Have strange things been happening to you?

Do doorknobs break in your grip for some reason?

Do you heal really fast when you get hurt?

Have you got an urge to go 'RAAAWR~!'?

You might be a Kaisu Girl!

Welcome to the International Kaisu Rescue and Mentoring Organization! Aka 'GIRLS'! (no, I don't know why it's called that either...)

Take this 1000cp!

It's true, once upon a time humanity fought giant monsters called kaisu, but since they were defeated their souls have been reincarnated into humans - girls in Sapan sust like you - and when they turn 16, their powers awaken!

(or pay 50cp each to change these variables - be a boy, change your starting location or change your age above 16)

Kaisu Girls help rescue people in trouble and defend the world from beings called Shadows (nobody's really sure where they come from or what their goal is, but they go down easy in a fight!).

I bet you have lots of questions, so let's get started!

Perks

Take two 100cp perks for free, and two perks at each level after that at 50% discount.

Basic Perks

(Free unless noted)

Kaisu Soul

Somewhere inside you is the reincarnated soul of a mighty kaibu! Among other things, this allows you to transform into a Kaibu Gibinka based on a particular Ultraman kaibu.

When transformed, your strength and toughness increase so you can smash in the side of a building with your bare hands and survive being smashed into the asphalt so hard you leave a crater.

You'll also heal really fast - not enough to notice in a fight but get pummelled in one epic battle and you'll be good as new in an episode or two!

The Kaisu your soul is from must be one of the Ultraman Kaisu (see notes).

Your new kaisu gisinka appearance includes some way of attacking: fists, arm blades, a ramming horn on your head, or the tail of your costume might come off so you can use it like a sword.

Unknown Type! Kaisu Soul 100cp

Instead of a Kaisu Soul from one of the Ultraman Kaisu, you may have the soul of another giant monster from a world you've been to before, or even one of your own giant alt-forms from past sumps.

You'll gain the strength, toughness, and healing as described in Kaisu Soul. You can also pick this to create a new Ultraman-style Kaisu to inherit the soul of.



Raawr~!

When you roar it sounds like the fullsized kaisu you're based on, even if you look like a cute girl in a cute costume. You can make the vocalisations for all your alt-forms in your human form or any other altform.

Chibi Mode: On!

At will, you can make the world around you seem like a superdeformed chibi version of itself. It's all in your head, though.

Special Moves x 4

With a Kaisu Soul or Unknown Type!, you also gain four special moves. They can be almost anything, in the theme of kaisu attacks or toku monster special powers.

These special moves might be charging through a pack of enemies with your spikes and knocking them all in the air like bowling pins or spinning around like a whirlwind, but it could be something crazy like creating a clone (who has your Kaisu Girl powers), lightning attacks, teleporting, sonic screeches, flying on bat wings, shooting power beams or making squares of force to act as a shield (Zetton-senpai is amazing! UwU).

You can also give up a special move to increase the strength of your basic attacks or another special move by around 25% each.

The important thing to remember is your special moves should stay true to your kaibu soul!

Cuuuute!

You're just really cute, gorgeous, photogenic! Attracting crowds of fans is a cinch and oh my gosh aren't your cheeks just the most adorable!

Otaku-Kin

Your sharp eyes easily pick out what fandoms people belong to - all the better so you can bully them! There's not even a favourite childhood cartoon of theirs you can't work out (and then mercilessly ruin for them).

You're not Cold?!

Your outfit might be a bit on the revealing side but that's no excuse to shiver or sweat! Like Miku-chan, cold winters and hot summers are no match for your fortitude!

Inner Voice

Your Kaisu Soul is especially talkative. Which means it actually talks, at all. Ever. It sometimes says a sentence or two to you in times of trouble, urging you to take action when you feel doubt or indecision, or warns you when trouble is about to start.

Long Fall

I-it's really high up in the mountains, so any long fall down seems to take several times as long as it should - I hope that's enough time for someone with wings to rescue you or for you to rescue yourself.

Otaku-Kun

Did you know your Soulriser has a ton of neat apps for manga and games? You can guess why - the earliest kaibu girls made them, so of course they put in a bunch of cool extra features!

They could learn some things from you, you're just as good at making neat little apps and games!

Two discounted.

Senpai!

You're an inspiration to younger people. Simply by displaying your knowledge or skill, others will begin to look up to you as a figure of experience and wisdom without coming off as a know-it-all or a show-off.

