Generic Lewd Digimon

Welcome, Jumper, to the World of Digimon! Well, not the "official" one, but some of the adjacent universes that spun off from the original ones. These are those worlds as envisioned by the lewd, the prurient, and the deviant, among some of my other favorite people. You're going to the world of Digimon Pornography.

Digimon is a series spread across multiple dimensions in multiple universes. Usually the Real World, a very confusing name for the Earth populated by mundane humans, and the Digital World, an often surreal realm populated by the titular Digimon. Across the various series, the Digital World has had many origins, many paths to reaching it, connections to numerous other dimensions, and gone through many resets and redesigns. The one constant is that it's home to Digital Monsters, creatures made of data that evolve into more complex and powerful forms, having more in common with incredibly complex computer programs than earthly biology. Nevertheless, their mentalities range from beast-like to fully human and beyond. In many of these worlds, a human or group of humans venture into the Digital World to help save one or both worlds from some apocalyptic threat. They team up with Digimon, empowering them to fight the dastardly beasts and bastards on their behalf.

And you're here to fuck some or all of those things.

To help you with that, take **1000 Choice Points**.

The Digimon series covers a massive set of dimensions and alternate universes, many of which have been reset several times. Now, what sort of adventure were you hoping to have with this jump?

Supplement Mode – If you want to use this Jump as a supplement to another Digimon Jump, choose this option. The CP pools for both jumps must be kept separate and conflicts between the options in these Jumps are left to you to resolve.

Specific Setting – You can choose to use this Jump to enter the setting of a specific Digimon fan work for ten straight years. The only requirement is that the work has a pornographic bent to it. Given the wide variety of options available to you with this, I'm leaving most everything else to your discretion outside of that.

The Digital World – You don't have to enter a specific setting at all, instead finding yourself in a lewd variation on the Digital World. There is no grand plot happening in the background, no potential world-ending threats to face down, and no special destiny in store for you. This state of relative peace seems to have made

Digimon much more likely to want to get down with whoever happens to be passing by. All you need to worry about is having a good time. It's still a world full of monsters great and small, with things like cities or civilizations being few and far in-between, so that might actually be harder than it sounds.

Digital Wanderer – Do you have multiple stories you want to explore? By picking this option, you will spend your ten years heading through different Digimon settings, never staying in one place for too long. You can choose when you leave and who or what comes with you as you go, heading between alternate universes at your own discretion. Whatever you're looking for, I hope you find it.

<u>Origin</u>

Origins are the role your perks will enable you to play. You may choose to have a memory and history in the world applied to you by this origin, but if you want to just drop in out of the blue that's perfectly acceptable. You are in no way obligated towards acting out the role as described here.

Digital Corruptor

Digimon aren't real. They're collections of data. That makes them the perfect tools for you to bend toward your less noble desires. All it takes is the right person with the right skills and this place could become an ideal world of pleasure, under your control. You dive into the Digital World, creating your own paradise out of the raw material this world provides.

Human

You are a human. On your own, you might not be that impressive, but what you do have is the support of others. Your hope, friendship, and love are the wheels on which the Digital World turns. In worlds like this, that love might take on a different meaning, but it is no less potent in its ability to bring about seemingly impossible changes and empower your friends to fight the evils of this world.

Digimon [100 CP]

Digital Monsters. Digimon are the champions. Change into Digital Champions to save the Digital World.

Sorry. You are a Digimon, a being made of data. You are one of the naturally occurring denizens of the Digital World. It's a dangerous place, with disputes settled more often by the strength of your attacks than the strength of your will. As such, you have a body built not just for fighting, but for changing into forms more suited for it as they grow more powerful. And in this world, your body is also for fucking.

Age and Gender

Your age and gender can be whatever you wish for them to be. For Digimon, this won't amount to more than figuring out how many years of memories you have, but this can be pretty meaningful for the other two Origins. Go with whatever best fits the fantasy you came to this world for.

Perks

Perks are discounted based on the Origin that they're attached to. Discounts are 50%, except for 100 CP perks which are discounted to free.

Actually, Digimon Aren't Divided Into Genders [Free & Mandatory for this Jump, 100 CP to Keep]

But that sort of thing is necessary here. Creatures without things like biological sex can now be made to possess functional primary and secondary sex characteristics. You can determine whether their genitals are always available or only sometimes present, but any creature you decide this perk applies to will always have had them.

And for an addition of 50 CP, you can actually determine what gender every affected individual ends up being. If you want a male Renamon or a futa Angewomon or what have you, this perk can assign gender either individually as you prefer, divide the affected group into sexes as you prefer, or allow for an even amount of people of any sex within the defined group. Or whatever else you want.

For an extra 50 CP, you can choose whether you want to stabilize your own gender between forms or leave it fluid. That means that if you Digivolve from a Holy Angemon to a Lillithmon, you can choose if you were a female Holy Angemon or a male Lillithmon. Or maybe you want to flip both sexes to their opposite. That's fine too.

A few caveats: The effects of this perk don't go away if you elect not to keep this perk, but you don't get to reapply it to future worlds. This perk does not inherently affect the power level of individuals that fall under its sway, though certain techniques might require an adjustment to be usable by you. It's purely for your sexual enjoyment.

The Internet Is For Porn [200 CP]

Sex and sexuality will be more commonplace in the world in ways that would appeal to you, with non-mundane worlds being changed to a more significant extant. While the people of Tokyo might not bat an eye at young people sneaking away together in the night, in places like the Digital World you can expect for there to be entire regions dedicated to lewd activities.

If you want, that is. You can choose to dial this perk up or down per world. Make the Digital World a little lustful, with only the cutest Digi-girls interested in what humans have to offer, but upgrade your own pocket dimensions into places that are horribly horny, with all the collective erotic desires of it's resident's brought to the fore. It's up to you, really. Once this perk is set for that world though, it's set until the end of the jump. Reality won't vacillate to your whims.

Without something like "Digimon Aren't Divided Into Genders" this might result in a world of creatures acting out sexuality without any real designs toward it, but I'll not obligate you to take both. Maybe being the only creature around with a functional dick in a world with many examples of giant-breasted monster women that can only satisfy their desires by giving you oral sex is your fantasy?

Acquiescing To Fate's Favor [300 CP]

The Digital World isn't just data as in information. It's belief, dreams, wishes, and fantasies, sensitive to those with power. It's a place where forces such as fate or destiny guide heroes through to happy endings, saving all of reality time and again with the powers of friendship. Carefully chosen children have been led to finding companionship with impossible beasts, miracles formed from the light of their friendship letting them rise up to stop the forces of evil from devouring the all of reality.

