side Character - Free

You are an interesting individual, being a moderately popular or well-known individual in your school, but not quite the top of the social food chain. If your life were a manga you would likely be a well-liked side character, like Shikamaru in Naruto for example. While you are not a school idol by any means, you have your own circle of friends and acquaintances that you have formed over the years.

Perks:

<u>Undiscounted</u>

Artistic Style - 100 CP (Free for Jump)

If you wish, you can choose to view the world in the lens of the manga's artstyle, free for the Jump. If you pay for the perk, however, you gain the ability to change the way you view worlds into any manga art style you wish, post-Jump of course. This is toggleable whenever you wish.

Mob Character

I Love Big Boobies - 100 CP

You love who you love, not what some narrative or fate tells you to love. Regardless of what fate would wish for you, only you can decide who you love, rendering such machinations as fate or mind control that would change who you are, null and void against your mind and soul.

The Most Uninteresting Man in the World - 200 CP

Man, hanging around you is such a drag sometimes. At least when you wish for it to be so, as this ability allows you to project an 'boring' field around yourself, rendering yourself uninteresting and normal to those observing you. This would be very useful in a world such as this, should you be straight, or already taken.

It's Not Manipulation... It's Matchmaking! - 400 CP

You find it very easy to read people and situations, this skill drastically increases in effectiveness depending on the level of tropes involved in a situation. While normally you are very skilled in manipulation and reading social situations and should there be tropes involved, such as BL logic being enforced on a meeting with a childhood friend, this skill increased to supernatural heights. This could be used to avoid tropes

like Mob does and redirect Yaoi events to others, which is possible due to your genre-savvy nature.

Screw Fate? No. Tear it Asunder! - 600 CP

Fate thinks that it may force you to follow its story, like a puppet on strings; but you will show fate that there are no strings on you. With this perk, you are not only immune to fate and similar manipulative influences, but actively disrupt it in such a way that would result in a better outcome for yourself. You can choose to avoid things such as fated events entirely or push them onto your enemies. For example, a mystic says that you are fated to die a terrible death at the hands of a jaded lover? No, it seems that it was your arch-nemesis Colonel Evil that was destined to die instead of you, how strange.

Main Character

Protagonist Looks - 100 CP

Regardless of how your personality may be, you definitely look the part of the main character, being either extremely handsome or beautiful (depending on your preferences). Both your mannerisms (such as posture) and appearance are affected by this perk, maximising your potential as a romance protagonist.

A Quick Study - 200 CP

Despite your large popularity, you are only one person and have many friends who have varying interests. Isn't it a great thing that you are a quick learner on pretty much anything? In fact, on average you learn everything five times faster than an average person and retain that knowledge for much longer than someone else normally would, due to your impressive memory.

Smoooooth - 400 CP

Damn, we might need to put a 18+ warning on the manga thanks to you. You are one smooth operator, being very charismatic and charming and become even more so when someone is attracted to you beforehand. As a bonus you also gain immense skill in bedroom activities, so you can walk the walk as well as talk the talk.

The Power of Beating Your Ass! - 600 CP

The power of friendship is good and all in, but sometimes that doesn't cut it, some people can't take a hint. This perk allows you to get your feelings through to others via fistacuffs (it can also be as simple as a light slap), be it hatred, annoyance, love (that's fucked up), it will get through to them. This doesn't mean that they will accept it immediately, but they will know your true feelings on a subject and will more often than not respect that. Doing this constantly will obviously earn resentment for constantly beating them up and will not increase their love for you (it would very likely do the opposite). This is more for the Yandere types and the Shounen bro types, than a more normal romance partner. This also boosts your ability to talk down dangerous individuals both peacefully and through intimidation.

Side Character

Hidden Talent Arc - 100 CP

Wow! What an interesting person, I don't know why I thought you were a side character! You have an impressive skill in a hobby that a University student could be expected to have (which is a lot), such as writing, cooking, gaming, etc.

How About Me? - 200 CP

You are able to get someone's honest opinion on you if you ask them directly, should you get them off-guard with a question, like you asking

your best friend out of nowhere. You also become very good at detecting lies when talking to people directly, easily detecting lies from even professional liers, though the very best can still manage to fool you if you don't manage to catch them off-guard.

Best Bro (Sis) - 400 CP

You are the certified best bro in this manga, that's for sure. You are many things for a protagonist, a wingman (or wingwoman), advisor and shoulder to cry on. You are the best friend a protagonist could ask for, being very skilled in all of these areas. You sure are kind, you couldn't have an alternative motive, could you?

A Spinoff More Popular Than the Manga - 600 CP

Woah, it seems you don't want to be a side character anymore, do you? Who could have known that you were the superstar idol J*U*M*P*E*R? What a twist! You are able to easily become famous for things that you are moderately good (or better) at and find even greater success when splintering off of an existing organisation or franchise, like a spinoff manga in real life! This perk gives you immense luck in such efforts and helps to quickly spread your name and brand. This also acts as a steroid shot to the 'Hidden Talent Arc' perk, making you peak human in that skill. The popularity aspect of the perk is toggleable, should you want to keep a low profile in a Jump, though it will not remove the fame or notoriety you already have.

Items:

Mob Character

School Supplies - 100 CP

You need to be prepared for University if you want to do well, which is why you have a stash of supplies for this purpose. You have a laptop, backpack and other miscellaneous supplies needed for school. The

laptop and backpack will repair themselves over time should they get damaged.