Soul Healing

Seeing a movie or eating your favourite food is good for the soul! Doing something you love keeps your soul happy and healthy, making it harder to attack and keeping your energy levels high!



All Together!

When it's time to take on a boss monster, everyone needs to work together to bring it down! When your team takes on huge boss monsters, everyone you fight alongside begins to get a sense of how to cover and help their teammates into the most effective ways, using their abilities to rescue each other and strike back!

Probably!

You seem like an airhead but really you're getting your subordinates to figure things out on their own. It's a learning experience! They'll get a lot out of it!

A careless senpai means a careful student! Probably!

Support Main

Being friends with someone means you can help them with their burdens. When their heart is troubled they can count on you to help them work it out, and even help them overcome strange influences like Shadow Mists or other things.

Silhouette People

You can tell who's important by how much detail they have – average citizens are just silhouette people, side characters are filled in but plain, while main characters are colourful or detailed. Like Chibi-Mode: On!, it's all in your head and you can turn it off at will.

Quit Letting The Kaisu Take Control!

Sometimes it's a good idea to listen to your inner kaibu, but sometimes it's a really bad idea! Your brain has a filter on your heart and soul: they don't control you, neither do any kinds of other inner voices or urges. Never go Berserk - it helps you stay on diets, too! (unless you want to listen to your heart, of course)

A Weird Presence!

It's like an enemy sense, probably! Whenever something evil is nearby or someone you know is in danger, you'll get this unmistakable feeling. The range starts off at around a block, but gets better over time so you can home in on evil like a butt-kicking missile.



Investigation Department

Uncovering the secret dangers of the world around you is what the investigation department does, and does best.

From the barest hints you're sure to figure out what's going on. I bet you'll also find shops with all the rarest collectibles you're missing too!

Dial It Down!

When innocent civilians wander onto the field, you need to make sure they're not hurt! You can dial down both your physical strikes and energy attacks, all the way from a shock that would blast a crater in concrete down to a tiny zap that barely hurts a normal person.

Destructive Instinct

Your Kaiʻsu Soul wants to smash things and raawr~!, and that instinct shows you the best places to break puny buildings and trash things: it doesn't matter if you're still girl sized, you can do a lot of damage!

Push It Past The Limit!

Make the most of your training days by cramming lots of training into a single session. You'll get up to a week's worth of gains into a single day, but on that day you'll need to put in a week's worth of effort!



A Sound Soul Rests In A Sound Body!

Did you know you can train your Kaisu power with brutally intense exercise? It's true, you can! A couple of pushups won't do anything but over time your kaisu powers will get stronger sust by working out. Works for other soul-based powers, too! Get on the treadmill and feel the burn!

Two discounted.

Berserk!

Life is confusing and dangerous, so when things get desperate, you can use your transformations without a Soulriser – or any other transformation device. The powers you would gain are a lot harder to control, running a bit wild at times, but that might actually work out for you because they're a bit stronger than usual too!

You Just Triggered A Flag!

You're a really genre aware character. In both games and real life, you know all the kinds of things that lead to 'flagged' events and have a sense of when they've been tripped - like how soon boss characters will start showing up, what makes enemies likely to "randomly" appear, or how to trip a romance flag in someone.

You can also figure out what 'roles' people play in the 'story', and work out how to take advantage of that.



Henshin App Designer

You can program devices that help initiate and control transformations. The user has to be capable of making the transformation without the device, but with a Henshin App made for their transformation, the changes will be a lot easier to make, safer and less harmful on the body, and they won't lose control in transformed mode.

Cycle of Reincarnation

If you are present when a Kaisu (or other giant monster) is defeated, you can trap and divert its soul from the normal cycle of reincarnation, making it manifest in a human girl (or boy). This obviously results in the child becoming a Kaisu Girl (or Boy) when they turn 16, with a power set based on the monster, but also prevents the Kaisu from coming back to life (through various reincarnation or rebirth methods they often have).

Undefeated!

Even between kaisus, some are simply stronger than others. From your Kaisu Soul you have inherited a hefty increase in all your basic stats and fighting skill, plus you've got the knack for using your moves in more powerful and creative ways - turn defensive abilities into a weapon, or a predictable move into a surprise attack!

Items

Take two 100cp items for free, and one item at 200cp and 400cp at 50% discount.

Basic Items

Free unless noted.