And missteps along the way have revealed the weaknesses of this world. Vast concentrations of power applied recklessly, wishes spent only on destruction and causing only destruction, destabilize reality around it in what's known as a Digital Hazard and potentially end both the Real and Digital Worlds. The wisest and most powerful of Digimon are careful of this fact, often sealing their abilities away (or being sealed) and unleashing their full power only when the time is right. Often, the gods and fate itself have had to step in to ensure the worlds don't collapse in on themselves when an individual has hungered for power. With this perk, you can choose to seal your own powers and avoid those perils, handing some of the control you'd have over to the fates that guide this world, descending from something superhuman all the way down to the level of a normal, human child or anywhere in between. In exchange, fate will slot you into its plans for this reality and reward you in proportion to your sacrifice.

Giving up only a small portion of your power will net you a lucky break, money on the street or a chance meeting with a cute person of your preferred gender. But if you entrust your more impressive powers to destiny, destiny will look out for you. You might never have to worry about money again, some lonely, beauteous benefactor happy to dote upon you as their Sugar Baby, or the chance meeting with a single cutie turning into finding your one true love and their sexy twin. This will more than likely, however, spin itself into protection from the forces that work against you. You, and those you care about, won't be crushed by debris or falling Digimon. Your enemies simply won't think to kill you and will go for tougher targets instead. Allies will rally around you, making up for what you now lack in individual power with numbers and a desire to see to your happiness and pleasure. And if there's an artifact you need to unlock the next stages of your powers, fate will all but force it into your hands, alongside it's playful, lonely guardian aching for a night with it's destined owner.

And as the world adjusts to your power, it will become safer and safer for you to unleash it. You'll find your available power growing more and more, easily keeping pace with the greatest of the heroes that destiny had already planned and prepared the world for. What others might train for, you unleash in a miraculous burst of power the moment it's truly necessary.

All that said, you aren't obligated to stick to the whims of fate. You may choose to, at any time, break those seals fully or partially and let some of your true power out. The world probably won't collapse immediately. You might even set conditions such as tying them to a sufficient threat or a transformation sequence. When you do this, you'll find the blessings fate has offered you faltering, your apparent luck diminished in proportion to how much power you unleashed. It will come back as fate rights itself, but how long that takes depends on how much you used.

Digital Corruptor Perks

Programming Genius [100 CP]

The Digital World is one that can be made highly favorable to those capable of understanding it's code. Depending on the continuity, everything from the original Digimon to the magics of Witchelny are just programming languages manifesting in the Digital World. And you have a natural aptitude for these languages, able to decipher and understand them with relative ease. On its own, this does very little, but with time you'll readily master even the most complex of computational disciplines, creating programs the likes of which this world has never seen, and manifesting them in the Digital World through any computer you might have.

Mysterious Evil Stranger [100 CP]

You have an air of mystery. By yourself or with just a couple distinct friends, this merely adds a strange attractiveness when you act in the shadows. The less others know about you, the more likely they are to fill in those blanks with fantasies of a sexual bent and the more willing they grow to learn exactly how accurate those fantasies can become.

Additionally, this perk helps in catching others off-guard. You can lurk in the shadows, hiding with ease and slipping away without a trace. Your sudden and mysterious arrival just to pump somebody full of corrupting seed or fit them with a slavery collar will go off without a hitch, and you'll find you have plenty of time to escape

A Lingering Touch [200 CP]

A virus will corrupt whatever it touches, but the most potent infections leave lingering marks on their hosts long after they've been cured. Now when you affect something with an ability meant to modify them rather than harm them, it has a much more lasting effect, even if your initial plan ends in failure. The effect won't be as strong, but a body you rebuild to be more comely will retain a few inches of bust or a mind you make more loyal will remember how good it felt to submit to another's will. And if you make two people fuck, they'll retain some lingering desires even after the mind control ends. This sort of thing can add up over time. Even in victory, your foes will slowly be drawn into your lewd desires and eventually, maybe, coming under your sway in a more willing

way. Especially if you "have a change of heart." These stories do still love their redemption arcs, after all.

A Dark Charisma [200 CP]

You have a way about you, Jumper. And a whip.

There are many Digimon in this world that willingly serve others, especially those stronger than them. And you are like catnip to them. You have a certain charisma that mixes sensuality and fear in a delightful cocktail that leaves those you've gotten your claws into dying to be under your thumb. And possibly sheets. Digimon and people with a hunger for power or protection will look to you as their natural leader. More powerful Digimon might require bribes, possibly in the form of their enemies being made to bend over for them, but they'll take note of exactly how easy that might be if they worked under you. And once these individuals have submitted to your will, they'll even start to crave the rush your approval and attention gets them.

But if fear is what you were hoping to instill, you're more than capable of doing that too. Your anger is fearsome, and it carries with it an aura of menace that might see a Champion level Digimon cowering in their boots. You are their emperor, and carry the charisma that requires, after all.

Digimon Are Just Data [400 CP]

You have a certain knack for understanding the code behind Digimon. One that gives you insight into exactly how their bodies and minds shape themselves. And from that insight, you can see how to make adjustments to digital lifeforms. It's a fairly resource intensive process, requiring some method of access to their body, but soon you'll be making the basic implements of control like cards that let you change their shape and adjust their attacks or control rings to take over their mind.

At first, this will be as simple as making a Digimon go wild in certain ways, driving them out of their mind with confusion, rage, or lust. As you experiment and master this understanding you'll find how to make more specific adjustments, like tamping down their will, making them camouflage, or trading the strength of mind for strength of body. You could even stop a Digimon from Digivolving, trapping them in a weakened form until you need to unleash them to do your bidding. By studying how the worlds and the creatures in them interact, you might eventually figure out how to impact humans and the other life forms that populate whatever multiverse you're in, enabling you to rewrite their minds or rebuild them with digital constructs. One far off day, you might even find yourself rewriting their very souls and DigiCores, untying the Red String of Fate to bind them to your will instead. Though such a feat would require a truly immense amount of data and energy to accomplish. You may have to tap into whole other worlds to accomplish it.

But you'll note that none of that on it's own really adds anything to the Digimon. You can specialize them, adjust what's already there, but they still have the same level of power. That's because if you do want to add something to them, you have to provide the data

and power to do so yourself. At the height of your skill in modifying Digimon (something you can reach in less than a year with this perk), you'll figure out how to convert data into the parts and pieces you want to add to the subjects of your experiments, repairing Digimon and adding new forms or Digivolutions to their list of options if you include enough of it. One day you might find yourself creating DigiCores themselves. The data you use to conduct these experiments can also impact their results, with stuff like weapons data being especially useful for making cyborg Digimon or pornography being especially good at getting Digimon to like it face-down ass-up after you heal them.

Two final caveats: Digimon do have something like an immune system that will heal and self-correct if your programs aren't stable enough or they may just become so unstable that they break down into loose data and die. And entities that are more powerful require more power and effort for you to control. Power, in this case, not just being something as basic as the attacks one can throw out, but the miraculous power of friendship as well.