Family Home - 300 CP

You (or your family) own a moderately sized home in the city, located not too far from the University, lucky you! The utility expenses and taxes are automatically paid for, so don't worry about dear old Dad possibly being arrested for tax evasion. A copy of this can come as a warehouse attachment post-Jump if you want.

Nothing to See Here - 600 CP

It seems that you might be a literal Mob character, or rather Yakuza in Japan, having ties to an important regional family (related or friends of). This gives you an important tie to the underworld, one you can exploit for significant gain, but it is risky considering the illegal nature of it. Blackmail is a genre after all.

Main Character

An Interesting Hobby - 100 CP

It seems you have a hobby suited for a main character such as yourself, such as playing guitar, writing or something else. These items will be high quality, but mundane in nature. You are given supplies suited for one hobby per purchase of the item.

Beach Episode - 300 CP

Summer vacations can be stressful for someone as popular as yourself, with so many friends wanting a piece of the Jumper pie. Lucky for you, you have a beach house available to escape to, or invite your friends to if you are feeling generous. The utility expenses and taxes are

automatically paid for, so enjoy your summer vacation! A copy of this can come as a warehouse attachment post-Jump should you want it.

Surprise! - 600 CP

It seems that you were related to a major corporation owner and didn't even know it, ain't it grand? You are set to inherit it from a direct relative or are able to quickly gain favor with the owner of such a corporation, should you be a drop-in. While this company will not be a fortune 500 company, it will still be impressive and important to your region, giving you a stable and impressive income.

Side Character

I'll Meet You There! - 100 CP

You are quite the lucky fellow aren't you? You have a public transport pass, not just any kind, but a universal pass. This allows you to get into any paid public transport that has similar passes, such as busses, trains, etc. These services will still get paid when you use the card, you just won't have to pay them yourself.

A Lovely Apartment - 300 CP

You own a modest, but well furnished apartment for someone of your age. It's very close to the University, so it's a quick commute. The utility expenses and taxes are automatically paid for, so enjoy eating out much more than the average University student. A copy of the apartment complex can come as a warehouse attachment post-Jump if you want.

The University at Your Fingertips! - 600 CP

It seems your Grandfather has left you the local University in your inheritance, giving you an impressive revenue stream and some influence on the education of the next generation of locals.

Companions:

Mob - Free

Please take this poor bastard out of this world, he clearly doesn't want to be here. It might be nice to take him back to see his family once in a while, though. Mob comes with all of the Mob character origin perks free. While you do have to convince him (willingly), it should not take very much to get him to come with you.

We Literally Bumped Into Each Other - 100 CP

You literally bumped into this person one day and became quick close friends with them and possibly something more? They come with the first three perks of an origin of your choice. You will be given a favorable chance to ask them to come with you at the end of the Jump (willingly).

Canon Companion - 100 CP

So you decided to befriend one of the canon handsome fellows or a very rare pretty lady in this world? You will quickly be given a chance to befriend them and later a chance to ask them to come with you (willingly).

Drawbacks:

The Ol' Switcheroo + O CP

Oh? It seems I was wrong; you have fallen into an alternate world of the aforementioned plot, where all of the character have become genderswapped. The narrative of the world is now more focused on the Yuri manga genre than the Yaoi genre, meaning women are now the targets of the world's machinations, encouraging them to become lesbian through Yuri tropes.

My Eyes! + 100 CP

With all of the romantic tropes around, why not add a few visual romance manga tropes as well? Now when a romantic moment occurs (it happens often), there will be things such as spontaneous blinding sparkles and rose petals that may enhance the mood, but annoy onlookers.

Do You Hate Me? + 200 CP

While before this drawback most people would take rejection easily and without problem (other than a broken heart), now individuals will have a strong dislike for you if you reject them (not hate, unless they would before) and will hinder some plans of yours should it regard romance of some kind. An example would be having a date at a cafe, but the rich heir of a company rents out the cafe for the day to prevent it to spite you for rejecting them. These issues can be ironed out with such an individual over time, but will take a while.

Trope Magnet + 400 CP

Baka! It's not like I like you or anything! Is what one of your suitors might say at some point, poor you! You now attract a disproportionate amount of curious characters that follow common anime and manga trends and tropes like the Tsundere or Kuudere, with that personality

set up to an obnoxious degree. You will meet at least several of these heroes (or heroines) each year throughout the jump with varying, but still tropey personalities and backstories. While you can rehabilitate them over time, it will take significant effort to do so. You like Tsunderes, do you? Try dealing with ten of them at once.

Not So Comedic + 600 CP

Are you really sure about this drawback? This turns the setting into more of a horror jump than a comedic, possibly romance jump. This is done by bringing some of the more horrific tropes into reality. This makes the much more obscure violent tropes such as Yandere, assault, death and worse becoming much more common in this world. What happened to being wholesome?

Author's Notes

To any wondering, this is based solely on the manga and not the drama and as far as I'm aware (I don't watch dramas) there are major differences between the manga version of the MC and the drama version of the MC that appear near the end of the drama.

While it is unknown if it's just Japan affected by the BL tropes, it likely encompases the entire world of the manga and will do so for the purposes of the jump, unless you nullify it with a perk or something.

Just as a disclaimer, the reason I made this jump was because I thought the manga was hilarious and is not meant to shit on people who are LBGT+ in any way.