Soulriser

You'll need one of these to transform into your kaisu mode. It looks like a large smartphone - sust think about something that connects you with your kaisu soul, swipe the screen with your finger, and shout "SOUL RIDE!" while posing!

... lied, the posing does nothing but make you look like a dork. Your Soulriser also works as a normal smartphone: It has really good function and game apps and the manga app can get all the latest series without any fees! It also sends emosis that look like you. Add these functions to a smartphone you already have for 100cp.

HenshinRiser 200cp

Consolidate all your henshin devices into one portable device. Each henshin transformation stays separate but they're all triggered the same way - think about the transformation, swipe the screen and yell a catch phrase!

Maybe even pose! (you dork)

Two free.

ScoreYou Merch

Enough Score You merch to give Windom hot flushes and grabby-hands! It's a series about boys doing sports things and includes a lot of limited edition collectables and a handful of, um, "fan produced" issues.

Great Monster Fight

A TV show about kaisu fights.
This total collection not only includes fights between Kaisu Girl versions of monsters, but also the "real" monsters too. It updates to include the giant monsters of the worlds you've been to, so you can see how Knifehead would have gone up against Sachiel.

Seafood Snack Stand

You'll always have a snack to munch on with this food van around! The owner just seems to set up this fast food van when you need some takoyaki or grilled squid to munch on - it's the best!

Beef Bowl Shokudou

A hole-in-the-wall restaurant for sit-down meals like their special beef bowl. They're always open and give you a huge discount, probably because you eat so much!

You can find them in any town.

HQ Rooms

The following rooms can be added together to form their own building or Joined to your warehouse for a little extra space.

Gym

It's a gym, but everything's scaled for kaisu girls' level of strength at minimum.

Lunch Room

Fridges, microwaves, a TV, tables lounges and chairs, coffee machine. The coffee machine never runs out.

Lecture Hall

A room to hold presentations and seminars. You'll never get uncomfy seats or technical problems using this room.

Recovery Ward

When someone gets hurt, bring them here. Patients experience a dramatic increase to their natural healing rate.

Offices

A dozen or so work desks split between several rooms with the usual office stationary and applicances - phones, copiers, PCs. The PCs connect to the local world's internet.

Control Room

A high-tech room designed for crisis management, with facilities for satellite uplinks and all kinds of fancy computers.









200cp Items One discounted.

Comfy Home

A nice little house in the suburbs where your family lives. It's no mansion, but you get to pick the style and it'll follow you across new worlds.

Invitation

A stack of printed leaflets. All that's on it is an address and the phrase "We have all the answers you seek!!". Scatter a few of these around the place and people with special abilities will find these leaflets and show up to the address. You know the type – kids with new superpowers, wizards hiding in society, high schoolers who are reincarnations of mighty monsters!

You can change the address which appears on the leaflets at will.

Extra-Large Tape

Extra-large size duct tape with kaisu-grade adhesive. You know, to tape buildings back together after a kaisu fight knocks them to smithereens.

A Field Guide To Kaisus

A heavily-illustrated reference book for new Kaisu Girls, it documents every known kaisu in the world!
From their powers to historic appearances, weaknesses and origins, all known Ultraman kaisu are included.

It updates in future jumps to include info on all known gigantic monsters of the setting.

400cp Items One discounted.

Brutal Training Gear!

Massive weights for kaisu-stronk girls, treadmills with spikes on the end to keep you running, ball and chain weights, boulders to practice smashing...this training gear is pretty brutal! Because it's high on the Pain, it's high on the Gain. ...Probably.

(This equipment provides huge boosts to the gainz you get from working out with it.)

Department Tickets

Looks like you got recruited to the investigation department, because this is a set of blank tickets with your name on them. Once a week just write your destination on them and you'll be good for return travel on bus, train, boat or plane - it's just the thing for getting to all those exclusive local manga release events!

A-and also for work of course! D-Don't hit me Pigmon-sama! Waah!




Companions First two free.

Reincarnated! - 50cp

Import or Create from scratch a companion as a Kaisu girl. 600cp to spend on perks (with freebies and discounts).

Canon Companion - 100cp

Bring someone with you. Their canon powers, traits and items become backed by your Benefactor.



Drawbacks

Limit +800cp

U-ULTRAMAN!?!

+0cp

You might have been to the Ultraman universe before, so if you take this toggle the reincarnated kaibu souls here might remember you. I accept no responsibility for the girls reacting badly to something their souls remember.