Programming In Real Time (And Space!) [400 CP]

Your time in and understanding of the Digital World has taught you more than a little about how the code in it works and exactly how much of it is shaped by the wishes of its inhabitants. This has enabled a somewhat miraculous power of your own. You can tap into the magics of this world, enabling you to cast certain effects with your own energies. What exactly you hope to accomplish is limited by the code you can understand and you'll find different elements require vastly different codes to unlock, but it's nothing the previous perks in this tree haven't prepared you to handle. Things like the small elemental attacks a Rookie Digimon could pull off are no sweat, and things like suddenly ramping up the lust or submissiveness of an individual are already your forte, but the more complicated and powerful effects will be dire, draining abilities that will be difficult to implement mid-combat.

Beyond that, though, the core of this ability is the power to alter data with just your mind and a simple touch. If the thing you're targeting is as powerful as you are, this is just a simple attack that alters their mood or harms them somehow. More powerful or willful individuals might even shrug it off. If you were to take the data in the world, like in the forest around you, this could be the basis of anything you might want to build or construct. Like a Dark Ring, for instance. Or a single use device to throw out a fireball, if you wanted to give this power to someone else.

Land of the Lay [600 CP]

I've already offered you the ability to affect a single person at a time, and that's already a resource intensive process. How would you like to affect a more wide-ranging audience? With this perk, you'll know how to create structures that spread your influence to the world around you. On its own, this perk is limited to some fairly simple, but potent, effects. Depending on the size of what you construct, something like a large obvious tower would affect an area of a few miles, you can make digital lifeforms in the area more prone to certain moods. You'll find yourself able to tap into the code of

anything within this construction's area of effect, enabling you to try to directly take control of something or someone remotely. This effect can range from a subtle calm to everyone in the area becoming absolutely lustful, depending on how well you construct the structure and how long they stay inside of it's range.

When combined with something like **Digimon Are Just Data**, this perk truly shines. This will now let you reconstruct an area, technically making it a vessel for both abilities. All Digimon that enter might find themselves unable to Digivolve, or if you want full of lust and forced to Digivolve into more feminine or masculine forms (though without something to provide the necessary energy and data, I can't guarantee the safety of that idea). These effects will be slower and less powerful overall, but quantity has a quality all its own.

Besides that is the ability to program in much more specific effects for the area or objects within it. You could call forth mists that seek to guide destined partners away from each other and into your traps or summon trees that want to leave their Seeds of Lust and Darkness in every orifice of anyone who happens by. The world is your oyster with this. I mean, if you want. You could make it something less clammy.

Human Partner Perks

Supple Little Waifs [100 CP]

Your body seems softer, Jumper. More delicate. It's something to be coddled and protected, kept safe from a cruel world. And it entices people to do just that. Your lovers will want to make love to it gently, working to maximize your pleasure and make sure you have a good time. They'll listen to you and trust you when you tell them to take it slow, giving you lots of sweet, soft kisses. And if what you want instead is to display your sexuality at its fullest and make love passionately and with abandon? Your body will only enhance the appeal, the thought of your delicate frame shaking with pleasure driving them wild with lust.

Your enemies will still look at your body as something to be protected. Coveted, even. Rather than seek to destroy you entirely, they'll want to capture you and take you home with them. This might be as a thing of beauty or their interests may hinge on ravaging it, but you won't be dead at least.

Growing Up Sucks [100 CP]

It's a simple fact that Digimon have an easier time bonding with those with pure hearts, namely children. And why should you give up on something like that just because you grow up? You'll find that being an adult in no way limits you from the beneficial aspects of childhood. You make easy friendships, never letting your heart fall to the cynicism or despair of adult life. And if a power only works for someone of a specific age, like a Chosen Child? It can now apply to you too. You can now choose whether or not you

count as an adult or a child for the purposes of things that affect individuals based on age.

Clap Those Cheeks If You Believe [200 CP]

In many continuities, the Digital World is built partially on the wishes and beliefs of humanity. That means if you believe hard enough, you can breathe water. It also means if you believe hard enough, you can breathe while trapped between a LadyDevimon's luscious thighs. When it comes to things sex-related, physics and fate will bend to accommodate your desires. You'll have the stamina to go for as long as you need and minor things like a massive size difference between you and your partner won't get in the way of you both leaving satisfied. This won't stop something like a Digimon's massive electrical attack, but if they just want to use that electricity for some bedroom-play, you can expect to survive the damage.

Dicking Down With Destiny [200 CP]

Fate will conspire to bring you closer together with those you care about in a fashion suited to this world. If you were to wander away from the group, hoping for some private time to work on your sexual frustrations, a friend who would be extremely amenable to helping you with that will come find you. Get a little horny while taking the train late at night and you'll find your Digimon partner begging to sit on your lap even though the train is completely empty. If you're taking this as a Digimon and playing by the river and your human partner falls in? Well it's not like Digimon care about nudity. Heck, they may even expect for you to bathe with them regularly after that. The world bends toward helping you have a good time with the ones you care about, and when you do you'll find you're closer than you ever were before.

Cumming Your Heart Out [400 CP]

Your hopes, your wishes, and your desires all culminate into one beautiful display of love that sees to the health and well-being of those you care about. Or maybe you're just tired of listening to them piss and moan. Anyway, the point is that now you can heal digital lifeforms of any sort of damage or corruption afflicting them through acts of physical affection. The intense emotions feed into them, your wish for them to return to a healthy state overpowering any terrible fate that befalls them, and the amount of information contained within your body will restore their systems to fully functional. Your "data" won't even seem to have an impact on their own, instead reinforcing it due to your wish for them to get better. Their mental data will be affected as well, helping to ease their woes and worries as your care and concern gives them a reason to have hope. It's especially good for warding off mind control and data destabilization because of that. Thank you, Doctor Love.

Portals to Other Worlds [400 CP]

The Digital World and the Real World are far from the only realms that exist within the Digimon Franchise. Heck, they aren't even the only Digital and Real Worlds. Places like

Witchelny, where Digimon go to learn magic, or the Dark Ocean are somewhere in the expansive cosmology of this reality.

And you can find a way to get to them, provided someone or something there wants to see you and you want to see them. Is your old Digimon partner still hungry for your dick after the plot separated you? You'll find yourself zapped straight to them the second you pass by a computer tower. Does your high school sweetheart look back at you fondly enough for a one-night stand? You'll run into them again at the bar. Hungry for the feeling of tentacles pounding at all your orifices? The eldritch being from another plane will open a portal to pull you through. Neither time nor space will sever the bonds you've built from your lusts. Getting back is up to you, however.

