Background

Perks

Author

My Mid Mind (100cp)

This should go without saying, but the minimum for a writer is to be able to write, to have enough creativity to craft stories that will steal the focus of the reader and the ability to put those in paper. With this you become a decently talented writer, capable enough to create vast and complex storylines as well as write them down in an interesting manner for the readers. You aren't a genius at it, but way better than most.

What The Readers Want (200cp)

There's something magical in being able to pour your entire being and soul into a work that has your best in it. Sadly, for the most part it's way too long of a process and usually not marketable enough. To counter that, you have learned a way to distance yourself from your own 'products' and write in a way that appeals to the masses and the market demands while maintaining quality. For the most part this allows you to churn out profitable works without losing the focus from your real passion writing.

The One & Only (400cp)

While being an author (especially a light novel one) normally wouldn't help you with socializing, it seems that fate itself conspires to pair you with many attractive and talented people that will quickly come to like you for who you are. It's a very powerful effect that increases according to your attitude and desires. You could be a pervert obsessed with little sisters with a shitty personality while lacking any future, and you would still have half a dozen women interested in dating you, plus a sizeable number of friends that genuinely support you.

Write That Up (600cp)

There are many authors that pour decent, even great works out there. Then, there are AUTHORS, who unequivocally create masterpieces that resonate with thousands, if not millions, pieces of work that are talked about and consecrated for generations after the death of the creator. Works of true art that change lives. And you are one of such geniuses. Your writing brings people to tears, touches their very hearts, and can easily inspire them to pursue another path in life. The talent you hold is the real deal and would easily allow you to be the top writer in any label you try at, also guaranteeing that your works get many adaptations of the highest quality available.

Editor

Tokimeki (100cp)

One needs to have a decent amount of emotional maturity to interact with the weird personalities of these people on a regular basis, deal with their nonsense, and somehow manage to get work done without resorting to physical violence. That's what you're good at, getting stuff done despite the nonsensical personalities and quirks of the people you work with, and managing to maintain a semblance of schedule.

Eye Of The Poacher (400cp)

Helping an author grow is one of your main skills, but for that to happen you need to get the author first, and not just anyone will do, you need someone with actual talent and potential rather than a one-shot cookie-cutter isekai webnovel maker. Actual Adult (600cp)

They will work on it to the best of their ability but within the limits of the time and budget – of which they will be provided a small base budget that you will most likely will need to increase by yourself if you want something even remotely decent. You get another one of these each year.

Bruh, I need a drink (200cp)

There are many ways to spent time with friends or get to know someone knew. For some damn reason you decided to use tabletop games for that, as a result, now you have quite the incredible collection of games to play with others, they range from mystery card games, to life-simulators, passing by classics like RPGs and narrative-based ones. You will get new games every week, free of charge, so you never get bored. Now, you just need to find some people to play them with.

867-5309 (200cp)

Keep talking about them eroge and suddenly they will start being made like crazy.

Pesky Fly (400cp)

Do you know what's mankind's best friend? Dogs? Close, but no cigar. The answer is alcohol. It has been handholding humans ever since its inception, and to honor that, here's a self-replenishing collection of all kinds of spirits, alcohols, wines and such alcoholic beverages from all around the world. A relatively small wood compartment seemingly inoffensive, just by putting your hand in there and wish for a particular concoction you will get several bottles of the stuff. Special Osaka chocolate beer sold once a year, old Italian wine lost ages ago, strong vodka from Russia. Whatever you want, and it actualizes its repertoire to add new alcohol from new world you visit.

Quiet Apartment (400cp)

It comes with a special room that's always quiet and with comfortable temperature, no matter what's happening outside, while in there your concentration will be boosted, to help you work through those pesky deadlines. From the ground up (+200cp)

Turns out you're a total newbie in the industry and you will have to claw your way into the ladder. This really doesn't mean much, except being treated like an idiot sometimes regardless of your actual skill.

No industry for old authors (+300cp)

You now have a huge complex about your own talent and skill, it might even cripple interpersonal relationships without someone willing to truly support and understand you. Hope you have good companions.

Already told you to fuck off (+300cp)

Someone got a hold of very embarrassing secrets of you and have decided to milk it for all its worth, they won't ask for anything too unreasonable as they know the blackmail only go so far, but expect to be inconvenienced every now and then. They will stop after a few months or when you learn to put your foot down.