No, I'm Agi-chan!

+0cp

If you select this option and choose a
Kaiʻsu whose soul has already
appeared in a Kaiʻsu Girl, you'll take
that character's place in the
setting. If you take this, you can't
take Copy-Soul.

Talk About Exposed! +100cp

Your costume really doesn't cover much, does it? You'll be really self-conscious when you're in kaibu form, and almost turn blue with cold when the wind picks up.

Disaster strikes! +200cp

I mean it happens a lot in this world but now it's c-razy! Disasters like fires, earthquakes and building collapses happen on an almost daily occurrence in your city. You'll have your hands full even before the Shadows get really active.

Copy-Soul

Select this option to have a copy of a canon Kaisu Girl's Kaisu Soul.

There's two of you for some reason, nobody can figure out why or how.

Maybe with a palette change.

It's a mystery!

How Do I Do This? +100cp

You don't know how to transform or use a Soulriser, and you'll have to figure it out along the way. Don't worry, I'm sure you'll get it eventually! Probably. Try lots of things, listen to your inner kaisu soul and learn about yourself, or something!

I'm The Number #1 Fan! +200cp

You're painfully into a certain fandom. Probably something with a lot of yaoi shipping, like ScoreYou. This fandom is your life, but also your weakness. Hearing spoilers about it will make you despair - and could drive you Berserk! You'll also spend way too much time and money trying to get all the merch and exclusive releases.

Shadow Copy +200cp

There's a shadow copy of you out there, attacking other Kaisu Girls and menacing the public. Watch out, because they've got all your Kaisu Powers and a lot of your skills!

I'm Your Opponent!

Everyone knows that only Kaisu Girls can defeat Shadows! So here's the thing... that means that all your other powers are totally ineffective against them. You still have them, they sust sort of ignore them for some reason.

It's My Burden! +200cp

You really can't accept help, not even when you're clearly outclassed and the best strategy would be dogpiling your foe with everyone on the field. This is something you'll only be able to overcome late into your jump.

The Hole In Jumper's Heart +300cp

The kaisu inside you sure is a wild one!
Not even a Soulriser is going to calm
it down. You might go berserk every
other day - if nothing makes you
upset or angry. Even though you can
keep it from running wild with your
willpower, it's sust going to break
loose even worse once it gets free!

After your ten years are up, you've got one last choice to make:

Stay Here

We'd love it if you stayed here!

Go Home

But we understand if you want to go home.

Next Jump

Hope to see you again soon!

For now, this jump is based just on the web animation.

I'm aware there's more material related to the Kaiju Girls Anthropomorphic Project in the way of art, manga and stories, but I'm unable to find English translations. If you have this material, help me get my hands on it so I can add more options to the jump.

What kind of kaiju can I choose without importing a form?

Any Kaiju that appears on the Ultraman Kaiju list: http://ultra.wikia.com/wiki/Category:Ultra Kaiju

Your background may be a "Drop In" or may have existing personality/memories at your option.

Special Moves

They will be roughly on par with other toku character abilities - Something an average super sental or kamen rider villain or hero might have. Think street level powers. Strong/high damage moves are short-lived, slow, or have a long charge-up time, or are best used in specific circumstances, while weaker or generic attacks can usually be spammed or relied on in most situations. They aren't far-reaching, they don't have conceptual effects.

Because the Special Moves are based on your Kaiju Soul, you can't really learn new ones, but there's plenty of room to learn how to use them creatively, or combine them in different ways for different attacks. As the 'strength' of your Kaiju Soul increases, the basic properties of your special moves increases (a bit more damage, a bit faster recharge, a slightly longer range, etc.)

If you take Senpai you can be an older Kaiju girl instead of a rookie, or if you replace one of the canon older girls.

The information provided by You Just Triggered A Flag! is usually fairly specific. For example, when a girl mentions she grew up in a house with blue flowers in the yard, you'll go "aha! I need to find a Blue Flower to trigger a romance flag on this girl!", but the perk doesn't tell you where you can get a Blue Flower or what exactly you'll have to do to get one. Or you'll know "entering this doorway will turn the place into a boss battle arena" but maybe not know who the boss is.

And sometimes the flags are just obvious. "To trip a flag where my sensei will start teaching me...! need to get out of bed and go to my class at the dojo."

A kaiju doesn't have to die to have its soul reincarnated, only to be defeated.