I Love You, <Insert Partner Name Here> [600 CP]

Digimon and their partners have a bond that goes beyond simple friendship, and with this perk you can forge that bond with anyone that you truly, wholeheartedly care about and who cares about you in return. This bond isn't limited to friends and can be used for lovers and family as well. The connection will grow to be empathic, letting you know how they truly feel in any given moment and also serves to ensure you can always find one another when one of you is in danger. Fate itself binds you together, ensuring your partnership will stand the test of time. You can maintain this bond with as many people you can maintain a meaningful relationship with at once. And they can also share this bond with one another, the power of your feelings for one another growing into a web with you at it's center.

Once this bond is established, however, is when the power really kicks in. If they have any sort of power that runs on things that you have, such as emotions or wells of energy or even simple pain tolerance, you can share that with them and they with you and even one another. You can flood them with emotions and wishes to bring about (potentially strange or new) Digivolutions or help them ward off mind control by letting them borrow your willpower. The connection between Partners is more than just simple friendship, after all.

Digimon Perks

Digital Monster [Digimon only unless taken with **Digital Bodies**, no discounts]

You are a Digimon, but you haven't decided what sort of Digimon you'd like to be. And depending on the continuity you find yourself in, that could be a life or death choice. There are very few consistencies across all the canon continuities and a lot of that flies out the window within the expanse of lewdness. So, since I can't know your setting from my current vantage point in time and space, I'm going to give you a list of options and you can make the choices that fit you best. This might lead into some oddities, and how those are resolved is up to you. The descriptions I'm going to give are extremely general, meant to describe the total power of a Digimon of that level and won't reflect

how it's applied in many cases. Some Digimon are melee only, and some use more esoteric effects.

If you already have a Digimon altform, you can choose to just import as that Digimon. There's no cost, as it's no work for me at all.

For free, you can start off as a Rookie level Digimon, like Agumon or Gabumon. These Digimon aren't the weakest, but they're generally not powerful enough to do more than absolutely wreck the furniture or start a fire.

For 100 CP, you can choose to instead start the jump as a stable Champion level Digimon, like Gatomon or Leomon. Champions are where they start to get powerful, and the average one could do major damage to a house with a single attack.

For 300 CP, you can start as a stable Ultimate level Digimon, like Andromon or Etemon. Digimon at this level are threats to major buildings with a single attack and can be expected to wreck whole cities if left to run wild.

For 600 CP, you can start as a stable Mega level Digimon, like MarineAngemon or BanchoLeomon. This is the level where things go wildly off the rails. A Digimon of this level would start off able to take on a small army and the strongest among them can bring about the end of reality itself. Generally, at this level only another Mega level Digimon could stop you.

For 50 CP you can choose instead to have a custom Digimon form. This form won't be much more powerful than the average Digimon of this level with just this perk, but you can choose what types of attacks you have and how you look. For an additional 250 CP on top of that, you can start in the upper tiers of power for your species, displaying abilities on par with the next level of Digimon. As a Rookie, you could regularly ward off Champion level Digimon. As an Ultimate, you might curbstomp weaker Mega level Digimon. You'll easily be among the strongest Digimon available, with your Mega level on par with legendary figures like the Royal Knights or the Seven Great Demon Lords.

High Quality Graphics [100 CP]

The thing about Digimon is that their bodies represent a collection of data that can take any number of forms, with a single Digimon going from being a pile of rocks to a plant to a brain-alien and then de-Digivolving into a centaur. While I can't guarantee that all the forms you take will be everyone's cup of tea, I can stack the deck in making that form attractive to somebody. Now, any form you take will have both it's apparent power and sexuality enhanced. Muscular bodies you find yourself in will be ripped in a manner that's titillating and not grotesque. Laser cannons replacing your arms will look cool and not just be a horrifying blending of flesh and machine. If you're a giant pile of sludge, you can make your scent overpowering or somehow more enticing. And your sexual assets will always be of a size and shape you consider complimentary to the appearance you were hoping to display, whether that's a giant horse cock on your Patamon form or being the only Angewomon with a B-Cup.

What this perk can't do is add any parts that weren't there initially. It's purely aesthetic, adjusting things like the shape of your legs or making the flavor of your cum a bit more pleasant. It won't make you a futa on it's own (there's another perk for that) or add wings to a wingless body.

Digivolution As Self-Expression [100 CP]

Digivolution isn't just the process of absorbing data and becoming what that data says it is, though that does have an effect on the end result. It's a process shaped by the will and desires of a Digimon (and their human partner, if they have one). And if what you desire is a leather get-up and to have your attacks be leashing your foes to be your playful little puppies then what is Digivolution to stop you? Now, when you go through a major change like Digivolution, you can take on a form a little more reminiscent of your desires. This won't be something completely off-the-wall, but simply a modification to what you were going to be instead. Go from being Bastemon to FemdomBastemon. This form won't be more or less powerful, overall, but it will be specialized toward techniques falling under its theme. The change from entrancing with a belly dance to entrancing with a riding crop isn't that different, after all.

This form is reflective of your desires, and as you explore those desires you'll find yourself unlocking more Digivolutions. This isn't a matter of simple convenience, though, but a reflection of your true desires at that moment. Digivolving into a form that doesn't reflect what you really want will be a much more energy intensive process. Not impossible, but often less than optimal.

I'm Just A Love Machine [200 CP]

The variety of bodies available to a Digimon is immense, not just in size but shape and function as well. And that represents both opportunity and challenge for the dedicated lover of the digital form. Well, a challenge for anyone else. You know how to use your body, no matter what form it takes, to astounding effect in the bedroom. Do you suddenly have a form with four or more legs? Well, mounting your lover won't be an issue at all, regardless of position. Are you suddenly a fish or sea slug of some sort? Making love in the ocean is as easy as riding the waves. Have a face where your genitals should be? This one should be obvious. Your attacks can be toned down and controlled, letting you use them for pleasure instead of pain. Even a Rookie could outbang the wildest of Megas with this perk. Your body is a tool to pleasure and regardless of form it is a masterwork to that end.

Digital Bodies [200 CP]

Sometimes, a Rookie Digimon will disguise themselves as a stuffed toy. A more powerful Digimon, however, will get themselves a human form to hide inside. You can now choose to hide your more powerful body as a human, reshaping your body and hiding away most of your power to avoid alerting any pesky humans to your presence. This form will still be highly reminiscent of your more monstrous form, maintaining as close as it can to your form's aesthetic while still not looking like anything other than a

questionably dressed human being. Your power is hidden, not locked away, meaning that only actively using it will reveal it to others, not that you can't use it at all.

If you're a Human or Digital Corruptor, however, this perk takes on a different effect. You gain access to the **Digital Monster** perk from this tree, but receive no discounts on Digimon Perks and Items.

