Well Jumper, I Made It... Despite Your Directions (+100 CP)- Superintendent Jumpchan seems to be a bit irritable because they had difficulty finding your Warehouse. Although they arrived more or less on time, their bad mood will make the luncheon a bit more awkward and they might be quicker to criticize you.

<u>JUMPER! (+100 CP)-</u> Uh-oh! Just as you were about to leave your kitchen to head to Krusty Burger Jump-chan will appear in the doorway, wondering what the holdup is for lunch. Before you can leave you'll have to explain the smoke that's billowing out of your oven, not to mention why you had your leg out the kitchen window.

Why Is There Smoke Coming Out of Your Oven, Jumper? (+200 CP)- Your oven is now on fire, so not only do you have to sneak over to the Krusty Burger, but you also have to find a way to manage the flames before your whole Warehouse goes up in flames. Or at least get Superintendent Jumpchan out the Warehouse door before then.

<u>I Thought We Were Having Steamed Clams? (+200 CP)-</u> With all the cooking perks available, Jumpchan has gotten the wrong idea about the quality of meal that you'll be serving. Good LORD, What Is Happening In There? (+300 CP)- Despite temporarily lacking in omniscience, Jumpchan's senses seem to be much higher than that of a human's, though not yet superhuman. Pulling one over on them is that much harder as a result.