15,875 GB of Data Per Ejaculation [400 CP]

And that's just an average human cumming a single time. Can you imagine the data output of your average character in a hentai manga? That's the sort of logic this place uses, in fact. By bringing someone to orgasm, you can exhaust them of their energy and data. For Digimon, this makes sex an extremely effective method of depowering your opponent. When you fuck someone, you can use that to weaken them, taking them out of more powerful forms by draining them of whatever energy they were using to maintain it. At the same time, those more powerful Digimon will take a lot longer to drain completely.

And what's there to do with all that data but absorb it? By somehow ingesting or coating yourself in the sexual juices of another Digimon, you will find yourself growing in power. This is most effective at growing your raw stamina and strength, with little use in training techniques. More powerful Digimon offer more data for you to absorb, with Digimon like the Seven Great Demon Lords being able to absolutely drench you in thick, sticky power.

Oh, and as for your own orgasms? Don't worry about it. You can choose whether or not to share your data through sex.

Power Undressed [400 CP]

Everything in the Digital World is data. And data is power. Ergo, everything you have on can be converted to power. If you ever need to use a particularly powerful special technique, you can choose to temporarily sacrifice any equipment you possess, including clothes, armor, weapons, and tools. These will be converted into energy, boosting the effect in a manner of your choosing, but leaving you vulnerable to counterattacks afterward. If used wisely, this could let you hit well above your weight class and leave you well-prepared for your victory celebration. If used poorly, you'll just be naked and vulnerable to whatever threat you were hoping to relieve yourself of.

If the equipment was something you got through Digivolving, like a Sakuyamon's Armor or a Venusmon's birds, it will still be there the next time you Digivolve into that Digimon, but you might find that to be hard to do given how much energy you used on that attack. Best take some time to recover.

Lewd Fusion [600 CP]

Digimon don't really breed, per se. There are Digi-Eggs, but those don't actually come from the wombs of Digimon. Still, Digimon do have a code and those codes do fuse to

create new Digimon. The specifics of that vary from setting to setting within this multiverse, so I'm going to offer you a special variant I've seen several times in the more perverse worlds.

When you have sex with someone, it naturally syncs up your bodies. One of the benefits being vastly improved odds of a simultaneous orgasm. The major benefit, though, is that you can use this synchronization of body and mind to fuse with your partner in a burst of light and energy. That could mean any number of changes, depending on who and how you fuse. The classic is attaining a form you already could, like a Guilmon fusing with their tamer to become Gallantmon. But it's also been used to access new modes, with one partner becoming an energy source that the other draws on until they unfuse, or to simply modify the body of one partner forever, the Digicore of the other simply absorbed into their once-lover. This fusion can be undone at the will of the users, in most cases. This could, in many ways, be considered an upgrade to **15,875 GB of Data Per Ejaculation**, but the requirements are much steeper.

If you're not a Digimon, you can still fuse in the same manner if you purchase this, but I can't tell you what would happen if you were to fuse with another biological creature.

Items

Items are discounted 50% to their attached Origins, with the 400 CP item discounted to free. You can buy multiples of any item, but purchases beyond the first are not discounted. You are free to import similar items into the roles of these items if you so wish.

20 Petabytes of Pornography [50 CP]

Exactly what it says on the tin. It's an extremely well-organized and searchable database of videos, images, and even audio dramas, all created around appealing to the sexier needs of humans and Digimon. Because this isn't just porn of humans, but of Digimon as well. This collection would take decades to go through and covers any and every sort of smut you could hope to get your hands on. What are you going to do with so much data?

Mala Mushrooms [50 CP]

I get that you're both hungry and horny, but just because you find something that is both phallic-shaped and food-shaped does not mean you have to eat it. These mushrooms in particular make those that eat them both hungry and unbearably horny. Which is great if you're sick and have trouble getting an appetite, but not so great if you're trying to survive in the Digital World. You'll find patches of these growing in any forested areas in the Digital World and near your home base in future worlds. They're great if you want an excuse to spend the day pigging out and fucking.

A Handy Laptop [100 CP]

Computers and the Digital World interact in weird ways, but this laptop has been designed specifically to work in the Digital World. Firstly, it has infinite battery life. It also has a database of Digimon, which quite conveniently keeps track of their level, attacks, some tidbits about their personality, and their kinks and erogenous zones. This doesn't update to tell you if the Digimon in question is corrupted somehow. There's nothing too in-depth in this listing, but you won't ever be looking at a Digimon again and just be left asking what the hell their deal was.

Digital Corruptor Items

Regal Threads [100 CP]

You are a ruler of this world, taming it to your will. And you're going to look fabulous doing so, with these clothes fit for a Digital King. This is a custom outfit built to increase how imposing you appear and working with your appearance perks to heighten your appeal to others. You can change others to fit your whims, now make them want it.

Seeds of Darkness [200 CP]

This is the start of your true power. It's the first step to control of the world around you, not just understanding. This is your signature tool, something you determine the shape of, that can attach to a Digimon to bend them to your will. On its own, all it does is disrupt a Digimon's mind, driving them wild with lust. But it's so easy to modify the design and produce more that if you wanted to cause more specific changes, including changes to a Digimon's body, all you'd need to know was the changes you wanted to their code. These are amazing vectors for reprogramming whatever they attach to.

You start with only a handful of these, but you can make more by scanning one with the DESAMT and setting it to make more out of whatever data you collect with it. You could also use a less specialized terminal with the right program. Any time one is lost to you, you'll find it having returned safe and sound the next day.

DESAMT [400 CP, 1 free to Digital Corruptor]

A Digital Entity Scanning and Modification Terminal is a device that enables deep scans and modification of digital code. Especially the code of the Digital World. It's a little larger than your average computer tower, with a monitor attached to the top, and the ability to store enough data that dozens of Digimon could be stored inside, and a handful of attachments that let you collect data on whatever they're pointed at.

This is also how you perform more in-depth and specific modifications on Digimon. As opposed to the Seeds of Darkness applying whatever changes you preprogrammed into them to whatever they came into contact with first, this allows more surgical and real-time interaction between you and a subject. You can save a deep scan of a

Digimon to store their presets, mess with their code as you see fit, and watch their reactions in real time. You can even save pieces of their code or code you created yourself, and potentially design a whole new Digimon from bits of the old ones. Or a building or bridge, but that's boring.

To facilitate this, the DESAMT is able to break down the code of the Digital World, storing it as raw data, before reconstructing it into something new. Simply attach the DESAMT to the target of your ire with a handy cable included in the box and watch as they fall to pieces before your eyes. It's fairly slow-going, with a single 20 foot tall tree taking a full minute to break down. Digimon destroyed this way won't even enter into the Digital World's cycle of reincarnation, instead being rendered into inert power for you to use as you see fit.

XXX Server [600 CP]

This isn't a server in the sense that it's a continent of the Digital World. Unless you force it to be that way, that is. This is a computer that can store nigh-infinite amounts of data and no requirement for an external power source. And that functionally makes it a pocket dimension in this setting. The only issue is that it's empty, a blank void absent of any sign of life or gravity. What use is this? Well, it's the perfect staging ground for whatever experiments you were hoping to run, and perfect storage space for your more elaborate designs. This is a world, your world, free to take whatever shape you desire of it. All it needs from you is the raw materials with which to do it.

Human Items

Digimon Costumes [100 CP]

You have a series of outfits based on Digimon. These costumes range from the silly, like being a giant stuffed Agumon, to the sexy, like Angewomon's skin tight leotard with numerous holes in it and helmet. They're great for cosplay and roleplay alike!

Wilderness Survival Supplies [200 CP]

An astounding amount of the adventures in the Digital World involve traveling for days on end through the middle of nowhere and surviving off the kindness of strangers and sheer dumb luck. You can reduce your reliance on luck with this handy satchel full of supplies. It has everything a kid, like you presumably are, would need to survive in the Digital World for a few months: a tent, some spare ropes, toilet paper, a first aid kit, lube, a massive vibrator, some spare batteries, a flashlight to explain to your friends why you have those batteries, enough food for a few days, fishing gear, water purification tablets,

a trowel, and a lighter to help start campfires. Your trip through the Digital World will practically be a vacation with these things, giant monster battles aside.

Digivice [400 CP, 1 Free to Humans]

A Digivice is a small handheld computer that helps channel and focus your connection to your Digimon and your inner light to the outer world. These things have taken many forms, and had many functions, but the one you receive will be destined to end up a high-end model for your chosen setting. Why destined? Because Digivices can grow and change with the human they're attached to, either through the power of the digital world or because they are a consumer product in that world and you can buy add-ons. The one guarantee is that this will strengthen and expand on the ways in which you connect with your Digimon. You may be able to communicate or track their location through it, or shoot out bursts of light to protect them if your powers are granted by light. Just be a dear and take care of the thing. It'll fix itself if you take a moment to strengthen your connection to your Digimon (if you know what I mean), but you might not have the opportunity before you need it.

Not Doing This Alone [600 CP]

There is a full-blown government organization dedicated to understanding and policing Digimon in the Real World. And what they lack in protagonism, they more than make up for in side-character-level ability to support you. The nature of this organization will vary from world to world, but they always seem to have some of the world's smartest scientists, sneakiest spies, and sluttiest secretaries. Not to mention the resources they can bring to bear in the name of saving the world are actually world-saving level resources. If you needed a Digimon tracked, they could handle it easily, but getting it bound and gagged is up to you.

It really is just a coincidence that all these people seem to be the sort that would jump at the chance to get with you, should you start giving them the opportunity. And there always seems to be someone who fits your taste hanging around their base when you're in the mood. It's almost like they have access to your browser history and want to keep you happy, but there's no way a government organization would do something so violating...

Digimon Items

For The Aesthetic [100 CP]

You have some pretty cool ideas for how you want to look, but not the tools to get it done? Get yourself some bits and bobs to customize your look. Your Digimon forms come with a handful of attachments that mostly just make you cool and thematic. This might be a leather jacket and pants that hug your ass impossibly well, or a handful of simple pets that function as the delivery method for one of your attacks. As a Gomamon you'd never have to worry about not having enough fish for your Marching Fishes attack again.

And whatever this actually gets you will be items or elements of your Digimon body at your discretion. That means that any time you change into your Digimon form or

Digivolve to a different level, you can choose to have these items simply appear on your person.

A Place To Be Alone Together [200 CP]

There's this hidden, little, out-of-the-way place you know about. It's nothing special, maybe just a dry cave or an eerily well-manicured clearing in the middle of the woods. The atmosphere is warm and intimate, as if you and whoever you bring with you are the only people in the world. And you may as well be, for all the outside world matters in this place. You won't ever be interrupted here, no matter what you do or how loud you get while doing so. It's the perfect place to bring someone to murder them, basically.

In this and future worlds, this place will appear when and where it's most convenient to you.

Digital Entity [400 CP, Free to Digimon]

Behemoth is a motorcycle that can possess anyone that rides it. The ZERO-ARMS are Digital Lifeforms that Digimon use as weapons and vehicles. You now possess a similar Digital Entity. They aren't truly intelligent, and thus don't count as companions. You can choose what form this helpful little assistant will take. A vehicle mode will be about as fast as Behemoth or Grani, letting it easily keep pace with a runaway Locomon. A weapon will work as a particularly potent focus for your power, massively boosting your strength and allowing you to pull some cool new tricks with it. And if you used this to grant yourself an autonomous sex toy backed by your own power and with a hunger to improve at it's job? I doubt it would be any less effective at stopping your opponent in their tracks than the weapon option.

Aside from that, they receive the same benefits as **For The Aesthetic**. You can determine whether or not they are part of your Digimon body any time that body changes.

Digimon Village [600 CP]

Your hometown, probably. What this village actually is and who lives in it will be left up to you, whether it's a fortress, factory, farming town, terrible trap, or toyland. Wherever it is, there's plenty of food and water available to you, and better than that: friends. Mostly the Digimon that live here will be Rookies, banding together to take care of each other in this often deadly land. But you can expect a few Champions or even an Ultimate or two to be hanging about the place to act as the village's primary guardians against evil. This place and it's residents will always have you back, going along with whatever crazy plans you concoct, and completely willing to serve whatever needs you might want them to satisfy.

In future worlds, this little Digimon Village can be made to appear in any system or realm capable of hosting a Digimon.

Companions and Followers

You may, at your discretion, import a companion into any of the options available here.

Digimon Partner [Free with Digivice, additional partners cost 200 CP]

Your Digivice comes with a mandatory new best friend to fight on your behalf. They have the **Digimon** Origin and 800 CP to spend on perks and items. Unless mistreated somehow, they'll be ever loyal to you. Otherwise, their personality is completely up to you.

Beyond that, they hold a special connection with you. This bond strengthens the both of you, the power of friendship building within you both as you bond intimately with one another. Now, that's not to say you have to have sex with them, but if you want to grow close quickly it couldn't hurt. For the Digimon Partner, this growing power will be a well that they can tap into to Digivolve into higher and higher levels. For you, this will be a simple burst of power that can emanate from your Digivice to scare away evil Digimon when your partner can't be around.

Human Partner [1 free for Digimon, 200 CP for more]

The counterpart to the previous option, a companion with the **Human** Origin and 800 CP to spend as they wish. You have a human ally with a Digivice of their very own. And this Digivice is attuned to you. You can feel the connection with them as an instinct as deep as any other, one reflective of the desires and wishes you both share. You'll be hungry at the same time, happy at the same time, and most especially horny at the same time. You can choose to ignore this instinct, as with any other, but following it will see your connection and power grow to new heights. The miraculous power of Digivolution will avail itself to you as they wish and beyond that, you'll find your parameters growing even at your lowest levels.

Your partner can be whatever gender and age you wish and will have a personality complimentary to your own. Think carefully about who you choose for them to be, however. You're bonded by fate, after all.

Digital Benefactor [Free Digital Corruptor, 200 CP for anyone else]

There's a mysterious force in the Digital World. And it wants to FUCK. It would seem that much like Homeostasis or King Drasil, there's a powerful being that serves to guide the world toward a specific end. In this case, that end is to fill the world with lewdness. It has a handful of powers to assist in this endeavor, things like possessing weak individuals already inclined to lewdness or twisting nature and probability to make lewdness more possible, but mostly it prefers to empower others to spread lewdness on their own.

This being has chosen you to be it's champion in the Digital World, and will work with you to enhance how you apply your lewder powers. If you reprogram a Digimon, it will help fill in any holes you might have missed. If you create a tree with fruit that increases the breast size of those that eat it, your benefactor will draw in hungry travelers to eat from it. If someone starts spreading a cure for your lust virus, it will cause the virus to mutate into something that can overcome that cure (and maybe that virus will develop a few other useful abilities as well).

But most importantly, they'll find people to support you in spreading your perverse will to the world. It can reach out to anything with lust in their hearts, whispering in their ear and guiding them to you. Digimon that want to be modified will be pulled to a Digital Corruptor, ready to serve their whims in exchange for a taste of what they have to offer. And in a world like this, that could get you any number of henchmen to experiment on. A Digimon or Human hungry for a partner that can satisfy their urges would see themselves pulled toward Jumpers with other origins. And if what your foes really want is a piece of your action? Your Benefactor is happy to tempt them to your side.

Tagalong Digimon [50 CP off the first purchase for any Digimon that did not take a Human Partner]

A Digimon Partner is far from the only Digimon that would seek to give another aid. More often than not, a Digimon will serve to guide a hero, villain, or other Digimon on the path they take through the Digital World. They might have their own goals in things or simply be a kind soul helping out some lost children. That and the rest of their personality is up to you to determine when you buy this. What I will say here is that if you want to take one of these Digimon along on your journey, it's going to cost you a bit.

For 50 CP, you can have a Rookie or lower level Digimon. These ones aren't much use in combat, but they can provide information or color commentary. They'll do their best to stay out of the way, otherwise. This is where you might find a submissive little Gabumon, shy and willing to follow your every whim. Or do you want a little Gazimon henchmen ready to do your dirty work for you?

For 100 CP they could be a Champion level Digimon. These Digimon tend to take the role of guides for the heroes early in their adventures. In worlds like this they tend to either fall or become corrupted somehow, going from a steadfast guardian to someone who can serve as both slave and predator at the behest of their masters. Maybe your love can cure them?

For 300 CP you may take an Ultimate level Digimon. Digimon at this level tend to be pretty confident. Some would say cocky, even. They'll be more than willing to show off their bodies and attacks for you. They've even been known to take charge and give the bad guys a firm, guiding hand on their path to darkness, mixing temptation into their displays of raw sexuality.

For 600 CP, this can be a Mega level Digimon, one with little to no qualms about taking what they want. Digimon at this level are the kings and queens of the Digital World and

know it. They are massive presences in the bedroom, powerhouses ready to take you where and how they want it. That doesn't mean they're all dommes, but it's more than likely true that you can expect their sexuality to be pretty open.

A Sibling [50 CP]

You didn't enter this world alone, whether you came willingly or were summoned. With you came a member of your family, a brother or sister. This is true even if you're a Digimon, the two of you emerging from the same Digi-Egg. They may be older or younger, half or full siblings, but they are still someone you share a pretty important bond with. Sometimes, with the way they look at and talk to you, it might even begin to seem like they have a crush on you or something.

For an additional 50 CP, they can come with a Human or Digimon Partner, and receive 800 CP to spend in the appropriate tree. If you want, they can even be partnered to one of your Partners, with the relationship becoming a three-person affair.

Friends and Partners [50 CP each, 300 CP for 8]

If you don't want to go on this journey alone, why not buy up some friends? You can either create or import up to 8 companions that each receive any origin you want and 600 CP to spend on perks and items. You are free to partner these people and yourself up in any arrangement that you wish, and give them whatever background sounds sensible to you.

You're Cumming With Me [50 CP for humans, 100 CP for Digimon]

Is there someone you were hoping to take with you from this world? Well, if you can get them to agree to accompany you, I can see no reason why you shouldn't take them along. I do hope you aren't separating a child from their Digimon friend, though. That's just cruel.

Drawbacks

Indented options are suboptions, requiring the Drawback above them to be taken before them.

No Off Switch [+100 CP]

Points for playing to genre. Literally. Sex will always be in the back of your mind and you will constantly be presented with opportunities to act on your lusts. On its own, this won't be more than a distraction, but if there was something else you were hoping to do while here, it'll feel like pulling teeth to get yourself to do it.

Digital Perverts [+100 CP]

There are no less than four Digimon with crotch bulges. Most of them are Etemon. The one Etemon without a crotch bulge has an ass you could bounce a quarter off of. It's not unusual for Digimon to, en masse, fall in love with ten-year-old girls and have to be stopped from sexually assaulting them with violence. No one bats an eye at Digimon having their primary outfit be leather fetish gear, swimsuits, their fursuit, or some combination thereof. That's all canon to the Bandai Digimon settings.

And this drawback takes that up to twelve. This jump originally enabled smut, but from here on out it will be like you're walking through a sexual parody of the Digital World. And not just in the ways you might like. If something in any of the canon Digimon settings showed even a hint of sexuality, here it's taken to the extreme. Sexy Digimon aren't just bombshells, they're assets would break a normal human. Perverted Digimon like Numemon that would normally try to steal a kiss go for the whole enchilada now. And if a Digimon dresses like a kinkster? Well, expect them to back it up.

Digital Worlds A Big Place [+100 CP]

You're going to be traveling a lot, and you have one stable mode of transport. Relying on others for transport will cost you, though. Usually in sex, though, so it's no biggie. Anytime you rely on others to travel a distance greater than a few miles, you'll have to offer yourself sexually to someone or something. This might present an issue with something like Locomon, but I'm sure they'll like it if you masturbate while inside them or something.

You're Going To Have To Open Your Mouths Much, Much Wider [+100 CP]

If you want to swallow each other. Like a lot wider.

You (and any companions you brought with you from other worlds) have no idea what sex is anymore. All memory of it has been scrubbed from your head, making you

extremely naive. This, quite naturally, leaves you vulnerable to any number of deviants that don't really deviate too far from the norm of this place. Your idea of what sex is will be rebuilt by the sexual experiences that others guide you into, so let's hope that you've surrounded yourself with good people and Digimon.

Broken-Hearted [+100 CP]

Sometimes you'll develop feelings for a specific individual. Romantic, not just sexual ones. Well, they have eyes for another. And unless you really bring your A-Game, that person will beat you for their affections every single time. Maintaining these affections will be a full-time job and striking out against your romantic rival will only see your love interest lashing out at you and going to comfort them. Still, it's better than the usual being trapped in romantic despair that these stories have, right?

I Have No Genitals And I Must Moan [+200 CP]

Unfortunately, you lack the ability to feel sexual pleasure. You don't lack the desire, or drive, but where your sex organs should be, there isn't anything other than a little hole to piss from. Any other erogenous zone you might be thinking of using no longer works to get you off, but still heightens your need to do so. Just like many canon Digimon, you have such a capacity for lust and none of the tools to resolve it.

I'm A Digimon!? [+200]

Regardless of your Origin, you start this jump trapped in the body of a Rookie Digimon. It's not a particularly powerful one and you can't Digivolve out of it just yet. There is a way to get back to your old life, however. The first you, the origin you signed up for, is still around. You have to find them, somewhere out in this world, and have sex with them. The next morning, you'll be back to being one person. No one but you will remember taking this drawback and failure to go fuck yourself will result in you losing this jump. This being a relatively simple challenge, given that you've chosen to come here, I'll throw in an optional complication...

And My Friends Don't Believe Me!? [+100]

You won't start off trapped as a Rookie Digimon, but will instead become them at some point in your journey. When this happens, your old self and your friends won't remember and will lose any evidence of you taking this drawback. You, with only the power of your Digimon body, have to track down yourself and at least eight of your friends and sleep with them. You can do this all at once or one at a time, but you can't use any perks to force them into it.

TK! [+200 CP]

You have a younger sibling, partnerless friend, or weaker digimon that you love and want to keep safe from the evils of this world. Thankfully, those evils don't want to just kill your loved ones. They want to trap them in a life most lewd. You still want to save them from that, though. Jumper, you have to make sure your loved one gets through

this jump safe and sound, fighting off all the evils that come to take them from you (or offering yourself up to them instead), or returning them to a healthy state of mind. If they're captured and turned into a sex slave or corrupted into a slut, you're the guy who has to see to their recovery and restoring a healthy attitude toward sex to them.

And they will more than likely be captured at some point, given their vulnerability as a target. There's still a chance to save them, if you find them quickly enough. They might lose their virginity, but they won't have had their spirits broken.

An Ounce of Prevention... [+100 CP]

...Is worth a pound of cure. You've decided against helping them through these situations and are going to instead stop your younger sibling from ending up in them at all. In a world like this, that takes eagle eyes, an eternal vigil, a lot of power, and more than a little luck. Now, if they're corrupted or taken into sex against their will, you'll be forever distraught and guilty. You won't lose the jump, but you will have to spend it miserable and morose, trapped in the memories of your failure. Sex will even start to lose it's luster as it reminds you of the fate you let befall the one you cared about.

Lost and Alone [+300 CP]

You will often find yourself separated from most of your friends and companions for extended periods of time. Evil Digimon love to scatter the heroes, separating them and taking them out one-by-one, rather than having to lose to the power of friendship (and courage and all the others). This is now guaranteed to happen to you and your friends. It will take you at least weeks before you start finding your allies again.

Meanwhile, your allies will be found by your enemies and corrupted in some way. How each individual is impacted and how far along they are on the path to corruption depends on the kind of person they were already. No matter what, your enemy will pull them away from you and the rest of the group, offering them a role in life that will be full of pleasure. It's up to you to get them back on your side again, and convince them that what you have to offer is more worthwhile.

A Weakling Like You [+300 CP]

Your power is drastically reduced. As a Digimon, this would mean that the power of your attacks is on par with the average Digimon a level lower than you are. Your Rookie level attacks won't amount to more than a weak bubble. If you're a Human, you have something that stops you from bonding with your Digimon like you should, putting you

miles behind where you'd need to be to power your way through things. If you're a Digital Corruptor, even the simplest reminder of friends or loved ones is enough to free someone from your modifications, and any creature you create will view you as a parent and rebel by making friends. You can still succeed, but you'll have to be exceptionally cunning to do so.

I hope you're the sort that enjoys being at the mercy of others, because in this world losing will cost you more than just your pride. But, in a sexy way.

"Friends" with "Benefits" [+300 CP]

Your friends want to look out for you. They really do. And part of that is being a good wingman. Sometimes, when you develop romantic or sexual feelings for someone, they'll help you get laid without you even having to ask. They'll get your digimon partner or minions out of the way, help you get it up by sucking your dick a little, tie you up so you don't get nervous and run away, and even load the girl you've had a crush on with aphrodisiacs so she'll be happy to bang it out with you. They'll hang around to watch, cheering you on and supporting you the whole while. And if you can't finish the job, for some reason, they'll happily help there, too, bringing your love interest to the orgasms you couldn't. I'd be very careful about the friends you make in this world, Jumper, because it could be any of them that attempt this.

If you're wondering, this is the plots to a story and a doujin I found.

You Have To Save The World [+300]

Normally if you didn't mess with the plot too heavily, everything would resolve itself a-okay. The Digital World and Real World want to live, and they'll fight to make that happen. Now you have to actually step up and take on a role in the plot in order to survive. What this means will depend on your chosen setting and mode, but you can bet that if you fail, there's a chance that the reality you're in will fall apart completely and you'll fall apart with it. Don't think you get out of this just because the setting or mode you chose stops there from being a consequential threat to reality. I'll make one for you. With blackjack and hookers.

And You Can't Use Your Dick To Do It [+200]

Attempting to solve your problems using anything sexual will always make things worse, not better. Your lewd perks will fail you, or empower your enemies, or reveal a strategy to your foes that will see your teammates and allies crumble where you might not. You can still have your fun during your downtime, but whatever plot you're caught up in will only suffer under the weight of your libido.

Ending options

10 years have passed in these worlds. Any drawbacks you want removed are hereby removed. Now, we need to decide what you're going to do next.

Go Home: Got what you came for? Well, it's been a pleasure watching you work. Maybe I'll peek in again to see what you're up to, but you've earned your rest.

Stay: I'm happy you found a world you like enough to want to stay behind in. I hope you and your new friends have fun.

Continue: I was hoping you'd say that. I do so love to see you in action. We're going to leave this world behind, but you can keep everything you purchased here and take it into any future Jumps you undertake. Now, let's see. Where to next....
